## CAA WEEKLY AWARDS

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

**Scott Eatherton • Northeastern**

Sr., F, 6-9, 234 - Hershey, Pa./Hershey

Eatherton averaged 23.5 points and 8.5 rebounds while shooting 69.6% from the floor in Northeastern's two road games last week. The senior forward scored a season-high 24 points on 8-of-10 FG shooting and grabbed nine boards in a 79-68 triumph at Hofstra last Thursday and followed with 23 points and eight rebounds in a 66-61 setback at UNCW. Eatherton is shooting a league-best 60.1% from the floor this season and has scored 20+ points four times in CAA play.



### ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

**Jordon Talley • UNCW**

Fr., G, 6-0, 180 - Richmond, Va./Henrico

Talley averaged 16.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 assists as UNCW moved into a tie for first place with two wins last week. The freshman guard scored a team-high 18 points and snared six rebounds as the Seahawks rallied past College of Charleston 58-45 and added 14 points in a 66-61 victory over Northeastern. For the week, Talley shot 52.9% from the floor and made 13-of-17 at the free throw line.

## CONFERENCE NOTES:

**TIGHT RACE ATOP CAA STANDINGS:** Five teams are separated by 1.5 games atop the CAA standings. **UNCW** and **Northeastern** are tied for first at 11-5 after the Seahawks held off Towson 73-69 and the Huskies edged Drexel 83-73 in OT on Saturday. **James Madison** and **William & Mary** are just a half-game behind at 10-5 heading into games on Sunday. The CAA was the only conference in the nation to feature a four-team tie for first place entering the weekend. **Hofstra** is just a game back of JMU and W&M at 9-6 heading into its game with the Tribe on NBC Sports Network. The CAA is one of only two Division I leagues (Big South) with five teams separated by only 1.5 games at the top.

**HISTORIC BALANCE:** This will be the first time in 18 years that the CAA regular-season champion has had at least five losses in conference play. The last time the first-place team in the CAA had more than four setbacks was 1996-97 when Old Dominion and UNCW shared the league title with a 10-6 mark.

**CLOSE CONFERENCE GAMES:** There have been 53 CAA games played since January 17, and 27 have been decided by six points or less or in OT. **Delaware** has had 10 of its past 14 games with a margin of six points or less. Eight of **College of Charleston's** last 13 games have been decided by six points or less. Seven of **UNCW's** last 12 games have been decided by five points or less. Eleven of **Towson's** 16 CAA games have had margins of 5 points or less.

**ROAD TEAMS DOING WELL IN CAA PLAY:** Road teams have posted a 16-12 mark over the past three weeks and home teams are just 40-38 (51.3%) in CAA play this season. Six squads are .500 or better in league road games, led by **James Madison (6-2)** and **Hofstra (6-2)**. All 10 teams have won at least one conference road contest and eight have won three or more. Last season, home teams went 44-28 (61.1%) in CAA play.

**PERFECT FROM THE FLOOR:** Hofstra senior center **Moussa Kone** scored a career-high 23 points on perfect 10-for-10 field goal shooting in last Sunday's win at Drexel. It was just the seventh time in CAA history that a player has gone 10-for-10 or better in a game. Northeastern's **Scott Eatherton** was also 10-for-10 against Towson on January 10, 2015. The best performance in CAA history came on March 7, 1985 when Navy All-American and future Hall of Famer David Robinson was 12-for-12 against East Carolina.

**TWO CAA PLAYERS AMONG TOP 25 IN SCORING:** Two CAA players are among the nation's top 25 in scoring through games of Feb. 19. Drexel junior **Damion Lee** is ranked 6th with 21.4 ppg, and W&M senior **Marcus Thornton** is 25th with 19.1 ppg. Thornton has scored double figures in 32 consecutive games and Lee has a 24-game streak.

**3-POINT THREATS:** The CAA features several of the nation's top three-point threats this season. Elon junior **Tanner Samson** ranks 15th in 3's per game (3.14). W&M senior **Marcus Thornton** is 24th in 3's per game (2.96) and 28th in 3-pt percentage (41.8%). Hofstra sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 35th in 3's per game (2.75) and 26th in 3-pt percentage (42.1%).

**MCGLYNN RANKED #6 NATIONALLY IN FT PERCENTAGE:** Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** is 115-of-125 (92%) at the charity stripe, which currently ranks sixth in the nation. Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%. Drexel junior **Damion Lee** is close behind in 15th at 88.6%.

**GREEN, THORNTON ON AWARDS LISTS:** Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** and William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** are two of 40 players named to the mid-season watch list for the Lou Henson Award, which is presented to the Division I Mid-Major Player of the Year by Colleg Insider.com. The award will be presented on April 3. Thornton is also one of 16 finalists for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year award, which is presented to the nation's top shooting guard by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** There are only six seniors among the CAA's top 30 in scoring, five seniors among the league's top 20 in rebounding and three seniors among the top 15 in assists. Through games of Feb. 21, there were 12 juniors, 10 sophomores and two freshmen on the list of top 30 scorers, while there were 10 juniors, five sophomores and one freshman on the list of top 20 rebounders.

**CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS:** Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** became the Tribe's career 3-point leader (300) on Jan. 21, passing David Schneider (278). That total also ranks 6th in CAA history. Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** is the Blue Hens' all-time three-point leader (266), passing Mike Ames (228) on Jan. 5. Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** ranks fourth on Elon's career three-pointers list with 231 and set the school record for 3-pointers in a season with 92.

