

**W**e're excited about the start of the 2010-11 CAA Basketball season. The conference returns the majority of its starters from a year ago, including nine All-CAA performers. There are also several newcomers who are expected to make an immediate impact.

## **QUICK HITS FOR 2010-11:**

- Nine players who earned All-CAA honors in 2009-10 are back this season. Leading the list are first-team honorees Charles Jenkins of Hofstra, who was the CAA Player of the Year, and Chaiison Allen of Northeastern. Four players are back from the second team - Denzel Bowles of James Madison, Jawan Carter of Delaware, Cam Long of George Mason and Joey Rodriguez of VCU. Returning from the third team are Ben Finney of Old Dominion, Quinn McDowell of William and Mary and Julius Wells of James Madison.
- There will be plenty of familiar faces around the CAA as teams welcome back nearly 67 percent of their starters (40-of-60) from a year ago. Delaware and George Mason return their entire starting fives, while Drexel, James Madison, Old Dominion, Towson and VCU have four starters back.
- A league-record six CAA teams received postseason berths in 2009-10. CAA champion Old Dominion advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament after knocking off Notre Dame, 51-50. Northeastern and William and Mary earned spots in the NIT, where they suffered narrow road losses to perennial powers Connecticut and North Carolina. VCU won five straight games to capture the CBI Championship with a 71-65 triumph over Saint Louis. Hofstra also participated in the CBI, while George Mason played in the CIT.
- Twelve of the league's top 20 scorers are back from last season, as are 12 of the top 20 players in rebounding and six of the top 10 in assists.

This prospectus contains a breakdown of all 12 CAA teams and information is current as of August 15, 2010, but is subject to change.

CAA Basketball Media Day will be held on October 19 in the Washington, D.C. area. Location and more details will be announced soon.

**MAJORITY OF STARTERS RETURN:** CAA teams welcome back 66.7% of their starters (40-of-60) from a year ago. Delaware and George Mason return their entire starting fives, while Drexel, James Madison, Old Dominion, Towson and VCU each have four starters back.

**NINE ALL-CONFERENCE HONOREES ARE BACK:** Nine players who earned All-CAA honors in 2009-10 are back this season. Leading the list are a pair of first-team all-conference honorees – Hofstra senior guard Charles Jenkins, who was the CAA Player of the Year, and Northeastern senior guard Chaison Allen. Four players return from the All-CAA second team – James Madison senior forward Denzel Bowles, Delaware senior guard Jawan Carter, George Mason senior guard Cam Long and VCU senior guard Joey Rodriguez. Back from the All-CAA third team are Old Dominion senior guard/forward Ben Finney, William and Mary junior guard/forward Quinn McDowell and James Madison junior forward Julius Wells.

**MORE ON JENKINS:** Along with earning CAA Player of the Year honors, Hofstra guard Charles Jenkins received the Haggerty Award as the top player in Metropolitan New York for the second year in a row and was named an honorable mention All-American. Jenkins was one of only five players in Division I to average at least 20 points (20.6 ppg), four rebounds (4.5 rpg) and three assists (3.9 apg) per game last season. Jenkins enters his final season with 1,767 career points and is on pace to become Hofstra's all-time leading scorer and one of the top five scorers in CAA history.

**NEW HEAD COACHES AT HOFSTRA, UNCW:** Two CAA schools will have new head coaches this season. UNC Wilmington hired Buzz Peterson, who has previously served as head coach at Appalachian State, Tulsa, Tennessee and Coastal Carolina. Peterson has guided four different teams to five post-season appearances. He replaces Benny Moss, who was reassigned within the athletic department last January.

Hofstra hired Mo Cassara to replace Tom Pecora, who took the head coaching job at Fordham. Cassara has spent the past four seasons as an assistant coach at Boston College and previously was the head coach at Division III Clark University for two years.

