

The start of the college basketball season is just a few weeks away and we are excited about the prospects for another strong year in the CAA.



QUICK HITS FOR 2010-11:

- Eight players who earned All-CAA honors are back, including All-America honorees Elena Delle Donne from Delaware and Dawn Evans of James Madison. The CAA teams also return 65% of their starters from a year ago.
- Two of the top five scorers in the nation return in the CAA. Delaware forward Elena Delle Donne, 2010 CAA Player and Rookie of the Year, and James Madison guard Dawn Evans finished the 2009-10 season averaging 26.7 and 24.6 points per game, respectively.
- The CAA returns 13 of the season's top 20 scorers and 10 of the top 20 rebounders. The conference also welcomes back eight of the top 10 leaders in assists.
- A league-record seven CAA women's basketball teams advanced to postseason play in 2009-10, shattering the previous high of four set in 2006 and 2007. James Madison earned the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament after capturing its first CAA championship since 1989. Five CAA squads – Delaware, Drexel, Hofstra, Old Dominion and VCU – were chosen to play in the WNIT and three of them picked up victories. Towson also made its first postseason appearance since 1969 in the Women's Basketball Invitational. The CAA has had at least three teams in postseason action for five consecutive seasons.
- The CAA surpassed its all-time record of 25 televised games (2007-08) with 27 games aired last year. All 12 teams made at least one appearance and the same is expected for the 2010-11 schedule.
- The CAA Women's Basketball Championship will be held at The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. on March 10-13, 2011. The tournament will be played at a neutral site for the first time since 1998.

This prospectus contains a breakdown of all 12 CAA teams and information is current as of August 30, 2010, but is subject to change.

CONFERENCE NOTES



Elena Delle Donne

HUNGRY FOR MORE: Eight players who earned All-CAA honors are back, including All-America honorees Elena Delle Donne from Delaware and Dawn Evans of James Madison. The CAA teams also return 65% of their starters from a year ago.

TOP GUNS: Two of the top five scorers in the nation return in the CAA. Delaware forward Elena Delle Donne, 2010 CAA Player and Rookie of the Year, and James Madison guard Dawn Evans finished the 2009-10 season averaging 26.7 and 24.6 points per game, respectively. The CAA returns 13 of the season's top 20 scorers and 10 of the top 20 rebounders. The conference also welcomes back eight of the top 10 leaders in assists.

TWO CAA PLAYERS ADDED TO WADE TROPHY WATCH LIST: Colonial Athletic Association women's basketball standouts Elena Delle Donne of Delaware and Dawn Evans of James Madison were added to the 2010-11 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) State Farm® Wade Trophy Division I Player of the Year pre-season watch list. Delle Donne, one of only four sophomores to earn a spot on the list, led Delaware to a 21-12 record and a berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT) as a freshman. The Blue Hens' forward was named the CAA Player and Rookie of the Year and became the first player in UD history to earn All-America honors when she garnered third team Associated Press and honorable

mention Women's Basketball Coaches Association accolades. Evans, a senior guard at JMU, was also a member of the Wade Trophy watch list in 2009-10. She ranked fifth in the nation in scoring with 24.6 points per game, was third nationally in three-pointers per game (3.6) and also was third in the CAA with 4.6 assists per game last season. Evans, who received honorable mention All-America honors from the Associated Press, was also among the candidates for the Wooden Award and Naismith Trophy.

2011 & 2012 CAA WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIPS TO BE HOSTED AT NEUTRAL SITE:

The Show Place Arena in Upper Marlboro, Md. has been selected to host the Colonial Athletic Association Women's Basketball Championship in 2011 and 2012 by the league's athletic directors. It will be the first time that The Show Place Arena has served as host of the CAA women's championship. All games in the four-day, 11-game tournament will be played at the 5,000-seat arena, with the winner earning an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

INCREASE OF INTEREST: The 2010 CAA Women's Basketball Championship welcomed 11,022 fans over the four day event, which was the most the tournament has seen since 2003 when Old Dominion hosted and entertained 11,536 spectators. The championship game was in front of 3,385 fans, which is the highest recorded attendance in the last decade.

TWO NEW HEAD COACHES WELCOMED TO THE LEAGUE: Two CAA schools will have new head coaches this season. UNC Wilmington hired Cynthia Cooper-Dyke, who has previously served as head coach at Prairie View A&M. The former college great, Olympic gold medalist and Women's National Basketball Association (WNBA) Most Valuable Player was enshrined into the James Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on August 13 in Springfield, Mass. She replaces Ann Hancock. Georgia State hired Sharon Baldwin-Tener to replace Lea Henry. Baldwin-Tener had spent the past eight seasons at East Carolina and previously was the head coach Mercer and Life.



