PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Ron Curry • James Madison

Jr., G, 6-4, 190 - Pennsauken, N.J./Paul VI

Curry averaged 23.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals as JMU split a pair of road games. The junior guard scored a career-high 25 points, grabbed six rebounds and made three steals as the Dukes rallied from a 14-point deficit to defeat Hofstra, 69-63. He was also 5-for-5 from three-point range and poured in a team-high 21 points at Northeastern. For the week, Curry shot 56% from the floor, including 8-of-11 from three. He recorded back-to-back 20-point outings for the first time in his career.



PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Damion Lee • Drexel

Jr., G, 6-6, 200 - Baltimore, Md./Calvert Hall

Lee averaged 24.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in Drexel's 1-1 week. The junior guard scored a team-high 21 points in a 53-51 victory over College of Charleston, including the game-winning three-pointer with 17 seconds to play. He also had a game-high 27 points and seven rebounds at Hofstra. Lee played all but two minutes in the two games and shot 40% (6-15) from 3-point range and 20-of-21 at the free throw line. He's scored double figures in 16 straight games.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Kory Holden • Delaware

Fr., G, 6-2, 180 - Salisbury, Md./J.M. Bennett

Holden averaged 18.0 points and 7.0 assists as Delaware went 1-1 last week. The freshman guard scored a team-high 24 points, handed out a career-best nine assists and made just one turnover in the Blue Hens' 84-80 win over William & Mary. He also tallied 12 points and five assists at Elon. For the week, he shot 59.1% from the floor and was 10-for-12 at the free throw line.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

TIGHT RACE ATOP CAA STANDINGS: The top five teams in the CAA standings are separated by just two games, including a tie for first place, as the conference race hits the halfway mark. **UNCW** and **William & Mary** are tie for first at 7-2. The Seahawks, who are off to their best CAA start since 2005-06, have won four in a row and seven of eight. The Tribe has captured five of its last six overall and is riding a 13-game home court winning streak. Sitting just a game back at 6-3 are **James Madison**, which has won four of its last five, and preseason favorite **Northeastern**. Alone in fifth is **Hofstra** (5-4). JMU hosts William & Mary on Saturday in a game televised by Comcast SportsNet.

OUTSTANDING EFFORTS: There were numerous outstanding individual performances in the CAA last week. Along with the numbers put up by Co-Players of the Week **Ron Curry** and **Damion Lee**, four other players averaged better than 21.0 ppg. W&M's **Omar Prewitt** averaged 24.5 ppg and 6.0 apg, including a career-high 30 points at Delaware, Delaware's **Kyle Anderson** averaged 24.0 ppg and was 8-of-17 from three, Elon's **Austin Hamilton** averaged 21.0 ppg, highlighted by a career-high 31 points against Delaware, and Towson's **John Davis** averaged 21.0 ppg and 10.5 rpg after recording a pair of double-doubles.

CLOSE CONFERENCE GAMES: There have been 19 CAA games played since January 17, and 12 have been decided by six points or less. **College of Charleston** has been involved in three straight two-point decisions, while four of **UNCW's** last five games have been decided by five points or less.

HOME TEAMS GO 4-0 ON WEDNESDAY: Home teams swept all four games on Wednesday and are a combined 24-20 in CAA play this season. Six squads are at least .500 in league road games and all 10 teams have won at least one conference road contest. Last season, home teams went 44-28 (61.1%) in CAA play.

GREEN, THORNTON ON HENSON AWARD WATCH LIST: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** and William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** are two of 40 players named to the mid-season watch list for the Lou Henson Award, which is presented to the Division I Mid-Major Player of the Year by CollegeInsider.com. The award will be presented on April 3.

HOFSTRA AMONG NATION'S BEST ON ROAD: **Hofstra** is tied for the fourth-most road wins (7-5) in Division I through games of Jan. 28. The Pride trails only Murray State (8-1), Albany (8-5) and Maryland-Eastern Shore (8-6). Other teams with seven road victories are Virginia, Gonzaga, Stephen F. Austin, Army, Rider and North Florida.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: There are only six seniors among the CAA's top 30 in scoring, six seniors among the league's top 20 in rebounding and three seniors among the top 15 in assists. Through games of Jan. 28, there were 12 juniors, 10 sophomores and two freshmen on the list of top 30 scorers, while there were nine juniors, four sophomores and one freshman on the list of top 20 rebounders.

CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS: Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** became the Tribe's career 3-point leader (283) on Jan. 21, passing David Schneider (278). That total also ranks 8th in CAA history. Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** is the Blue Hens' all-time three-pointer leader (249), passing Mike Ames (228) on Jan. 5. Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** moved into fourth on Elon's career 3-pointers list with 208 after hitting four at UNCW on Wednesday.

W&M'S THORNTON ON NATIONAL TOP 10 LISTS: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** ranks fourth among active Division I players in career 3-pointers made (283) and he's seventh in career scoring (1,905 points). The CAA preseason Player of the Year ranks second in the CAA in scoring (19.3 ppg) this season and has hit 60 treys. He also ranks third on W&M's all-time scoring list.

