PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Freddie Jackson • UNCW

Sr., G, 6-4, 185 - Wilmington, N.C./New Hanover
Jackson averaged 19.0 points, 5.7 rebounds and 4.0 assists in UNCW's 3-0 week. The senior guard scored 18 points in a road victory at preseason favorite Northeastern, tallied a team-high 20 points, eight rebounds and five assists in an overtime win against Delaware and had a team-best 19 points in a triumph over Drexel. For the week, Jackson shot 55.5% from the floor as the Seahawks won three straight CAA games for the first time since 2011-12.



PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Terry Tarpey • William & Mary

Jr., G/F, 6-5, 210 - Stamford, Conn./Fairfield Prep
Tarpey averaged 16.3 points, 11.3 rebounds and 5.0 assists as William & Mary went 2-1 last week. The junior set career-highs with 22 points and 13 rebounds at Elon before recording the first triple-double in Tribe program history with 18 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists in an 81-73 victory over JMU on Saturday. Tarpey shot 58.1% from the floor and 83.3% from the free throw line last week.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Kory Holden • Delaware

Fr., G, 6-2, 180 - Salisbury, Md./J.M. Bennett
Holden averaged 16.3 points, 5.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists in Delaware's three road games last week. The freshman guard scored a game-high 25 points and grabbed seven rebounds at UNCW, contributed 14 points in a road victory at College of Charleston and tallied 10 points, seven rebounds and five assists at Hofstra.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

THREE-WAY TIE ATOP CAA STANDINGS: Hofstra, Northeastern and William & Mary are locked in a three-way tie atop the CAA standings at 4-1 after an exciting night of action on Wednesday. NU set season-highs for FG percentage (63.8%) and points in a 91-83 victory over Hofstra, which snapped the Pride's six-game winning streak. W&M posted the biggest comeback in school history, rallying from a 22-point deficit to defeat UNCW, 76-72. In other action on Wednesday, **College of Charleston** picked up its first CAA win of the season with a 66-50 triumph at Elon and **Delaware** won its second straight game, edging Towson 67-64 in overtime. The CAA is one of only three Division I conferences (Patriot and Summit) in which all teams have at least one win and one loss in conference play.

ROAD TEAMS ARE 13-11 IN CAA PLAY: Road teams are a combined 13-11 in CAA play this season. Home teams went 3-1 on Wednesday after visitors had gone 3-2 on each of the previous four conference play dates. **Northeastern** is 3-0 and **Hofstra** is 3-1 on the road in the CAA, and nine of the 10 teams have won at least one conference road contest. Last season, home teams went 44-28 (61.1%) in CAA play.

HOFSTRA, NORTHEASTERN AMONG BEST ON ROAD: Hofstra leads all Division I schools with seven road wins (7-4) this season. **Northeastern** is tied for second with six road victories (6-3), along with Murray State (6-1), Eastern Kentucky (6-3) and Buffalo (6-4).

TARPEY RECORDS TRIBE'S FIRST TRIPLE-DOUBLE: Junior guard/forward **Terry Tarpey** recorded the first triple-double in the 110-year history of William & Mary basketball last Saturday when he had 18 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists in a win over James Madison. It was just the seventh triple-double posted by a Division I player this season, but the second in the CAA. Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** turned in the first triple-double in Pride program history on Dec. 28 when he had 15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a victory over LIU Brooklyn.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: There are only six seniors among the CAA's top 30 in scoring, six seniors among the league's top 20 in rebounding and four seniors among the top 15 in assists. Through games of Jan. 14, there were 12 juniors, 10 sophomores and two freshmen on the list of top 30 scorers, while there were nine juniors, four sophomores and one freshman on the list of top 20 rebounders.

BUSY STRETCH OF CONFERENCE PLAY CONCLUDES: After a busy stretch of four games in eight days to open the conference schedule, all teams will play just two games per week for the next seven weeks. For the first time since 2004-05, teams are playing a double round-robin 18-game slate where all schools meet each other at home and on the road.

CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS: Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** became the Blue Hens' all-time three-pointer leader (239) on Jan. 5, passing Mike Ames (228). William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** has made 274 career treys, which ranks second in Tribe history behind only David Schneider (278). Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** ranks sixth on the Phoenix's all-time chart with 195 treys and needs five more to pass Chris Chalko for fifth place.

CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA teams are 58-63 (.479) in non-conference play. Of the 63 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, including six teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#2 Virginia, #4 Duke, #5 Villanova, #6 Louisville, #15 North Carolina and #16 West Virginia.)

MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: CAA teams have played only 48 of their 121 non-conference games (39.7%) at home and the league is a combined 31-17 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

CAA RANKED 18TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA is ranked 18th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through Jan. 14. **Northeastern** is ranked #64 in the RPI while **William & Mary** is ranked #103 and **Hofstra** is #150.

W&M'S THORNTON ON NATIONAL TOP 10 LISTS: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** ranks fourth among active Division I players in career 3-pointers made (274) and he's seventh in career scoring (1,835 points). The CAA preseason Player of the Year ranks second in the CAA in scoring (19.8 ppg) this season and has hit 51 treys. He also ranks fourth on W&M's all-time scoring list.

GREEN GETS TO THE LINE: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** has made 125 free throws this season, which is the most of any player in Division I. Maryland's Melo Trimble is second with 120. Green also ranks second in free throws attempted (150), trailing only Gardner-Webb's Jerome Hill (166). He's shooting an impressive 83.3% from the charity stripe.

