PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Addison Spruill • UNCW

Sr., G, 6-4, 225 - Currie, N.C./Pender

Spruill averaged 28.0 points and 7.0 rebounds as UNCW split a pair of difficult road games. The senior guard poured in a career-high 33 points on 12-of-16 FG shooting and grabbed eight rebounds in a 76-72 setback at William & Mary and scored a team-best 23 points with six boards in a 79-74 victory at Hofstra. For the week, Spruill shot 62.5% from the floor, including 5-of-8 from 3-point range, and was a perfect 11-for-11 at the free throw line. He's scored double figures in 10 straight games and is averaging 18.3 ppg in CAA play.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Tyshawn Myles • Drexel

Fr., F, 6-8, 245 - Queens, N.Y./Washington Hts. Learning School
Myles came off the bench to record a double-double with career-highs of 11 points and 11 rebounds in Drexel's 66-62 victory at Delaware on Saturday. The freshman forward entered the game with no points and four rebounds in 19 minutes over his first five CAA contests, but connected on 5-of-8 shots from the floor and grabbed six of his 11 boards on the offensive end while playing a career-high 26 minutes.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

TIGHT RACE ATOP CAA STANDINGS: The top five teams in the CAA standings are separated by just one game at the one-third mark of the conference race. **Northeastern**, which is on a four-game CAA winning streak, is in first at 5-1 heading into tonight's key game against **James Madison** (4-2). Sitting just a half-game behind the Huskies at 5-2 are **Hofstra**, which has won seven of its last nine, **UNCW**, which has won five of its last six, and **William & Mary**, which had a three-game winning streak snapped at Delaware on Wednesday. The CAA is one of six Division I conferences (Mid-American, Pac 12, Patriot, Summit and Sun Belt) in which all teams have at least one win and one loss in conference play.

ROAD TEAMS ARE 18-15 IN CAA PLAY: Road teams are a combined 18-15 in CAA play this season. Visitors have gone 3-2 on five of the seven conference play dates, with the exceptions being Jan. 14-15 when home teams were 3-2 and last night, when home teams were 2-1. Six squads are at least .500 in league road games and nine teams have won at least one conference road contest. Last season, home teams went 44-28 (61.1%) in CAA play.

HOFSTRA, NORTHEASTERN AMONG BEST ON ROAD: **Hofstra (7-4)** is tied with Gonzaga (7-1) and Rider (7-3) for the most true road wins in Division I this season. **Northeastern** is tied for fourth nationally with six road victories (6-3).

YOUTH MOVEMENT: There are only six seniors among the CAA's top 30 in scoring, six seniors among the league's top 20 in rebounding and four seniors among the top 15 in assists. Through games of Jan. 21, there were 12 juniors, 10 sophomores and two freshmen on the list of top 30 scorers, while there were nine juniors, four sophomores and one freshman on the list of top 20 rebounders.

CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS: Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** is the Blue Hens' all-time three-pointer leader (242), passing Mike Ames (228) on Jan. 5. William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** hit two threes at Delaware on Wednesday to become the Tribe's career leader with 280, passing David Schneider (278). That total also ranks 8th in CAA history. Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** moved into fifth place on Elon's career 3-pointers list with 200 after hitting five at JMU last Saturday. He needs four to pass Scot-tie Rice (204) for fourth place.

W&M'S THORNTON ON NATIONAL TOP 10 LISTS: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** ranks fourth among active Division I players in career 3-pointers made (280) and he's seventh in career scoring (1,868 points). The CAA preseason Player of the Year ranks second in the CAA in scoring (19.4 ppg) this season and has hit 57 treys. He also ranks third on W&M's all-time scoring list.

HOFSTRA'S GREEN LEADS NATION IN MADE FREE THROWS: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** has made 134 free throws this season, which is the most of any player in Division I. BYU's Tyler Haws is second with 128. Green also ranks third in free throws attempted (161), trailing Gardner-Webb's Jerome Hill (176). He's shooting an impressive 83.2% from the charity stripe.

CAA TEAMS AMONG NATIONAL STATS LEADERS: Several CAA teams are ranked nationally in various statistical categories through games of Jan. 21. **Hofstra** is 9th (9.2 pg) and **William & Mary** is 15th (9.0 pg) in 3-pointers per game, while the Tribe is 7th (41.1%) and the Pride is 32nd (38.9%) in 3-point FG percentage. Hofstra is also 17th in scoring offense (79.5 ppg). **Towson** ranks 16th in rebound margin (+8.1 rpg) and W&M is 22nd in FG percentage (48.4%).

MCGLYNN RANKS 2ND NATIONALLY IN FT PERCENTAGE: Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** is an incredible 73-of-78 (93.6%) at the charity stripe, which currently ranks second in the nation. Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%. Northeastern junior **David Walker** is shooting 88.7% (55-of-62) from the line and ranks 19th in Division I.

THREE CAA PLAYERS AMONG TOP 40 IN SCORING: Three CAA players are among the nation's top 40 in scoring through games of Jan. 21. Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee** is ranked 9th with 20.6 ppg, W&M's **Marcus Thornton** is 27th with 19.4 ppg and Hofstra's **Ameen Tanksley** is 39th with 18.4 ppg. Thornton has scored double figures in 24 consecutive games and Lee has a 15-game streak.

3-POINT THREATS: The CAA features several of the nation's top three-point threats this season. W&M senior **Marcus Thornton** is 16th in 3's per game (3.17) and 13th in 3-pt percentage (46%). Hofstra junior **Ameen Tanksley** ranks 7th in 3-point percentage (48.7%), while Pride sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 20th in 3's per game (3.1) and 10th in 3-pt percentage (47%). Elon junior **Tanner Samson** is 12th in 3's per game (3.21).