RECORD-HIGH SEVEN TEAMS IN POSTSEASON PLAY: For the first time in conference history, the Colonial Athletic Association sent seven women's basketball teams to the postseason. James Madison earned a bid in the NCAA Women's Basketball tournament, while Old Dominion, Delaware, Drexel, Hofstra, and VCU earned bids to the Women's National Invitation Tournament and Towson played in the Women's Basketball Invitational. For the fifth consecutive season, at least three CAA teams advanced to the postseason and for the 10th consecutive season the CAA had a representative in the WNIT. The CAA was just one of four conferences to see five teams in the WNIT. The Big Ten, Big East and Atlantic 10 also saw five conference teams advance to the postseason event.

CONFERENCE NOTES



TV EXPOSURE: The CAA surpassed its all-time record of 25 game (2007-08) with 27 games aired during the 2009-10 season. All 12 teams made at least one television appearance. The CAA women's basketball television package has aired over 20 games for at least the last three seasons.

DELLE DONNE, EVANS, AND MARGINEAN HONORED BY ASSOCIATED PRESS:

Delaware freshman guard/forward Elena Delle Donne was named to the Associated Press All-America third-team, while James Madison junior guard Dawn Evans and Drexel senior forward Gabriela Marginean received honorable mention. Delle Donne, the 2010 Colonial Athletic Association Player and Rookie of the Year, was one of two league players named a finalist, as the 6-5 forward/guard averaged 26.7 points per game and 8.8 boards. Delle Donne finished the season with a record-setting 774 points and broke 13 Delaware records, while setting a new single-season scoring record for the CAA. Evans averaged 24.6 points and 4.6 assists a game last season while leading the Dukes to the CAA championship and an NCAA Tournament berth. Evans has broken numerous school records, including single-game points (38), career 30-point games (17), season points (761), season free throws (177) and season three-pointers (112). Marginean ranked third in the CAA in scoring and eighth in the nation last season while leading her team to its third top-four finish in her four years at Drexel. She became the all-time leading scorer at Drexel, in the CAA and in the history of Philadelphia collegiate women's basketball. She is the first player in Drexel history to amass 2,500 points, 900 rebounds and 200 steals.



DELLE DONNE NAMED TO 2010 FULL COURT PRESS FRESHMAN ALL-AMERICA TEAM:

Delaware freshman sensation Elena Delle Donne was one of five NCAA Division I freshmen women's basketball players named to the 2010 Full Court Press Freshman All-America Team. This honor is coupled with an Associated Press All-America Third Team honor and a WBCA State Farm Coaches' All-America Honorable Mention award she received. Full Court Press published a 15 person All-America team which included first, second and third team honors, in addition to the three-squad Freshman All-America team voted on by a panel of Full Court Press correspondents from across the nation. Delle Donne was joined by South Carolina's Kelsey Bone, Notre Dame's Skyler Diggins, Baylor's Brittney Griner and Georgetown's Sugar Rodgers on the Freshman first team, while the All-American first team was comprised of Connecticut's Tina Charles and Maya Moore, Nebraska's Kelsey Griffin, Stanford's Nnemkadi Ogwumike and Virginia's Monica Wright.

JMU'S DAWN EVANS CHOSEN AS 2010 CAA RANDOLPH INSPIRATION AWARD WINNER: James Madison guard Dawn Evans was selected as the winner of the 2010 John H. Randolph Inspiration Award by the Colonial Athletic Association. The award recognizes individuals who through strength of character and human spirit serve as an inspiration to all to maximize their potential and ability for success. It is named after former William & Mary athletic director John Randolph, who lost a courageous battle with cancer in 1995. Evans, a standout women's basketball player for the Dukes, has battled Focal Segmental Glomerular Sclerosis (FSGS) this year and faces the prospect of a kidney transplant in the near future. The disease creates serious scarring within a kidney's filtering system and dialysis is not an uncommon consequence, nor is an organ transplant. Evans was diagnosed last December, shortly after scoring a school-record 38 points during the Dukes' upset of 14th-ranked Virginia on the road. Doctors said her kidneys were in Stage 4 - or functioning at about 20 percent efficiency - and a transplant is recommended at 15 percent. Evans missed one game after taking a 10-day break following her diagnosis in December, but returned to the court to face nationally-ranked Duke on December 18th. Evans missed just one other game during the season and led the Dukes to the 2010 CAA Women's Basketball Championship.