**LEAGUE-RECORD SIX CAA TEAMS IN POSTSEASON PLAY:** A league-record six CAA men's basketball teams earned postseason berths last year, topping the previous high of five set in 2008-09. Old Dominion, which earned a #11 seed in the South Region of the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship, upset #6 Notre Dame 51-50 in the first round before falling to Baylor, 76-68. The Monarchs

became the third different CAA team in the last five years to advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Northeastern and William & Mary were chosen for the NIT, with the 5th-seeded Huskies falling 59-57 at #4 Connecticut and the 5th-seeded Tribe losing 80-72 at #4 North Carolina. VCU went 5-0 and captured the CBI championship with a pair of victories over Saint Louis in the finals. Hofstra also competed in the CBI, but lost to IUPUI in the first round. George Mason participated in the CIT, but fell in overtime to Fairfield in the opening round.

**POSTSEASON SUCCESS:** CAA teams have combined to win 24 games in postseason play over the last five years. During that five-year period, the conference has had a team reach the Final Four of the NCAA Tournament (George Mason – 2006) and the NIT (Old Dominion – 2006) and has had squads capture championships of the College Basketball Invitational (VCU – 2010) and the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (Old Dominion – 2009).



**QUALITY FROM TOP TO BOTTOM:** Over the past five years, nine of the CAA's 12 teams have participated in postseason play.

**SEVEN TEAMS WITH 10+ CAA WINS FOR FIRST TIME:** For the first time in CAA history, seven teams finished the 2009-10 season with 10 or more conference victories. Six teams had reached the 10-victory mark on four previous occasions. Hofstra was the first #7 seed in the CAA Tournament to have a winning record in league play.

**ODU RIDING 23-GAME HOME COURT WINNING STREAK:** Old Dominion enters the 2010-11 season with the fourth-longest home winning streak in the nation at 23 games. The Monarchs' home court streak ranks behind only Kansas (59), Siena (38) and Xavier (24). ODU was a perfect 15-0 at the Constant Center last season.

**FOUR CAA TEAMS IN MID-MAJOR TOP 25 POLL:** Four CAA teams were ranked in the final Mid-Major Top 25 poll of 2009-10 released by CollegeInsider.com. Old Dominion led all CAA squads at #5, followed by Northeastern at #19, William & Mary at #20 and VCU at #21. The CAA led all conferences with four teams in the poll.

**FROM CAA TO NBA:** VCU center Larry Sanders was selected by the Milwaukee Bucks with the 15th overall pick in the first round of the 2010 NBA Draft. It was the second straight year that a CAA player was taken in the first round of the NBA Draft as Sanders joined former VCU teammate Eric Maynor, who was selected 20th overall by the Utah Jazz in 2009. In addition, former Towson guard Gary Neal signed a multi-year contract with the San Antonio Spurs and Northeastern guard Matt Janning signed a multi-year contract with the Phoenix Suns.

