#### **Recruiting Calendar Notes:**

- 1. <u>Dead Period.</u> During the Dead Periods on December 20, 2010 through January 3, 2011 and January 10-13, 2011 institutional staff members may have contact with a prospect who has been admitted for midyear enrollment, provided the prospect has signed an NLI or other offer of admission and/or financial aid to attend the institution and is required to be on campus to attend institutional orientation sessions for all students.
- 2. <u>Contact Period.</u> Six in-person off-campus contacts per prospect are permitted during Contact Periods that are listed on Recruiting Calendar from November 28, 2010 through January 29, 2011 with not more than one permitted in any one calendar week (Sunday through Saturday) or partial calendar week.

### FOOTBALL DEAD PERIOD REMINDERS

<u>Contacts, Evaluations & Recruiting Trips</u>. No in-person, on- or off-campus contact with a prospective student-athlete may be made during the Dead Period, including evaluating a prospect or visiting a high school, prep school, or junior college, even if no contact is made with prospects.

**Speaking Engagements.** Coaches may not serve as a speaker at or attend a meeting or banquet at which prospects are in attendance during a Dead Period.

<u>Telephone Calls to Midyear JC Transfers.</u> Institutional coaching staff members may make unlimited telephone calls to prospective midyear JC transfer student-athletes during the period starting at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, December 13 until 7:00 a.m. on Friday, December 17 (i.e., 48 hours before and 48 hours after 7:00 a.m. on the initial signing date for the NLI).

<u>Official Visits/Unofficial Visits/Complimentary Admissions.</u> A prospect may not visit your campus on an official (paid) or unofficial (self-paid visit during a Dead Period. Complimentary admission may not be provided to prospects during Dead Periods.

<u>Delivery of NLI.</u> The NLI cannot be hand-delivered or picked up during a Dead Period or at any other time. It may be delivered and returned by express mail, courier service, regular mail, electronic mail or fax during the signing period.

Written Correspondence. Coaches may write prospects during the Dead Period.

**NEW!** <u>Amateurism Certification Questionnaire.</u> Prospects must complete the Amateurism Certification Questionnaire administered by the NCAA Eligibility Center prior to being provided a written offer of athletically related financial aid.

**NEW!** <u>Disclosure Reports.</u> The NCAA Eligibility Center now provides the information contained within the Disclosure Reports [e.g., Admissions and Graduation Rate Data, Academic Progress Rate (APR) and Graduation Success Rate (GSR), Initial-Eligibility Standards and Banned Drug List] to prospects and their parents or legal guardians after the prospect registers with the NCAA Eligibility Center, and is added to the institution's IRL. Institutions may still choose to send these reports to prospects and parents, however, it is no longer a requirement.