**W&M'S THORNTON ON NATIONAL & CAA LISTS:** William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** ranks fourth among active Division I players in career 3-pointers made (300) and he's sixth in career scoring (2,016 points). He's also sixth on the CAA's career treys chart and 12th on the CAA career scoring list. This season, he ranks second in the CAA in scoring (19.1 ppg) and has hit 77 treys.

**HOFSTRA'S GREEN LEADS NATION IN MADE FREE THROWS:** Hofstra guard **Juan'ya Green** has made 183 free throws this season, which is tied with BYU's Tyler Haws for the most of any player in Division I. Drexel's Damion Lee is sixth with 164 made free throws. Green ranks third in free throws attempted (218). He's shooting an impressive 83.9% from the charity stripe. Green also ranks 8th nationally in assists (6.6 apg).

**CAA TEAMS AMONG NATIONAL STATS LEADERS:** Several CAA teams are ranked in the top 25 nationally in various statistical categories through games of Feb. 19. **William & Mary** ranks 8th nationally in FG percentage (49.4%) and **Northeastern** is 23rd (47.8%). **Hofstra** is 15th (8.9 pg) in 3's per game, while the Tribe is 20th in 3's per game (8.7) and 12th in 3-point FG% (40.3%). Hofstra is also 16th in scoring offense (78.5 ppg). **Towson** ranks 7th in rebound margin (+8.6 rpg).

**HOFSTRA AMONG NATION'S BEST ON ROAD:** **Hofstra** is tied for the 2nd-most road wins (10-5) in Division I through games of Feb. 19. Albany leads the nation at 11-5, and the Pride is tied with Gonzaga (10-1), Murray State (10-1), Rider (10-4) and Yale (10-5).

**DOUBLE TRIPLE-DOUBLES:** Only eight players have recorded triple-doubles in Division I basketball this season, and two of them are in the CAA. William & Mary junior **Terry Tarpey** had the first triple-double in the 110-year history of Tribe basketball on Jan. 10 when he had 18 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists in a win over James Madison. Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** turned in the first triple-double in Pride program history on Dec. 28 when he had 15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a victory over LIU Brooklyn.

**CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY:** CAA teams are 58-64 (.475) in non-conference play. Of the 64 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, as well as eight teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#2 Virginia, #4 Duke, #6 Villanova, #12 Louisville, #15 North Carolina, #23 West Virginia and #24 Ohio State.)

**MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS:** CAA teams have played only 49 of their 122 non-conference games (40.2%) at home and the league is a combined 31-18 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

**CAA RANKED 18TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES:** The CAA is ranked 18th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through Feb. 18. **Northeastern** is ranked #98 in the RPI while **William & Mary** is ranked #105 and **James Madison** is #150.

**CAA COACHES TELECONFERENCES EACH TUESDAY:** The CAA weekly coaches teleconference series takes place each Tuesday at 10 a.m. through March 3. More information can be found on page 5 of this release.

**THREE CAA PLAYERS NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM:** Three CAA men's basketball players - College of Charleston sophomore guard **Canyon Barry**, Hofstra graduate student guard **Dion Nesmith** and UNCW senior forward **Cedrick Williams** - have been nominated for the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The prestigious award recognizes student-athletes who have made significant contributions to their communities through volunteerism and civic service.

**W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM:** William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93 three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team were Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton**, who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who made the All-CAA second team in 2012-13, but missed most of last season with a knee injury, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**, who earned 3rd-team All-CAA accolades.

**NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE:** Northeastern, which returned four starters and welcomed back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, was picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

**ELON JOINS THE CAA:** The CAA welcomed Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix had a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** is in its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

**TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA:** There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

**PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS:** CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

**NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS:** CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

**CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE:** The CAA Men's Basketball Championship returns to Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena on March 6-9. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

**OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE:** The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.

- Ended a 3-game slide with a 77-63 victory over Elon on Wednesday.
- Canyon Barry hit 4-of-7 threes and scored a team-high 22 points vs. Elon. It was his fifth 20+ point effort and his 12th time in double figures in the last 13 games. Barry leads the team in scoring (12.8 ppg) and steals (33), and is 2nd in rebounding (5.4 rpg).
- Joe Chealey added 16 points and tied a career high with 9 rebounds vs. Elon. He's reached double digits in 7 straight games and is averaging 14.0 ppg over that stretch.
- Anthony Stitt returned on Feb. 5 after missing 7 games with a knee injury. He's averaged 8.6 ppg since coming back. Stitt is one assist shy of 300 for his career.
- Adjehi Baru tallied 8 points and 7 rebounds vs. Elon. Baru ranks fifth in the CAA in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and is 15 rebounds shy of 900 for his career.
- CofC shot a season-high 56.3% from the floor against Elon and recorded its third-highest point total of the season.

- Suffered narrow losses at JMU (82-78) and Northeastern (83-73 in OT) last week.
- Damion Lee averaged 28.0 ppg and 5.5 rpg last week, including 30 points at NU. Lee tops the CAA in scoring (21.1 ppg), has tallied double digits in 24 straight games, has 14 games with 20+ points and four with 30+ points. He's 34-of-35 at the line over the past 4 games and has hit 92 of his last 98.