DOUBLE TRIPLE-DOUBLES: Only seven players have recorded triple-doubles in Division I basketball this season, and two of them are in the CAA. William & Mary junior **Terry Tarpey** posted the first triple-double in the 110-year history of Tribe basketball on Jan. 10 when he had 18 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists in a win over James Madison. Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** turned in the first triple-double in Pride program history on Dec. 28 when he had 15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a victory over LIU Brooklyn.

BUSY STRETCH OF CONFERENCE PLAY CONCLUDES: After a busy stretch of four games in eight days to open the conference schedule, all teams will play just two games per week over the final seven weeks. For the first time since 2004-05, teams are playing a double round-robin 18-game slate where all schools meet each other at home and on the road.

CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA teams are 58-64 (.475) in non-conference play. Of the 64 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, including six teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#2 Virginia, #4 Villanova, #5 Duke, #10 Louisville, #15 North Carolina and #18 West Virginia.)

MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: CAA teams have played only 49 of their 122 non-conference games (40.2%) at home and the league is a combined 31-18 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

CAA RANKED 18TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA is ranked 18th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through Jan. 21. **Northeastern** is ranked #83 in the RPI while **William & Mary** is ranked #114 and **UNCW** is #146.

CAA COACHES TELECONFERENCES EACH TUESDAY: The CAA weekly coaches teleconference series takes place each Tuesday at 10 a.m. through March 3. More information can be found on page 5 of this release.

THREE TEAMS RECEIVING VOTES IN MID-MAJOR POLL: Three CAA teams received votes in the Jan. 19 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll. **Northeastern** (61 pts), **Hofstra** (22 pts) and **William & Mary** (2 pts) were listed in the rankings.

THREE CAA PLAYERS NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM: Three CAA men's basketball players - College of Charleston sophomore guard **Canyon Barry**, Hofstra graduate student guard **Dion Nesmith** and UNCW senior forward **Cedrick Williams** - have been nominated for the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The prestigious award recognizes student-athletes who have made significant contributions to their communities through volunteerism and civic service.

W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93

three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team are Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton** (15.9 ppg, 10.2 rpg), who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13 after averaging 16.5 ppg, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who averaged 17.1 ppg and made the All-CAA second team in 2012-13, but missed most of last season with a knee injury, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**, who earned 3rd-team All-CAA accolades after averaging 15.4 points and 5.3 rebounds per contest.

NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: Northeastern, which returns four starters and welcomes back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, has been picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

ELON JOINS THE CAA: The CAA welcomes Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix are coming off a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** begins its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA: There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS: CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS: CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship returns to Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena on March 6-9. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.

- Fell 58-56 in overtime to UNCW on Wednesday. It was their second straight 2-point loss.
- Canyon Barry posted his first career double-double vs. UNCW with 16 points and 10 rebounds. He has reached double figures in five straight games, leads the team in scoring (12.2 ppg) and steals (24) and is second in rebounding (5.6 rpg).
- Adjehi Baru recorded his third double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds vs. UNCW. He's averaging 12.0 ppg over his last 3 games. Baru is one of 12 CofC players with at least 1,000 points and 600 rebounds.
- Joe Chealey added 8 points vs. UNCW and is averaging 16.3 ppg over his last four games. He's 16th in the CAA in scoring (11.9 ppg) and 6th in assists (3.5 apg).
- Senior Anthony Stitt, who is averaging 9.4 ppg, is out 2-4 weeks with a knee injury. He has 10 double-figure outings in 16 games.
- CofC's defense limited UNCW to a season-low 25.8% FG shooting, including 4-of-17 from 3-pt range.

DREXEL

4-14 Overall/2-5 CAA



- Dropped an 86-58 decision at Hofstra on Wednesday.
- Damion Lee poured in a team-high 27 points and grabbed 7 rebounds at Hofstra. Lee tops the CAA in scoring (20.6 ppg), is 6th in rebounding (6.2 rpg) and 1st in steals (1.7 spg). He's scored double figures in 15 straight games and has topped the 20-point mark eight times, which leads the CAA.
- Freshman Tyshawn Myles recorded his first double-double with career-highs of 11 points and 11 rebounds at Delaware and had 7 rebounds at Hofstra. Myles didn't score in Drexel's first five CAA games.
- Junior Tavon Allen scored 10 points at Hofstra, which was his 8th double-digit effort in the last 11 games.
- Freshman Sammy Mojica had 9 points, 5 rebounds and 3 assists at Hofstra.
- Sophomore Rodney Williams (7.7 ppg/8.1 rpg), is out 4-6 weeks with a stress fracture.
- Drexel was 16-of-22 (81%) at the FT line at HU and is shooting 71.2% for the season.

DELAWARE

4-14 Overall/3-4 CAA



- Rallied from a 16-point second-half deficit to defeat W&M 84-80 on Wednesday. Have won three of their last four.
- Freshman Kory Holden had a team-best 24 points and a career-high 9 assists vs. W&M. It was his fifth double-digit scoring effort in the last six games and he's averaging 7.0 apg over his past three contests.
- Senior Kyle Anderson scored a season-high 23 points vs. W&M. He's scored double figures in 10 of his 11 games and is averaging a team-best 14.8 ppg. Anderson is UD's all-time 3-point leader with 242.
- Cazmon Hayes added 13 points vs. W&M, which was his fourth straight game in double digits. He's averaging 11.8 ppg over that stretch.
