PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

David Walker • Northeastern

Jr., G, 6-6, 196 - Stow, Ohio/Stow-Munroe Falls
Walker averaged 23.0 points, 5.5 assists and 4.0 rebounds as Northeastern went 2-0 to remain tied atop the CAA standings. The junior guard scored a team-high 21 points and dished out seven assists in a 75-64 victory over William & Mary and followed with a career-best 25 points, including 11 in overtime, as the Huskies edged Drexel 83-73. For the week, Walker shot 66.7% from the floor, including 5-of-8 from 3-point range, was 17-of-18 at the free throw line and played all 85 minutes.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Elijah Bryant • Elon

Fr., G, 6-4, 225 - Gwinnett, Ga./New Hampton School
Bryant had a strong all-around week, averaging 15.0 points, 5.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists as Elon split a pair of road games. The freshman guard narrowly missed a double-double with 10 points, a team-high nine rebounds and five assists in an 83-75 overtime win at Delaware and contributed 20 points and three steals against College of Charleston. Bryant has scored double figures in 23 of Elon's 29 contests.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Greg Malinowski • William & Mary

Fr., G/F, 6-5, 205 - Chantilly, Va./Episcopal
Malinowski averaged 10.0 points while shooting 77.8% from the floor, including 5-of-7 from 3-point range, in W&M's two difficult road games. The freshman scored 11 points in only his second career start in an 80-78 triumph at Hofstra and drained three treys for nine points at Northeastern. Malinowski, who was filling in for injured starter Daniel Dixon, had scored just 17 points in his previous seven games before last week.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

TIGHT RACE ATOP CAA STANDINGS: The CAA features one of the most competitive regular-season races in the nation as the top four teams are separated by just one game heading into Saturday's regular-season finales. **UNCW** and **William & Mary** are tied for first at 12-5 after the Seahawks snapped JMU's five-game win streak with a 74-54 victory and the Tribe topped Towson 65-50 on Wednesday. **Northeastern**, which lost 72-65 at Elon on Thursday, and **James Madison** are a game back with an 11-6 mark. W&M captured its last regular-season crown in 1997-98, JMU won its last title in 1999-2000, UNCW's most recent first-place finish came in 2005-06 and NU claimed its only regular-season championship in 2012-13. **There hasn't been a tie for the CAA regular-season championship since 2005-06 and the conference has never had more than two teams finish in a first-place tie.**

HISTORIC BALANCE: This will be the first time in 18 years that the CAA regular-season champion has had at least five losses in conference play. The last time the first-place team in the CAA had more than four setbacks was 1996-97 when Old Dominion and UNCW shared the league title with a 10-6 mark.

CLOSE CONFERENCE GAMES: There have been 60 CAA games played since January 17, and 28 have been decided by six points or less or in OT. Ten of **Delaware's** past 15 games have been decided by six points or less or OT. Eight of **College of Charleston's** last 14 games have been decided by six points or less. Seven of **UNCW's** last 13 games have been decided by five points or less. Eleven of **Towson's** 17 CAA games have had margins of 5 points or less.

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship returns to Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena on March 6-9. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

ROAD TEAMS DOING WELL IN CAA PLAY: Road teams have posted an 18-17 mark over the past three-and-a-half weeks and home teams are just 45-40 (52.9%) in CAA play this season. Seven squads are .500 or better in league road games, led by **Hofstra (6-2)** and **James Madison (6-3)**. All 10 teams have won at least one conference road contest and eight have won three or more. Last season, home teams went 44-28 (61.1%) in CAA play.

THORNTON BECOMES W&M'S ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** became the school's all-time leading scorer on Wednesday with 2,062 points. He broke the oldest Division I scoring record in the country, which was set by Chet Giermak (2,052 pts) back in 1950. Thornton ranks third among all active NCAA Division I players in career 3-pointers made (305) and he's sixth in career scoring. He's also sixth on the CAA's career treys chart and 11th on the CAA career scoring list.

DREXEL'S LEE OUT FOR THE SEASON: Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who leads the CAA and ranks fourth nationally in scoring with 21.4 ppg, is out for the season after suffering a fracture in his right hand during last Saturday's game at Northeastern. Lee, who reached the 30-point mark for the fourth time against the Huskies, finished with 578 points, which is the 8th-highest season total in school history. He also ranks 10th on the Dragons' career scoring list with 1,538 points.

TWO CAA PLAYERS AMONG TOP 25 IN SCORING: Two CAA players are among the nation's top 30 in scoring through games of Feb. 24. Drexel's **Damion Lee** is ranked 4th with 21.4 ppg, and W&M's **Marcus Thornton** is 22nd with 19.4 ppg. Thornton has scored double figures in 34 consecutive games and Lee, who is out for the season, has a 24-game streak.

