PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Juan'ya Green • Hofstra

Jr., G, 6-2, 195 - Philadelphia, Pa./Archbishop Carroll
Green averaged 15.0 points, 10.5 assists and 7.0 rebounds as Hofstra split two games last week. The junior guard recorded the first triple-double in Pride program history with 15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in an 88-62 victory over LIU Brooklyn on Sunday, and also recorded a double-double with 15 points and 11 assists against La Salle last Tuesday. Green has four double-doubles and his triple-double is only the sixth in Division I this season. He leads the CAA in assists (6.8 apg) and ranks fourth in scoring (17.6 ppg).



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Elijah Bryant • Elon

Fr., G, 6-4, 225 - Gwinnett, Ga./New Hampton School
Bryant averaged 19.0 points in Elon's victories over Kennesaw State (67-65) and Marist (69-64) last week. The freshman guard poured in a career-high 25 points and dished out five assists at KSU and followed with 13 points versus Marist. For the week, Bryant shot 50% (13-26) from the floor and from 3-point range (4-8). He leads all CAA freshmen in scoring with 12.5 ppg and has tallied double figures in 10 of his 13 games.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

CONFERENCE SCHEDULE OPENS ON SATURDAY: Conference play in the CAA gets started on Saturday with all 10 teams in action. For the first time since 2004-05, teams will play a double round-robin 18-game slate where all schools meet each other at home and on the road. The schedule gets off to a busy start with four conference games over an eight-day stretch between January 3-10.

FOUR FRESHMEN TOP 20-POINT MARK: Three freshmen topped the 20-point mark in games on Dec. 22. Elon guard **Elijah Bryant** poured in a career-high 25 points as the Phoenix rallied to beat Kennesaw State. Towson guard **Byron Hawkins** contributed a career-high 23 points in a 61-56 setback at Navy. Delaware guard **Chivarsky Corbett** netted a career-best 21 points in an 84-81 loss at Robert Morris. A fourth reached the mark last Tuesday as **Kory Holden** scored a career-high 27 points in a win over St. Bonaventure.

CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS: Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** has made 255 career treys, which ranks second in Tribe history behind only David Schneider (278). Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** has 226 career threes, which ranks second in Blue Hens' history behind Mike Ames (228). Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** ranks sixth on the Phoenix's all-time chart with 182 treys and needs 18 more to pass Chris Chalko for fifth place.

SOLID STARTS: As the non-conference portion of the schedule comes to a close this week, six of the CAA's 10 teams have .500 or better records. **Northeastern** (8-4) had seven wins before Christmas for the first time since 1981-82 and had its best 10-game record since 1985-86. **Hofstra** (9-4) matched its second-best nine-game start (7-2) as a Division I program. **Elon** (8-5) has won six of its last eight contests. **William & Mary** (6-5) is a perfect 5-0 at home this season. **Towson** (7-6) got off to its best eight-game start at the Division I level (7-1). **James Madison** (7-6) put together a six-game home winning streak from Nov. 17-Dec. 7. **UNCW** (5-6) had its best eight-game mark (5-3) since 2007-08.

CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA teams are 58-63 (.479) in non-conference play. Of the 63 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, including seven teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#2 Duke, #3 Virginia, #5 Louisville, #6 Villanova, #17 West Virginia, #19 North Carolina and #20 Ohio State).

MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: CAA teams have played only 48 of their 121 non-conference games (39.7%) at home and the league is a combined 31-17 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

CAA RANKED 17TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA is ranked 17th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through Jan. 1. **Northeastern** is ranked #60 in the RPI while **William & Mary** is ranked #137 and **UNCW** is #156.

W&M'S THORNTON ON NATIONAL TOP 10 LISTS: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** ranks fourth among active Division I players in career 3-pointers made (255) and he's seventh in career scoring (1,729 points). The CAA preseason Player of the Year ranks third in the CAA in scoring (19.1 ppg) this season and has hit 32 treys.

CAA TEAMS AMONG TOP 25 IN NATIONAL STATS: Several CAA teams ranked among the top 25 nationally in various statistical categories through games of Jan. 1. **Hofstra** is 4th in Division I in 3-point FG percentage (42.1%), 8th in 3-pointers per game (9.8 pg) and 15th in scoring offense (81.3 ppg). **Northeastern** is 21st in free throw percentage (74.6%). **Towson** ranks 8th in rebound margin (+10.5 rpg). **Elon** is 24th in 3-point FG percentage defense (28%).

MCGLYNN LEADS NATION IN FT PERCENTAGE: Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** was 8-for-8 at the free throw line against Fairleigh Dickinson on Monday, continuing his near-perfect accuracy. For the season, he is an incredible 66-of-69 (95.7%) at the charity stripe, **which currently leads the nation.** Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES FOR TOWSON'S DAVIS: Towson sophomore forward **John Davis** leads the CAA and is tied for 20th in Division I with six double-doubles this season. Five of them have come in the past nine games, including 10 points and 10 rebounds against Georgetown and 11 points and 14 boards at Temple. Davis is averaging 10.3 ppg and leads the CAA in rebounding with 8.6 rpg.

