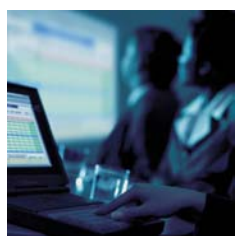

On June 20-21, 2007 the CAA held its 14th Annual Rules Compliance Seminar in Richmond, VA. The CAA takes the opportunity once a year to bring together compliance coordinators, the conference NCAA contact, and liaisons from other departments together to discuss compliance updates, legislative issues, and best practices.

Departments participating range from compliance, academic coordinating, life skills, financial aid, registrar's office, and faculty athletic representatives.

Newly adopted legislation, transfer/international issues, financial aid, and progress toward degree



were a few of the topics presented.

Each participant had the choice of presentations to attend.

This provided each institution's department the opportunity to attend presentations relevant to their work. In addition, the departments had the opportunity to discuss issues and share ideas with other institution's department personnel.

During the compliance coordinators roundtable many subjects were discussed. Hot topics were: programs used to assist coaches in tracking recruiting interaction, camps and clinics, coaches and athletic administration rules education, uses of the Special Assistance Fund, and campus wide involvement in ensuring athletic compliance.