HOFSTRA'S GREEN RANKS SECOND IN MADE FREE THROWS: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** has made 137 free throws this season, which is the second-most of any player in

Division I. BYU's Tyler Haws leads the nation with 138. Green also ranks fourth in free throws attempted (165). He's shooting an impressive 83.0% from the charity stripe.

CAA TEAMS AMONG NATIONAL STATS LEADERS: Several CAA teams are ranked nationally in various statistical categories through games of Jan. 28. **Hofstra** is 10th (9.3 pg) and **William & Mary** is 20th (8.8 pg) in 3-pointers per game, while the Tribe is 8th (40.9%) and the Pride is 40th (38.3%) in 3-point FG percentage. Hofstra is also 17th in scoring offense (78.7 ppg). **Towson** ranks 16th in rebound margin (+8.0 rpg) and W&M is 9th in FG percentage (49.5%).

MCGLYNN LEADS NATION IN FT PERCENTAGE: Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** is an incredible 73-of-78 (93.6%) at the charity stripe, which currently leads the nation. Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%. Northeastern junior **David Walker** is shooting 89.4% (59-of-66) from the line and ranks 10th in Division I.

TWO CAA PLAYERS AMONG TOP 25 IN SCORING: Two CAA players are among the nation's top 25 in scoring through games of Jan. 28. Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee** is ranked 5th with 21.2 ppg, and W&M's **Marcus Thornton** is 24th with 19.3 ppg. Thornton has scored double figures in 26 consecutive games and Lee has a 17-game streak.

3-POINT THREATS: The CAA features several of the nation's top three-point threats this season. W&M senior **Marcus Thornton** is 22nd in 3's per game (3.0) and 17th in 3-pt percentage (44.4%). Hofstra junior **Ameen Tanksley** ranks 6th in 3-point percentage (47.1%), while Pride sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 15th in 3's per game (3.14) and 14th in 3-pt percentage (45.1%). Elon junior **Tanner Samson** is also 15th in 3's per game (3.14).

DOUBLE TRIPLE-DOUBLES: Only eight players have recorded triple-doubles in Division I basketball this season, and two of them are in the CAA. William & Mary junior **Terry Tarpey** had the first triple-double in the 110-year history of Tribe basketball on Jan. 10 when he had 18 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists in a win over James Madison. Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** turned in the first triple-double in Pride program history on Dec. 28 when he had 15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a victory over LIU Brooklyn.

CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA teams are 58-64 (.475) in non-conference play. Of the 64 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, as well as eight teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#2 Virginia, #4 Duke, #7 Villanova, #10 Louisville, #13 North Carolina, #17 West Virginia, #21 Georgetown and #23 Miami.)

MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: CAA teams have played only 49 of their 122 non-conference games (40.2%) at home and the league is a combined 31-18 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

CAA RANKED 18TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA is ranked 18th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through Jan. 28. **William & Mary** is ranked #84 in the RPI while **Northeastern** is ranked #102 and **UNCW** is #142.

W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93 three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team were Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton**, who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who made the All-CAA second team in 2012-13, but missed most of last season with a knee injury, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**, who earned 3rd-team All-CAA accolades.

NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: Northeastern, which returned four starters and welcomed back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, was picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

ELON JOINS THE CAA: The CAA welcomed Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix had a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** is in its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA: There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS: CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS: CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship returns to Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena on March 6-9. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.

- Fell 58-56 in OT to UNCW and 53-51 at Drexel last week. Have dropped three straight games by only two points.
- Canyon Barry posted his first career double-double (16pts/10reb) vs. UNCW and a team-high 16 points at DU. He has reached double figures in six straight games, leads the team in scoring (12.3 ppg) and steals (24) and is second in rebounding (5.6 rpg).
- Adjehi Baru recorded his third double-double (11pts/12reb) vs. UNCW. He's averaging 10.8 ppg over his last 4 games. Baru is one of 12 CofC players with at least 1,000 points and 600 rebounds.
- Freshman Cameron Johnson hit 3-of-3 three-pointers and scored 11 points at Drexel. It was his 3rd double-digit effort.
- Senior Anthony Stitt, who is averaging 9.4 ppg, is out 2-4 weeks with a knee injury. He has 10 double-figure outings in 16 games.
- CofC's defense held UNCW to a season-low 25.8% FG shooting and DU to 34.1%.

DREXEL

6-14 Overall/4-5 CAA



- Rallied from a 12-point deficit to defeat Northeastern 65-60 on Wednesday. Have won three of their last four games.
- Damion Lee scored a season-high 33 points vs. NU and is averaging 27.0 ppg over his last three games. Lee tops the CAA in scoring (21.2 ppg), is 8th in rebounding (6.1 rpg) and 2nd in steals (1.6 spg). He's scored double figures in 17 straight games and has 10 games with 20+ points. Lee has made 42 of his last 43 free throws.
- Junior Tavon Allen added 9 points vs. NU. He has nine double-digit efforts in the last 13 games.
- Sammy Mojica scored 10 points vs. NU and is averaging 9.7 ppg over his last 3 games.
- Freshman Tyshawn Myles is averaging 7.5 rebounds over his past four contests.
