Recruiting Calendar

Football, Championship Division

Nov. 25-Feb.2 ~ Contact Period
Six in-person off-campus contacts per prospective student-athlete shall be permitted during this time period with not more than one permitted in any one calendar week (Sunday through Saturday) or partial calendar week.

Except for:

Dec. 16~ Quiet Period

Dec. 17-Jan. 3, 2008 ~ Dead Period

** Note: During the Dead Period institutional staff members may have contact with a prospect who has been admitted for midyear enrollment, provided the prospect has signed an NLI or other offer of admission and/or financial aid to attend the institution and is required to be on campus to attend institutional orientation sessions for all students.*

Football Midyear Junior College Transfer Signing Period

Initial Date for NLI Midyear JC Transfer Signing Period: Wednesday, December 19, 2007.

Last Day of Signing Period: Tuesday, January 15, 2008.

Quiet Period: December 16, 2007 & January 4-6 & January 11-12, 2008.

Dead Period: December 17, 2007 through January 3, 2008 & January 7-10, 2008.*

** Note: During the Dead Period institutional staff members may have contact with a prospect who has been admitted for midyear enrollment, provided the prospect has signed an NLI or other offer of admission and/or financial aid to attend the institution and is required to be on campus to attend institutional orientation sessions for all students.*

Dead Period Restrictions

Please be aware of the following dead period restrictions:

1. Contacts, Evaluations & Recruiting Trips.

No in-person, on- or off-campus contact with a prospective student-athlete may be made during the Dead Period, including evaluating a prospect or visiting a high school, prep school, or junior college, even if no contact is made with prospects.

2. Speaking Engagements. Coaches may not serve as a speaker at or attend a meeting or banquet at which prospects are in attendance during a Dead Period.

3. Telephone Calls. Institutional coaching staff members may make unlimited telephone calls to prospective student-athletes during the period

starting at 7:00 a.m. on Monday, December 17 until 7:00 a.m. on Friday, December 21 (i.e., 48 hours before and 48 hours after 7:00 a.m. on the initial signing date for the NLI).

4. Official Visits/Unofficial Visits/

Complimentary Admissions. A prospect may not visit your campus on an official (paid) or unofficial (self-paid) visit during a Dead Period. Complimentary admissions may not be provided to a prospect during a Dead Period.

5. Delivery of NLI. The NLI cannot be hand-delivered or picked up during a Dead Period or at any other time. It may be delivered and returned by express mail, courier service, regular mail, electronic mail or fax machine during the signing period.

Recruiting Ban After Signing. Once a prospective student-athlete signs an NLI with another institution they are required to cease recruiting that prospect. The recruiting ban extends to prospective student-athletes who enroll in a two-year college after signing an NLI provided the NLI was not declared null and void for reasons listed in Provision 7 of the NLI. Thus, while in attendance at a two-year college, a coach shall not recruit a prospect if he or she signed an NLI prior to enrolling at the two-year college. Recruiting ban violations and allegations should be reported to the NLI Office.
