PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Ron Curry • James Madison

Jr., G, 6-4, 190 - Pennsauken, N.J./Paul VI
Curry averaged 24.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists in JMU's two games last week. The junior guard scored a career-high 27 points in a 63-61 victory at Towson, including a game-winning 18-footer at the buzzer. He also contributed a team-best 21 points, six rebounds and four assists versus UNCW. For the week, Curry was 7-of-13 from 3-point range and 17-of-21 at the free throw line. He's scored 15 or more points in six straight games and has reached double figures in 11 consecutive contests.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Sammy Mojica • Drexel

Fr., G, 6-3, 175 - Chelsea, Mass./Brimmer & May School
Mojica averaged 10.5 points and 4.0 rebounds off the bench to help Drexel win a pair of road games last week. The freshman guard tallied 14 points in a 67-63 triumph at Elon and had seven points and six rebounds in a 59-45 victory at CofC. For the week he shot 44% from the floor, including 3-of-6 from 3-point range. He's averaging 11.6 ppg over his past five contests.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Joey McLean • James Madison

Fr., G, 6-0, 160 - Greensboro, N.C./High Point Christian
McLean averaged 12.5 points and 2.5 rebounds in JMU's 1-1 week. The freshman guard set a career-high with 11 points against UNCW and then topped it by scoring 14 points in his first collegiate start as the Dukes edged Towson on the road. For the week, McLean shot 50% (7-of-14) from the floor and was 9-of-10 at the free throw line.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

TRIBE ATOP CROWDED CAA STANDINGS: Six teams are within two games of first place in the CAA standings with just six games to play. **William & Mary** regained sole possession of first place after a 56-53 victory at UNCW last Saturday. The Tribe (9-3), which has won four of its last five, has been extremely efficient offensively and is shooting 52% from the floor, 41.9% from three and 77.4% from the FT line in CAA play. **UNCW** and **Northeastern** are tied for second at 8-4 despite both suffering home losses last Saturday. The Seahawks, who have won five of their last seven, and the Huskies meet on Saturday night in Wilmington. **James Madison** and **Drexel** improved to 8-5 with victories on Tuesday night, while **Hofstra** is just a half-game back at 7-5.

CLOSE CONFERENCE GAMES: There have been 37 CAA games played since January 17, and 19 have been decided by six points or less. **Delaware** has had eight of its past 11 contests with a margin of six points or less. Seven of **College of Charleston's** last 10 games have been decided by six points or less. Five of **UNCW's** last eight games have been decided by five points or less. Eight of **Towson's** 13 CAA games have had margins of 4 points or less.

STREAKING: **William & Mary** is riding a 13-game home court winning streak, including a 10-0 mark this season. The Tribe's streak is the 16th-longest in Division I currently. **Drexel** has won six consecutive games, which is tied for the 11th-longest active streak in Division I. The Dragons' streak is their longest since winning 19 in a row in 2012.

ROAD TEAMS DOING WELL IN CAA PLAY: Road teams have posted an 8-4 mark over the past 10 days and home teams are only 32-30 (51.6%) in CAA play this season. Six squads have winning records in league road games and all 10 teams have won at least one conference road contest. Last season, home teams went 44-28 (61.1%) in CAA play.

TWO CAA PLAYERS AMONG TOP 30 IN SCORING: Two CAA players are among the nation's top 30 in scoring through games of Feb. 8. Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee** is ranked 5th with 21.1 ppg, and W&M's **Marcus Thornton** is 29th with 19.0 ppg. Thornton has scored double figures in 29 consecutive games and Lee has a 21-game streak.

3-POINT THREATS: The CAA features several of the nation's top three-point threats this season. Elon junior **Tanner Samson** ranks 7th in 3's per game (3.24). W&M senior **Marcus Thornton** is 31st in 3's per game (2.83) and 20th in 3-pt percentage (43%). Hofstra junior **Ameen Tanksley** ranks 3rd in 3-point percentage (47.4%), while Pride sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 25th in 3's per game (2.92) and 26th in 3-pt percentage (42.4%).

MCGLYNN RANKED #4 NATIONALLY IN FT PERCENTAGE: Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** is 100-of-108 (92.6%) at the charity stripe, which currently ranks fourth in the nation. Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%. Drexel junior **Damion Lee** is 19th at 87.7%.

GREEN, THORNTON ON HENSON AWARD WATCH LIST: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** and William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** are two of 40 players named to the mid-season watch list for the Lou Henson Award, which is presented to the Division I Mid-Major Player of the Year by ColleagueInsider.com. The award will be presented on April 3.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: There are only five seniors among the CAA's top 30 in scoring, six seniors among the league's top 20 in rebounding and two seniors among the top 15 in assists. Through games of Feb. 10, there were 12 juniors, 10 sophomores and three freshmen on the list of top 30 scorers, while there were 10 juniors and four sophomores on the list of top 20 rebounders.

CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS: Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** became the Tribe's career 3-point leader (288) on Jan. 21, passing David Schneider (278). That total also ranks 8th in CAA history. Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** is the Blue Hens' all-time three-point leader (258), passing Mike Ames (228) on Jan. 5. Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** ranks fourth on Elon's career three-pointers list with 220.