MARGINEAN SELECTED BY MINNESOTA LYNX IN 2010 WNBA DRAFT: After completing a stellar collegiate playing career, Drexel senior Gabriela Marginean added another first to her list of achievements at Drexel. She became the first Dragons' women's basketball player drafted by a team in the Women's National Basketball Association when, with the second pick of the third round, the Minnesota Lynx selected Marginean as the 26th overall pick.

DELAWARE	<p>Head coach Tina Martin welcomes back four returning starters and 10 letterwinners after a strong 21-12 season and a trip to the postseason Women's National Invitation Tournament.</p> <p>Delaware will return All-American and 2010 CAA Player and Rookie of the Year Elena Delle Donne. The sophomore averaged 26.7 ppg during her freshman campaign. She was also named to the Wade Trophy watch list for the 2010-11 season.</p> <p>Top returnee guard Lauren Carra (6.0 ppg) will join returning starting guards Jocelyn Bailey (5.0 ppg/4.4 rpg) and Kayla Miller (3.5 ppg/3.1 apg) and forward Danielle Parker (5.0 ppg/5.5 rpg).</p>
DREXEL	<p>The Dragons may have lost all-star Gabriela Marginean (23.5 ppg/7.7 rpg), but head coach Denise Dillon will welcome back four starters including senior guard Jasmina Rosseel (10.3 ppg) and junior guard Kamile Nacickaite (11.6 ppg). Juniors Marisa Crane and Tyler Hale will also return to their starting positions.</p> <p>Drexel has made a postseason appearance the past two seasons and will look to continue the streak during the 2010-11 season. The Dragons made their first NCAA appearance in 2009 and played in the WNIT in 2010.</p> <p>Jasmina Rosseel averaged 2.6 treys per game, and Kamile Nacickaite poured in 1.9 per outing. The Dragons led the league averaging 6.5 three-pointers per contest.</p>
GEORGE MASON	<p>Head coach Jeri Porter welcomes back all five starters to the court this season, including three senior leaders in Brittany Poindexter (11.8 ppg), Ashleigh Braxton (8.5 ppg) and Angelee LaTouche (6.1 rpg).</p> <p>CAA All-Rookie honoree Amber Easter led the team in rebounding with 173 total boards, and sophomore Rahneeka Saunders posted team-highs in steals (53) and assists (79).</p> <p>Senior Angelee LaTouche helped the Jamaican National Team earn a silver medal at the Centrobasket Championship for Women. With the second-place finish at the tournament, Jamaica earned a spot in the 2011 FIBA-Americas Championship (Pre-Olympic) and the 2011 Pan-American Games.</p>
GEORGIA STATE	<p>Georgia State welcomes Sharon Baldwin-Tener as the ninth head coach in the history of the Panthers' program. Baldwin-Tener brings a career record of 195-142 to the Panthers, most recently posting a 126-115 record at the helm of East Carolina.</p> <p>Junior forward Chan Harris will enter the 2010-11 season after sitting for a majority of the past season due to injury. She played just six games last year and averaged 11.0 points and 6.2 rebounds in her time on the court.</p> <p>Senior forward Angelique Burttts, who added 10.2 points and 4.6 rebounds per contest, will also return to the court for Georgia State.</p>
HOFSTRA	<p>Head coach Krista Kilburn-Steveskey and the Pride look to build on the 20-14 season from a year ago. Hofstra advanced to the second round of the WNIT in 2010.</p> <p>All-CAA second team and All-Rookie team honoree Shante Evans returns for the Pride after averaging team highs of 13.3 points and 9.5 rebounds a year ago. She was second on the team in field goal percentage (.483).</p> <p>Starting guards Aamira Terry and Candice Bellocchio will also return among eight other letterwinners to the 2010-11 squad.</p>
JAMES MADISON	<p>Coming off a 26-7 overall record and a trip to the NCAA first round, head coach Kenny Brooks and the Dukes look to defend their CAA title in 2010-11.</p> <p>James Madison returns All-American and two-time All-CAA first team member Dawn Evans. The senior guard averaged 24.6 points and 4.6 assists per game last year. She was also named to the Wade Trophy watch list for the 2010-11 season.</p> <p>Including Evans, the Dukes return four starters. Sophomore guard Tarik Hislop (10.3 ppg), sophomore forward/guard Nikki Newman (4.9 rpg) and senior center Jalissa Taylor (5.2 ppg) will also be back for JMU.</p>

