PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

T.J. Williams • Northeastern

So., G, 6-3, 201 - Pflugerville, Texas/Pflugerville
Williams averaged 16.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists in Northeastern's two road victories last week. The sophomore guard scored 15 of his career-high 20 points in the second half of a 58-57 triumph at Richmond, including a game-winning trey with 18 seconds left. He also had six rebounds and six assists vs. the Spiders. Williams followed with 12 points, five boards and four assists as the Huskies defeated Delaware 72-53 in their CAA opener. For the week, Williams shot 52.4% from the floor, including 7-of-9 from beyond the arc.



PLAYER AND ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Elijah Bryant • Elon

Fr., G, 6-4, 225 - Gwinnett, Ga./New Hampton School
In Elon's inaugural CAA game, Bryant poured in a career-high 32 points and grabbed a season-best seven rebounds as the Phoenix posted a 77-67 road victory over Drexel on Saturday. It was the most points by an Elon player since 2012 and was Bryant's third game with 20+ points this season. He finished 10-of-20 from the floor, including 3-of-4 from three, and made 9-of-10 at the free throw line. He leads all CAA freshmen in scoring with 13.9 ppg.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

BUSY STRETCH OF CONFERENCE PLAY CONCLUDES: Conference play in the CAA resumes on Saturday with all 10 squads in action, concluding a stretch of four games in eight days. For the first time since 2004-05, teams will play a double round-robin 18-game slate where all schools meet each other at home and on the road.

ROAD TEAMS GO 9-6 IN CAA PLAY: Away teams have won nine of the 15 conference games played thus far. **Hofstra** and **Northeastern** are both 2-0 on the road in league play, while **Drexel**, **Elon**, **James Madison**, **UNCW** and **William & Mary** each have one road victory. Last season, home teams went 44-28 (61.1%) in conference play.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: There are only six seniors among the CAA's top 30 in scoring, six seniors among the league's top 20 in rebounding and three seniors among the top 15 in assists. Through games of Jan. 9, there were 11 juniors, 10 sophomores and three freshmen on the list of top 30 scorers, while there were nine juniors, five sophomores and one freshman on the list of top 20 rebounders.

FRESHMEN MAKING AN IMPACT: Freshmen are making a big impact for several CAA teams this season. Five freshmen have topped the 20-point mark in a game over the past few weeks. UNCW guard **Jordon Talley** netted a career-high 21 points in a victory at Northeastern on Monday. Elon guard **Elijah Bryant** poured in a career-high 32 points at Drexel last Saturday and had 25 points in a win over William & Mary on Thursday. Delaware guard **Kory Holden** tallied a career-best 27 points in a victory over St. Bonaventure on Dec. 30 and scored 25 at UNCW on Thursday. On Dec. 22, Towson guard **Byron Hawkins** contributed a career-high 23 points at Navy and Delaware guard **Chivarsky Corbett** netted a career-best 21 points at Robert Morris. Hofstra forward **Rokas Gustys** recorded his first double-double with 11 points and a career-high 16 rebounds in a win over Delaware last Monday. Gustys has been limited to nine games due to injury, but has had 10 or more caroms in five of them.

CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS: Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** hit three treys last Monday to become the Blue Hens' all-time three-pointer leader (233), passing Mike Ames (228). William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** has made 264 career treys, which ranks second in Tribe history behind only David Schneider (278). Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** ranks sixth on the Phoenix's all-time chart with 193 treys and needs seven more to pass Chris Chalko for fifth place.

CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA teams are 58-63 (.479) in non-conference play. Of the 63 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, including seven teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#2 Duke, #3 Virginia, #5 Louisville, #8 Villanova, #14 West Virginia, #18 North Carolina and #22 Ohio State).

MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: CAA teams have played only 48 of their 121 non-conference games (39.7%) at home and the league is a combined 31-17 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

CAA RANKED 18TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA is ranked 18th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through Jan. 8. **Northeastern** is ranked #80 in the RPI while **William & Mary** is ranked #121 and **Hofstra** is #163.

W&M'S THORNTON ON NATIONAL TOP 10 LISTS: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** ranks fourth among active Division I players in career 3-pointers made (264) and he's seventh in career scoring (1,789 points). The CAA preseason Player of the Year ranks second in the CAA in scoring (19.3 ppg) this season and has hit 41 treys.

CAA TEAMS AMONG TOP 25 IN NATIONAL STATS: Several CAA teams ranked among the top 25 nationally in various statistical categories through games of Jan. 6. **Hofstra** is 12th in 3-pointers per game (9.1 pg) and 19th in scoring offense (79.2 ppg). **Northeastern** is 21st in free throw percentage (74.9%). **Towson** ranks 13th in rebound margin (+9.5 rpg), while **William & Mary** is 25th in field goal percentage (48.2%).

MCGLYNN RANKS SECOND IN NATIONALLY IN FT PERCENTAGE: Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** was 1-for-2 at the free throw line against Drexel on Thursday, continuing his near-perfect accuracy. For the season, he is an incredible 71-of-76 (93.4%) at the charity stripe, **which currently ranks second in the nation**. Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%.