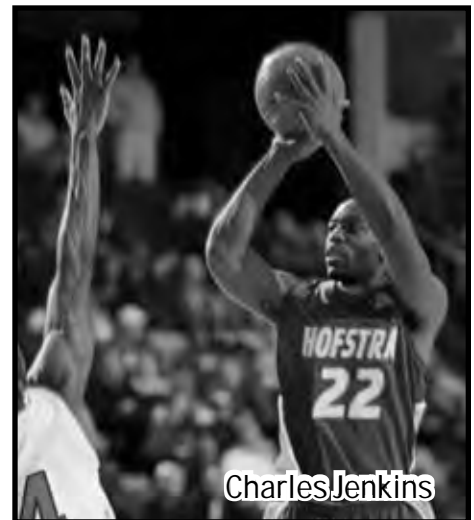

# 2010-11 CAA TEAM NOTES

DELAWARE	<p>Senior guard Brian Johnson ranks fourth on Delaware's career assists list with 450. Johnson, who had started all 94 games of his Blue Hens' career before missing last season with a knee injury, is on pace to finish among the top 10 in CAA history in assists.</p> <p>Senior guard Jawan Carter, who ranked third in the CAA in scoring (18.2) last year, eclipsed the 1,000-point mark in his UD career in less than two seasons. Carter scored double figures in 23 of his final 24 games in 2009-10.</p> <p>Senior Alphonso Dawson has been among the CAA's top 20 in scoring and rebounding for the past two seasons. He enters his final year with 1,155 career points and 489 career rebounds.</p>
DREXEL	<p>Guard Chris Fouch became the first Drexel player to earn CAA Rookie of the Year honors in 2009-10. Fouch led all CAA freshmen in scoring (11.3 ppg) and ranked among the league's top 10 in 3-pointers (60) and 3-point FG percentage (37.9%).</p> <p>Junior forward Samme Givens has ranked among the top six in the CAA in rebounding for the past two seasons. Givens averaged 8.3 rebounds per game a year ago and grabbed double-digit caroms 12 times.</p> <p>Drexel went 11-7 in the CAA last season, which marked the seventh time in nine years as a member of the conference that the Dragons have posted double-digit victories in league play.</p>
GEORGE MASON	<p>George Mason has made eight postseason appearances in the past 12 years, including four berths in the NCAA Tournament and three in the NIT. The Patriots have also won at least 12 CAA games for the past three seasons.</p> <p>Senior guard Cam Long, who earned 2nd team All-CAA honors a year ago, needs just 96 points to become the 30th player in Mason history to reach the 1,000-point mark for his career. He is also on pace to finish among the Patriots' top 10 all-time in assists.</p> <p>Junior guard Andre Cornelius led the CAA in 3-point FG percentage (43.3%) last season. Cornelius is the first Patriots' player to top the conference in 3-point accuracy since Brian Miller in 1987-88.</p>
GEORGIA STATE	<p>Senior point guard Marques Johnson is Georgia State's lone returning starter. The N.C. State transfer started 20 of the Panthers' final 24 contests and was second on the team with 73 assists.</p> <p>Junior guard Jihad Ali averaged 8.9 ppg and 3.6 rpg over GSU's final nine games last season. He poured in a career-best 22 points in the Panthers' 61-57 victory over George Mason, including the game-winning three-pointer with 42 seconds left.</p> <p>The Panthers face the difficult task of replacing their top five scorers from a year ago, who combined to average 47.2 ppg. GSU has added seven new players to this year's roster, including three junior college transfers.</p>
HOFSTRA	<p>Senior guard Charles Jenkins enters the season ranked eighth in career points (1,767) and assists (331) and ninth in steals (156) at Hofstra. The reigning CAA Player of the Year and two-time Haggerty Award winner is on pace to become the Pride's all-time leading scorer and one of the top five scorers in CAA history.</p> <p>Jenkins was one of only five players in Division I to average at least 20 points, four rebounds and three assists per game last season.</p> <p>Senior forward Greg Washington already holds Hofstra's records for blocked shots in a season (92) and a career (203). He enters the season ranked 10th on the CAA's all-time blocked shots list.</p>
JAMES MADISON	<p>Senior forward Denzel Bowles led the CAA in scoring (20.8 ppg), rebounding (9.2 rpg) and FG percentage (59.4%) last season. The Texas A&amp;M transfer scored double figures in all 25 games he played in and recorded 12 double-doubles after becoming eligible in mid-December.</p> <p>Junior forward Julius Wells ranked second in the CAA with 91 three-pointers last year, which was the fourth-highest season total ever by a JMU player. He needs just 43 points to reach 1,000 for his career.</p> <p>The Dukes welcome back sophomore point guard Devon Moore, who missed all of last season with a knee injury. Moore earned CAA All-Rookie accolades in 2008-09 after averaging 10.7 ppg and dishing out 92 assists.</p>