CAA TEAMS AMONG NATIONAL STATS LEADERS: Several CAA teams are ranked nationally in various statistical categories through games of Jan. 14. **Hofstra** is 8th (9.4 pg) and **William & Mary** is 23rd (8.6 pg) in 3-pointers per game, while the Tribe is 22nd (39.6%) and the Pride is 23rd (39.3%) in 3-point FG percentage. Hofstra is also 17th in scoring offense (79.4 ppg). **Towson** ranks 15th in rebound margin (+8.2 rpg) and W&M is 28th in FG percentage (48.3%).

MCGLYNN RANKS 3RD NATIONALLY IN FT PERCENTAGE: Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** is an incredible 71-of-76 (93.4%) at the charity stripe, which currently ranks third in the nation. Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%.

THREE CAA PLAYERS AMONG TOP 32 IN SCORING: Three CAA players are among the nation's top 32 in scoring through games of Jan. 14. Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee** is ranked seventh with 20.8 ppg. He had a team-high 32 points at UNCW last Saturday, which was his seventh 20+-point effort of the season. W&M's **Marcus Thornton** has topped the 20-point mark in three of his last four games and is 19th in scoring (19.8 ppg) and Hofstra's **Ameen Tanksley** is 32nd (18.9 ppg).

3-POINT THREATS: The CAA features several of the nation's top three-point threats this season. W&M senior **Marcus Thornton** is 12th in 3's per game (3.19) and 15th in 3-pt percentage (46.4%). Hofstra junior **Ameen Tanksley** ranks 7th in 3-point percentage (49%), while Pride sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 17th in 3's per game (3.11) and 11th in 3-pt percentage (47.5%). Elon junior **Tanner Samson** is 17th in 3's per game (3.11).

CAA COACHES TELECONFERENCES EACH TUESDAY: The CAA weekly coaches teleconference series takes place each Tuesday at 10 a.m. through March 3. More information can be found on page 5 of this release.

HOFSTRA RANKED #21 IN MID-MAJOR POLL: CAA leader **Hofstra**, which is riding a six-game winning streak, was ranked #21 in the Jan. 12 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll. **Northeastern** (55 pts) was among others receiving votes in the poll.

THREE CAA PLAYERS NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM: Three CAA men's basketball players - College of Charleston sophomore guard **Canyon Barry**, Hofstra graduate student guard **Dion Nesmith** and UNCW senior forward **Cedrick Williams** - have been nominated for the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The prestigious award recognizes student-athletes who have made significant contributions to their communities through volunteerism and civic service.

W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season

after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93 three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team are Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton** (15.9 ppg, 10.2 rpg), who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13 after averaging 16.5 ppg, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who averaged 17.1 ppg and made the All-CAA second team in 2012-13, but missed most of last season with a knee injury, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**, who earned 3rd-team All-CAA accolades after averaging 15.4 points and 5.3 rebounds per contest.

NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: Northeastern, which returns four starters and welcomes back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, has been picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

ELON JOINS THE CAA: The CAA welcomes Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix are coming off a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** begins its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA: There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS: CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS: CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship returns to Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena on March 6-9. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.

COLL. OF CHARLESTON**6-12 Overall/1-4 CAA**

- Ended an 8-game slide with a 66-50 at Elon on Wednesday.
- Sophomore Canyon Barry hit 4-of-7 threes and scored a season-high 23 points at Elon. He has reached double figures in seven of his last 10 games, leads the team in scoring (12.0 ppg) and steals (22) and is second in rebounding (5.3 rpg).
- Joe Chealey was 6-of-8 from the floor, including 3-of-3, and tallied 17 points and 5 assists at Elon. He's averaging 11.4 ppg and ranks 6th in the CAA in assists (3.3 apg).
- Senior Anthony Stitt, who is averaging 9.4 ppg this season and has topped the 1,000-point mark in his career, is out 2-4 weeks with a knee injury. He has 10 double-figure outings in 16 games.
- Freshman Cameron Johnson scored double digits for the second time in his career with 11 points at Elon. He also made 4 steals.
- Senior Adjehi Baru scored 12 points at Elon and needs just 11 more points to reach 1,000 for his career.

DREXEL**3-12 Overall/1-3 CAA**

- Won 55-41 at Towson but lost 73-47 to W&M and 64-57 at UNCW last week.
- Junior Damion Lee averaged 22.0 ppg and 7.3 rpg for the week, including 32 points and 8 boards at UNCW. Lee tops the CAA in scoring (20.8 ppg), is 8th in rebounding (6.0 rpg) and 1st in steals (1.7 spg). He's scored double figures in 12 straight games and is 18th on Drexel's all-time scoring list.
- Junior Tavon Allen added 10 points at Towson and has tallied double digits in six of his last eight games.
- Senior Freddie Wilson scored 13 of his season-high 14 points in the 2nd half vs. TU.
- Freshman Rashann London registered 16 points and 3 assists vs. W&M and had 8 points at UNCW. He's scored double figures in four of his past eight contests.
- Sophomore Rodney Williams (7.7 ppg/8.1 rpg), is out 4-6 weeks with a stress fracture.
- Drexel tied a school record with only 3 turnovers at Towson.

DELAWARE**3-13 Overall/2-3 CAA**

- Edged Towson 67-64 in overtime on Wednesday for their second straight win.
