JANUARY RECRUITING CALENDAR & MIDYEAR JC TRANSFER

Initial Date for NLI Midyear JC Transfer Signing Period: Wednesday, December 15, 2010.

Last Day of NLI Signing Period: Saturday, January 15, 2011

January 1-3	Dead Period
January 4-8	Contact Period
January 9	Quiet Period
January 10-13	Dead Period
January 15	Last Day of NLI Signing Period for Midyear Junior College Transfers
January 14-29	Contact Period
January 30	Quiet Period

* During the January 1-3 and 10-13 Dead Period institutional staff members may have contact with a prospective student-athlete who has been admitted for midyear enrollment, provided the prospect has signed a National Letter of Intent or other offer of admission and/or financial aid to attend the institution and is required to be on campus to attend institutional orientation sessions for all students.

- The NLI must be signed within 14 days of the date the NLI was issued to the PSA.
- The NLI & Scholarship Agreement must be submitted to the CAA within 21 days of the date of the final signature.

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PROPOSED LEGISLATION REMINDER

As a reminder, at its January 12-13 meeting, the Legislative Council will be responsible for considering, and ultimately voting on, all legislative proposals being considered in the annual legislative cycle. Proposals receiving at least two-thirds support by the Legislative Council at that meeting will be considered adopted but that action will not be considered final until after the conclusion of the Board of Directors January 16 meeting. Therefore, pursuant to this process, the Board has the authority to consider any proposal adopted by the Legislative Council, but is not required to examine every adopted proposal. The intent of this process is to allow the Legislative Council to take final action on the day-to-day legislative matters necessary for the efficient management of Division I, but to leave to the Board the authority to address any issue facing the division. We will update you on any adopted football proposals in the February 2011 Newsletter.