# 2010-11 CAA TEAM NOTES



UNC WILMINGTON	<p>Senior guard Chad Tomko ranked among the CAA's top 15 in scoring (12.8 ppg), assists (4.3 apg) and steals (1.6 spg) for the second year in a row in 2009-10. Tomko has already topped the 1,000-point mark (1,155) for his career and ranks third in career steals (165) and fourth in career assists (349) at UNCW.</p> <p>Senior guard Ahmad Grant scored double figures in six of UNCW's final seven games last season and averaged 13.1 ppg over that stretch. Grant finished second on the team with 43 three-pointers.</p> <p>Sophomore forward Keith Rendleman ranked second among all CAA freshmen and 12th overall in rebounding (6.1 rpg) last season. Rendleman led the Seahawks in rebounding 11 times in 2009-10.</p>
NORTHEASTERN	<p>Senior guard Chaiison Allen, who earned 1st team All-CAA and CAA All-Defensive team honors, scored double figures in 29 of 33 games last season. He also ranked among the league's top 10 in assists (3.6 apg), steals (1.5 spg), field goal percentage, 3-pointers and 3-point field goal percentage.</p> <p>Allen has already eclipsed the 1,000-point mark (1,066) for his career and enters the season ranked among the top 10 in Huskies' history in assists (324/7th) and steals (171/8th).</p> <p>Northeastern won 20 games last season for the first time since 2004-05 and just the second time in the last 17 years. The Huskies also made back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time since 1987.</p>
OLD DOMINION	<p>Old Dominion has averaged 24 victories over the past six seasons, which is the most of any school in the state of Virginia and the CAA. The Monarchs have made six consecutive postseason appearances, which includes three NCAA Tournament berths.</p> <p>Senior Ben Finney, who received All-CAA third team honors last season, has grabbed over 200 rebounds from the wing position for the past two years. He is on pace to finish in the top 15 on ODU's career caroms list.</p> <p>Junior guard Kent Bazemore was named to the CAA's All-Defensive team last season after tying for the league lead in steals with 67. Bazemore made a career-high six steals in a win over Georgia State.</p>
TOWSON	<p>Senior forward Robert Nwankwo made the CAA All-Defensive team last season after leading the CAA and ranking 11th in the nation with 3.1 blocked shots per game. Nwankwo was also third in the CAA in rebounding (8.9 rpg) and recorded eight double-doubles.</p> <p>Junior guard RaShawn Polk averaged a team-best 15.5 ppg over the Tigers' final seven games last season. He poured in a career-high 20 points in Towson's victory over UNCW in the first round of the CAA Tournament.</p> <p>Towson has won its opening game in the CAA Men's Basketball Championship for the past four years. Only one other CAA team – VCU – has a longer active streak than the Tigers.</p>
VCU	<p>Senior guard Joey Rodriguez, a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, led the conference and ranked 15th in the nation with 5.8 assists per game last season. Rodriguez dished out 208 assists in his first year as the Rams' point guard, which was the 10th-highest season total in CAA history.</p> <p>Senior guard Brandon Rozzell drained a team-high 63 treys last season and ranked third in the CAA in 3-point percentage (42.3%). Rozzell scored a career-high 27 points in VCU's win over Saint Louis in the CBI title game.</p> <p>VCU went 27-9 and captured the CBI championship in its first season under coach Shaka Smart. The 27 victories were the second-most in school history and the postseason appearance was the fourth in a row for the Rams.</p>
WILLIAM & MARY	<p>Junior guard/forward Quinn McDowell made the All-CAA third team last season after ranking 10th in the league in scoring with 13.9 ppg. He was also among the CAA's top 10 in field goal, free throw and 3-point shooting percentage. McDowell scored 20 or more points eight times in 2009-10.</p> <p>W&amp;M made its first postseason appearance since 1983 when it earned an NIT berth last March. The Tribe's 22 wins were the third-most in school history and they reached the CAA finals for the second time in three years.</p> <p>The Tribe drained 295 threes last season, shattering the CAA record of 270 set by UNCW in 2008-09. W&amp;M, which ranked eighth in the nation with 8.9 treys per game, has made 200 or more treys for the past four years.</p>

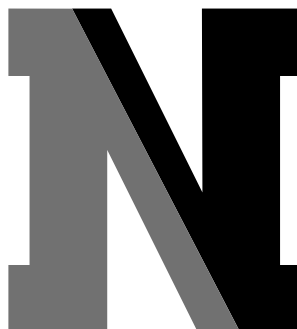