DREXEL'S LEE RANKED 14TH NATIONALLY IN SCORING: Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee** is ranked 14th nationally in scoring with 20.0 ppg. He had a team-high 29 points against Elon last Saturday, which was his sixth 20+-point effort of the season. W&M's **Marcus Thornton** is 29th in scoring (19.3 ppg) and Hofstra's **Ameen Tanksley** is 37th (18.8 ppg).

HOFSTRA'S 3-POINT THREATS: Hofstra features two of the nation's top three-point threats this season. Junior **Ameen Tanksley** is shooting 47.8% from beyond the arc, which ranks 9th in Division I, while sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 22nd nationally with 3.0 treys per game and 17th in 3-point percentage (46.6%). Feeding them the ball is junior **Juan'ya Green**, who is 15th in Division I in assists (6.1 apg). Green is the only player in the nation to be averaging at least 17.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 6.0 assists per contest.

CAA COACHES TELECONFERENCES EACH TUESDAY: The CAA weekly coaches teleconference series takes place each Tuesday at 10 a.m. through March 3. More information can be found on page 5 of this release.

TWO TEAMS RECEIVING VOTES IN MID-MAJOR POLL: Two teams were among others receiving votes in the Jan. 5 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll. **Northeastern** (51 pts) and **Hofstra** (17 pts) both got votes in the poll.

W&M'S SHAVER REACHES 500-WIN MARK: William & Mary head coach **Tony Shaver** recorded his 500th career victory as the Tribe defeated Washington College 86-46 on December 19. Shaver is the 86th coach with at least 10 years of Division I experience to win 500 or more games and is W&M's career victories leader with 144.

THREE CAA PLAYERS NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM: Three CAA men's basketball players - College of Charleston sophomore guard **Canyon Barry**, Hofstra graduate student guard **Dion Nesmith** and UNCW senior forward **Cedrick Williams** - have been nominated for the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The prestigious award recognizes student-athletes who have made significant contributions to their communities through volunteerism and civic service.

NORTHEASTERN KNOCKS OFF FLORIDA STATE: Preseason CAA favorite Northeastern earned a 76-73 win at Florida State on Nov. 18, which was the program's first victory ever over an ACC school. NU also captured its first in-season tournament since 2009 when it beat Navy (68-44) and Manhattan (65-51) to take the Hall of Fame Tipoff title on Nov. 23.

W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93 three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team are Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton** (15.9 ppg, 10.2 rpg), who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13 after averaging 16.5 ppg, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who averaged 17.1 ppg and made the All-CAA second

team in 2012-13, but missed most of last season with a knee injury, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**, who earned 3rd-team All-CAA accolades after averaging 15.4 points and 5.3 rebounds per contest. A complete listing of the preseason All-CAA teams can be found in this release.

NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: Northeastern, which returns four starters and welcomes back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, has been picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

W&M'S THORNTON ON HENSON AWARD WATCH LIST: William & Mary senior guard Marcus Thornton has been placed on the Watch List for the Lou Henson Award, which is given to the top mid-major player in the nation by CollegeInsider.com.

ELON JOINS THE CAA: The CAA welcomes Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix are coming off a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** begins its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA: There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS: CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS: CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship returns to Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena on March 6-9. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.

- Sophomore Canyon Barry tied his season-high with 21 points vs. Hofstra and also grabbed 7 rebounds. He has reached double figures in five of his last eight games, leads the team in scoring (11.3 ppg) and steals (22) and is second in rebounding (5.3 rpg).
- Senior Anthony Stitt, who recently topped the 1,000-point mark for his career, scored 10 points vs. JMU and 11 against Hofstra. He has 10 double-figure outings this season.

- Junior Damion Lee had a team-high 18 points, 7 rebounds and 3 steals vs. W&M and a team-best 16 points and 7 boards at TU. Lee tops the CAA in scoring (20.0 ppg), is 11th in rebounding (5.9 rpg) and first in steals (1.7 spg). He's scored double figures in 11 straight games.
- Junior Tavon Allen added 10 points at Towson and has tallied double digits in six of his last seven games.
- Senior Freddie Wilson scored 13 of his season-high 14 points in the 2nd half vs. TU.
- Freshman Rashann London played all 40 minutes vs. W&M and registered 16 points and 3 assists. He's scored double figures in four of his past seven contests.

- Freshman Kory Holden led UD with 25 points, 7 rebounds and 4 assists at UNCW. He's 11th in the CAA in scoring (11.3 ppg) and 3rd in assists (4.0 apg). It was his 6th double-digit effort in the past eight games.
- Senior Kyle Anderson scored a team-high 16 points at Hofstra and 11 at UNCW. He became UD's all-time 3-point leader with 233. Anderson has scored double figures in all seven of his games this season and is averaging a team-best 14.4 ppg.
- Freshman Chivarsky Corbett had 11 points off the bench at Hofstra. He has six double-digit efforts in the past nine games.