W&M'S THORNTON ON NATIONAL & CAA LISTS: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** ranks fourth among active Division I players in career 3-pointers made (288) and he's eighth in career scoring (1,955 points). He's also eighth on the CAA's career treys chart and 14th on the career scoring list. This season, he ranks second in the CAA in scoring (19.0 ppg) and has hit 65 treys.

HOFSTRA'S GREEN SECOND IN NATION IN MADE FREE THROWS: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** has made 165 free throws this season, which is the second-most of any player in Division I. BYU's Tyler Haws leads the nation with 167. Green also ranks third in free throws attempted (198). He's shooting an impressive 83.3% from the charity stripe. Green also ranks 7th nationally in assists (6.4 apg).

CAA TEAMS AMONG NATIONAL STATS LEADERS: Several CAA teams are ranked in the top 20 nationally in various statistical categories through games of Feb. 10. **William & Mary** ranks 7th nationally in FG percentage (49.7%). **Hofstra** is 11th (9.2 pg) and W&M is 24th (8.4 pg) in threes per game, while the Tribe is 14th (40.2%) in 3-point FG percentage. Hofstra is also 18th in scoring offense (78.5 ppg). **Towson** ranks 6th in rebound margin (+8.9 rpg).

DOUBLE TRIPLE-DOUBLES: Only eight players have recorded triple-doubles in Division I basketball this season, and two of them are in the CAA. William & Mary junior **Terry Tarpey** had the first triple-double in the 110-year history of Tribe basketball on Jan. 10 when he had 18 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists in a win over James Madison. Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** turned in the first triple-double in Pride program history on Dec. 28 when he had 15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a victory over LIU Brooklyn.

HOFSTRA AMONG NATION'S BEST ON ROAD: Hofstra is tied for the fifth-most road wins (8-5) in Division I through games of Feb. 10. Albany leads the nation at 10-5, followed by Gonzaga (9-1), Murray State (9-1) and MD-Eastern Shore (9-8). The Pride is tied with Virginia (8-0), Stephen F. Austin (8-2), Harvard (8-3), UC Davis (8-4), Rider (8-4), Yale (8-5) and St. Francis NY (8-5).

CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA teams are 58-64 (.475) in non-conference play. Of the 64 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, as well as eight teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#2 Virginia, #4 Duke, #6 Villanova, #9 Louisville, #12 North Carolina, #21 West Virginia and #23 Ohio State.)

MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: CAA teams have played only 49 of their 122 non-conference games (40.2%) at home and the league is a combined 31-18 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

CAA RANKED 18TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA is ranked 18th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through Feb. 10. **William & Mary** is ranked #77 in the RPI while **Northeastern** is ranked #122 and **UNCW** is #146.

CAA COACHES TELECONFERENCES EACH TUESDAY: The CAA weekly coaches teleconference series takes place each Tuesday at 10 a.m. through March 3. More information can be found on page 5 of this release.

THREE CAA PLAYERS NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM: Three CAA men's basketball players - College of Charleston sophomore guard **Canyon Barry**, Hofstra graduate student guard **Dion Nesmith** and UNCW senior forward **Cedrick Williams** - have been nominated for the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The prestigious award recognizes student-athletes who have made significant contributions to their communities through volunteerism and civic service.

W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93

three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team were Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton**, who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who made the All-CAA second team in 2012-13, but missed most of last season with a knee injury, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**, who earned 3rd-team All-CAA accolades.

NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: Northeastern, which returned four starters and welcomed back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, was picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

ELON JOINS THE CAA: The CAA welcomed Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix had a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** is in its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA: There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS: CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS: CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship returns to Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena on March 6-9. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.

- Ended a 5-game slide with an 80-72 victory over W&M, but fell 59-45 to Drexel. Seven of 10 CAA losses have been by 6 pts. or less.
- Canyon Barry tallied team-highs of 19 points and 6 rebounds vs. W&M. He has reached double figures in 9 of his last 10 games, leads the team in scoring (12.6 ppg) and steals, and is 2nd in rebounding (5.5 rpg).
- Anthony Stitt returned after missing 7 games with a knee injury and had 10 points, 5 assists and 3 steals vs. W&M and a team-high 15 points against Drexel.
- Adjehi Baru tallied 12 points on 5-5 FG shooting vs. W&M and grabbed 6 rebounds vs. DU. He's seventh in the CAA with 6.2 rpg.
- Joe Chealey contributed 16 points and 5 rebounds vs. W&M and scored 11 vs. DU. He's reached double digits in 4 straight games and is averaging 14.2 ppg over that stretch.
- CofC shot a season-best 54.5% from the floor and had five players score double figures for the first time this season vs. W&M, but shot a season-low 29.1% vs. Drexel.

- Damion Lee hit 11-of-11 FT's and scored a team-high 23 points vs. TU. Lee tops the CAA in scoring (21.1 ppg) and is 6th in rebounds (6.3 rpg). He's scored double digits in 21 straight games and has 12 games with 20+ points. Lee has made 69 of his last 74 FT's (93.2%).