UNC WILMINGTON	<p>New UNCW coach Cynthia Cooper-Dyke spent the past five seasons at Prairie View A&M, where she guided the Panthers to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. Cooper-Dyke, who was a two-time WNBA MVP and Olympic gold medalist, was inducted into the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame on August 13.</p> <p>Senior Brittany Blackwell has earned All-CAA honors during each of her first three seasons with the Seahawks. Blackwell enters her senior year ranked sixth in career rebounds (721) and seventh in career points (1,245) at UNCW.</p> <p>Senior Martha White has made 45 consecutive starts for the Seahawks. She averaged a career-best 9.4 ppg last season and tallied double figures 17 times.</p>
NORTHEASTERN	<p>Junior Kashaia Cannon ranked ninth in the CAA in 3-point FG percentage (35.2%) last season and made nearly 41% of her attempts from beyond the arc in conference play.</p> <p>Junior guard Jamie Conroy dished out a team-high 101 assists last season and was also second on the team with 44 steals. Conroy scored a career-high 20 points in NU's triple-overtime win over ODU on Jan. 7.</p> <p>Northeastern ranked second in the CAA with 193 three-pointers last season. The 193 treys tied a school record, which was previously set in 2007-08.</p>
OLD DOMINION	<p>ODU made its 18th postseason appearance in the last 19 years last season when it advanced to the second round of the WNIT. The Lady Monarchs captured an NCAA-record 17 CAA titles from 1992-2008 and earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.</p> <p>The Lady Monarchs return their top three scorers from a year ago, all of whom averaged double figures. Back for ODU are junior Tia Lewis (11.2 ppg) and seniors Jasmine Parker (11.1 ppg) and Shadasia Green (10.7 ppg).</p> <p>Senior guard Jasmine Parker earned CAA All-Defensive team honors last season after making 80 steals, which was the second-most in the conference.</p>
TOWSON	<p>Towson will have plenty of new faces in its starting lineup this season. The Tigers have to replace four starters from a year ago, who were also the team's four leading scorers.</p> <p>Twenty-six of senior guard Simona Petronyte's 38 field goals last season were three-pointers. Petronyte finished second on the team in treys.</p> <p>Towson made its first postseason appearance since 1969 last season when it earned a berth in the Women's Basketball Invitational. The Tigers also posted their first victory over a nationally ranked opponent a year ago when they upset Maryland, 67-55.</p>
VCU	<p>VCU set program records by winning more than 20 games and reaching postseason play for the third year in a row. The Rams went 22-13 and advanced to the third round of the WNIT in 2009-10.</p> <p>Junior forward Courtney Hurt earned third-team All-CAA honors last season after ranking among the top 10 in the CAA in scoring (13.7 ppg), rebounding (7.7 rpg) and FG percentage (45.9%).</p> <p>The Rams return a pair of guards who each dished out more than 100 assists last season - junior Jennifer Lane (117) and senior Ebony Patterson (103). No other team in the CAA had two players with 100+ assists a year ago.</p>
WILLIAM & MARY	<p>Junior guard Taysha Pye scored 493 points last season, which was the second-highest total in W&M history. The second-team All-CAA selection reached double figures in 26 of her 30 games.</p> <p>The Tribe returns three of the CAA's top 15 players in steals in 2009-10. Junior Janine Aldridge (2.0 spg) ranked eighth, junior Katherine DeHenzel (1.9 spg) was 12th and junior Taysha Pye (1.7 spg) was 15th.</p> <p>W&M head coach Debbie Taylor is the winningest basketball coach in school history for either men or women. Taylor has 125 career victories with the Tribe.</p>

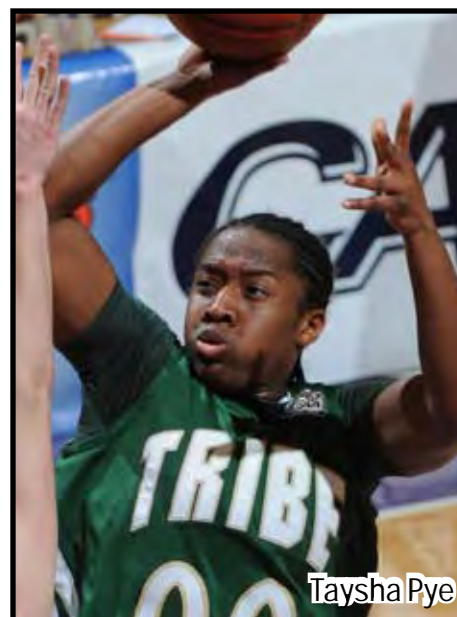