3-POINT THREATS: The CAA features several of the nation's top three-point threats this season. Elon junior **Tanner Samson** ranks 13th in 3's per game (3.17). W&M senior **Marcus Thornton** is 23rd in 3's per game (2.93) and 34th in 3-pt percentage (41.2%). Hofstra sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 35th in 3's per game (2.77) and 29th in 3-pt percentage (41.7%).

MCGLYNN RANKED #3 NATIONALLY IN FT PERCENTAGE: Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** is 117-of-127 (92.1%) at the charity stripe, which currently ranks third in the nation. Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%. Drexel junior **Damion Lee** ranks 13th at 88.6%.

GREEN, THORNTON ON AWARDS LISTS: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** and William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** are two of 40 players named to the mid-season watch list for the Lou Henson Award, which is presented to the Division I Mid-Major Player of the Year by CollegeInsider.com. The award will be presented on April 3. Thornton is also one of 16 finalists for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year award, which is presented to the nation's top shooting guard by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: There are only six seniors among the CAA's top 30 in scoring, five seniors among the league's top 20 in rebounding and four seniors among the top 15 in assists. Through games of Feb. 26, there were 11 juniors, 10 sophomores and two freshmen on the list of top 30 scorers, while there were nine juniors, five sophomores and one freshman on the list of top 20 rebounders.

CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS: Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** became the Tribe's career 3-point leader (305) on Jan. 21, passing David Schneider (278). That total also ranks 6th in CAA history. Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** is the Blue Hens' all-time three-point leader (268), passing Mike Ames (228) on Jan. 5. Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** ranks fourth on Elon's career three-pointers list with 234 and set the school record for 3-pointers in a season with 95, which is tied for 7th in CAA history.

HOFSTRA'S GREEN LEADS NATION IN MADE FREE THROWS: Hofstra guard **Juan'ya Green** has made 188 free throws this season, which is the most of any player in Division I. Green ranks third in free throws attempted (224). He's shooting an impressive 83.9% from the charity stripe. Green also ranks 9th nationally in assists (6.5 apg).

CAA TEAMS AMONG NATIONAL STATS LEADERS: Several CAA teams are ranked in the top 25 nationally in various statistical categories through games of Feb. 26. **William & Mary** ranks 7th nationally in FG percentage (49.3%) and **Northeastern** is 20th (48.0%). **Hofstra** is 12th (8.9 pg) in 3's per game, while the Tribe is 24th in 3's per game (8.5) and 14th in 3-point FG% (40.2%). Hofstra is also 16th in scoring offense (78.3 ppg). **Towson** ranks 9th in rebound margin (+8.5 rpg).

HOFSTRA AMONG NATION'S BEST ON ROAD: **Hofstra** is tied for the 4th-most road wins (10-5) in Division I through games of Feb. 26. Albany (12-5) leads the nation and Gonzaga (11-1) and Rider (11-4) are second. The Pride is tied with Virginia (10-0), Murray State (10-1), Wichita State (10-2), Yale (10-5), Iona (10-6) and Maryland-Eastern Shore (10-8).

DOUBLE TRIPLE-DOUBLES: Only eight players have recorded triple-doubles in Division I basketball this season, and two of them are in the CAA. William & Mary junior **Terry Tarpey** had the first triple-double in the 110-year history of Tribe basketball on Jan. 10 when he had 18 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists in a win over James Madison. Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** turned in the first triple-double in Pride program history on Dec. 28 when he had 15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a victory over LIU Brooklyn.

CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA teams are 58-64 (.475) in non-conference play. Of the 64 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, as well as seven teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#2 Virginia, #4 Duke, #6 Villanova, #15 North Carolina, #17 Louisville and #20 West Virginia.)

MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: CAA teams have played only 49 of their 122 non-conference games (40.2%) at home and the league is a combined 31-18 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

CAA RANKED 18TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA is ranked 18th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through Feb. 26. **William & Mary** is ranked #84 in the RPI while **Northeastern** is ranked #104 and **UNCW** is #129.

THREE CAA PLAYERS NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM: Three CAA men's basketball players - College of Charleston sophomore guard **Canyon Barry**, Hofstra graduate student guard **Dion Nesmith** and UNCW senior forward **Cedrick Williams** - have been nominated for the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The prestigious award recognizes student-athletes who have made significant contributions to their communities through volunteerism and civic service.

W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93 three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team were Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton**, who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who made the All-CAA second team in 2012-13, but missed most of last season with a knee injury, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**, who earned 3rd-team All-CAA accolades.

NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: Northeastern, which returned four starters and welcomed back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, was picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

ELON JOINS THE CAA: The CAA welcomed Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix had a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** is in its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA: There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS: CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS: CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.