HOFSTRA'S 3-POINT THREATS: Hofstra features two of the nation's top three-point threats this season. Junior **Ameen Tanksley** is shooting 50.7% from beyond the arc, which ranks eighth in Division I, and he's 47th nationally with 2.85 threes per game. Sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 13th nationally with 3.3 treys per game and he's ninth in 3-point percentage (50.6%). Feeding them the ball is junior **Juan'ya Green**, who is 9th in Division I in assists (6.7 apg) and 12th in assist/turnover ratio.

CAA COACHES TELECONFERENCES BEGIN ON JAN. 6: The CAA weekly coaches teleconference series begins on Tuesday, January 6 and will continue each Tuesday through March 3. More information can be found on page 5 of this release.

TWO TEAMS RECEIVING VOTES IN MID-MAJOR POLL: Two teams were among others receiving votes in the Dec. 29 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll. **Northeastern** (28 pts) and **Hofstra** (11 pts) both got votes in the poll.

W&M'S SHAVER REACHES 500-WIN MARK: William & Mary head coach **Tony Shaver** recorded his 500th career victory as the Tribe defeated Washington College 86-46 on December 19. Shaver is the 86th coach with at least 10 years of Division I experience to win 500 or more games and is W&M's career victories leader with 142.

THREE CAA PLAYERS NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM: Three CAA men's basketball players - College of Charleston sophomore guard **Canyon Barry**, Hofstra graduate student guard **Dion Nesmith** and UNCW senior forward **Cedrick Williams** - have been nominated for the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The prestigious award recognizes student-athletes who have made significant contributions to their communities through volunteerism and civic service.

NORTHEASTERN KNOCKS OFF FLORIDA STATE: Preseason CAA favorite Northeastern earned a 76-73 win at Florida State on Nov. 18, which was the program's first victory ever over an ACC school. NU also captured its first in-season tournament since 2009 when it beat Navy (68-44) and Manhattan (65-51) to take the Hall of Fame Tipoff title on Nov. 23.

W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93 three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team are Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton** (15.9 ppg, 10.2 rpg), who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13 after averaging 16.5 ppg, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who averaged 17.1 ppg and made the All-CAA second team in 2012-13, but missed most of last season with a knee injury, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**, who earned 3rd-team All-CAA accolades after averaging 15.4 points and 5.3 rebounds per contest. NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: Northeastern, which returns four starters and welcomes back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, has been picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

LOTS OF NEW STARTERS: The CAA's 10 teams return just 44% (22-of-50) of their starters from a year ago. Preseason favorite Northeastern welcomes back four starters, while Hofstra and UNCW each return three. The league's remaining seven teams have no more than two regulars back in the lineup. In addition, only eight of the CAA's top 20 scorers are back in 2014-15 and nine of the top 20 players in rebounding.

W&M'S THORNTON ON HENSON AWARD WATCH LIST: William & Mary senior guard Marcus Thornton has been placed on the Watch List for the Lou Henson Award, which is given to the top mid-major player in the nation by CollegeInsider.com.

ELON JOINS THE CAA: The CAA welcomes Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix are coming off a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** begins its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA: There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS: CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS: CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship returns to Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena on March 6-9. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.

- Suffered a 67-40 setback at Miami (Fla.) to close non-conference play last Tuesday.
- Senior Anthony Stitt scored seven points at Miami and eclipsed the 1,000-point mark for his career. Stitt has seven double-figure outings this season and is averaging 9.8 ppg.
- Sophomore Canyon Barry was held scoreless at Miami, ending a four-game double-digit scoring streak. He's second on the team in scoring (11.1 ppg) and rebounding (5.4 rpg) and has a team-high 17 steals.
- Junior David Wishon came off the bench to contribute a career-high tying 10 points and five rebounds in 14 minutes at Miami. He had missed the previous six games.
- Sophomore Joe Chealey scored a career-high 30 points at Charlotte on Dec. 16. It was the most points by a CofC player since Andrew Lawrence in 2012. He's averaging 15.4 ppg over his last 5 games.
- The Cougars scored a season-low 40 points at Miami and were only 2-of-14 from 3-point range.

- Closed non-conference play by falling 81-62 to Iona last Sunday.
- Junior Damion Lee had a team-high 18 points, six rebounds and three assists vs. Iona. Lee leads the CAA in scoring (19.7 ppg), is 13th in rebounding (5.6 rpg) and first in steals (1.6 spg). He's scored double figures in eight straight games.
- Junior Tavon Allen hit four threes and also scored 18 points vs. Iona. Allen has tallied double digits in his last four games and is averaging 14.3 ppg over that stretch.
- Freshman Sammy Mojica chipped in 10 points against Iona after scoring a career-best 14 points vs. Penn State. He had scored just 8 points in six games prior to that.
