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FOOTBALL MIDYEAR JUNIOR COLLEGE TRANSFERS NATIONAL LETTER OF INTENT (NLI) REMINDERS

Initial Date for NLI Midyear JC Transfer Signing Period: Wednesday, December 16, 2009.

Last Day of NLI Signing Period: Friday, January 15, 2010.

Recruiting Calendar NOTES:

1. During the Dead Periods on December 21, 2009 through January 1, 2010, and January 11-14, 2010 institutional staff members may have contact with a prospect who has been admitted for midyear enrollment, provided the prospect has signed an NLI or other offer of admission and/or financial aid to attend the institution and is required to be on campus to attend institutional orientation sessions for all students.
2. Six in-person off-campus contacts per prospect are permitted during Contact Periods that are listed on Recruiting Calendar from November 29, 2009 through January 30, 2010 with not more than one permitted in any one calendar week (Sunday through Saturday) or partial calendar week.



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FOOTBALL DEAD PERIOD RESTRICTIONS

Contacts, Evaluations & Recruiting Trips. No in-person, on- or off-campus contact with a prospective student-athlete may be made during the Dead Period, including evaluating a prospect or visiting a high school, prep school, or junior college, even if no contact is made with prospects.

Speaking Engagements. Coaches may not serve as a speaker at or attend a meeting or banquet at which prospects are in attendance during a Dead Period.

Telephone Calls to Midyear JC Transfers. Institutional coaching staff members may make unlimited telephone calls to prospective student-athletes during the period starting at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, December 14 until 7:00 a.m. on Friday, December 18 (i.e., 48 hours before and 48 hours after 7:00 a.m. on the initial signing date for the NLI).

Official Visits/Unofficial Visits/Complimentary Admissions. A prospect may not visit your campus on an official (paid) or unofficial (self-paid) visit during a Dead Period. Complimentary admission may not be provided to prospects during Dead Periods.

Delivery of NLI. The NLI cannot be hand-delivered or picked up during a Dead Period or at any other time. It may be delivered and returned by express mail, courier service, regular mail, electronic mail or fax during the signing period.

GENERAL REMINDERS

Written Correspondence. Coaches may write prospects during the Dead Period.

Admissions and Graduation Data, Academic Progress Rate (APR), Graduation Success Rate (GSR), Banned Drug List and Information about Nutritional Supplements. Institutions are required to provide prospects and prospects' parents/legal guardians with information contained in these Disclosure Reports no later than the day prior to a prospect's signed acceptance of the NLI or signed acceptance of the institution's written offer of admission and/or financial aid. The reports may be provided in hard copy or electronic form (email, link to web site).
