CAA WEEKLY AWARDS



PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Damion Lee • Drexel

Jr., G, 6-6, 200 - Baltimore, Md./Calvert Hall

Lee averaged 32.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists in Drexel's victories over Northeastern (65-60) and UNCW (85-76) last week. The junior guard poured in a season-high 33 points against the Huskies and then posted his second double-double of the season with 32 points and a team-high 13 rebounds against the Seahawks. For the week, he shot 63.3% (19-30) from the floor, including 5-of-9 from three-point range, and made 22-of-23 at the free throw line. Lee has scored double figures in 18 straight games and has scored 20 or more points 11 times this season.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Mike Morsell • Towson

Fr., G, 6-5, 190 - Fort Washington, Md./St. John's College

Morsell averaged 14.5 points and 5.0 rebounds in Towson's 2-0 week. The freshman guard scored a career-high 15 points and pulled down six rebounds in a 74-70 win over College of Charleston and followed with 14 points, four rebounds and two blocks in an 86-72 victory at Hofstra. It was the first back-to-back double-digit scoring efforts of the year for Morsell, who shot 52.9% (9-17) from the floor.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

THREE-WAY TIE ATOP CAA STANDINGS: UNCW, Northeastern and William & Mary are locked in a three-way tie atop the CAA standings at 8-3 with seven league games remaining. The Seahawks have won five of their last six after a 77-65 victory at James Madison on Wednesday. The Huskies topped Towson 69-62 on Wednesday for their second straight win. The Tribe had its three-game winning streak snapped after an 80-72 setback at College of Charleston on Thursday. All three teams have head-to-head matchups remaining, starting with tonight's W&M/UNCW contest televised by the American Sports Network. There is also a three-way tie for fourth place at 6-5 between Drexel, which is on a four-game winning streak, Hofstra and James Madison.

OUTSTANDING EFFORTS: Along with the sensational performance by CAA Player of the Week **Damion Lee** of Drexel, there were several other outstanding efforts around the league last week. William & Mary sophomore guard **Daniel Dixon** set a school record by going 6-for-6 from 3-point range against Hofstra and followed with a career-high 25 points at James Madison. Delaware junior forward **Marvin King-Davis** poured in a career-high 31 points at JMU last Wednesday. Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** averaged 21.0 ppg in a 2-0 week as he netted 20 points against CofC and 22 points at Hofstra. JMU sophomore guard **Jackson Kent** set career-highs with back-to-back 19-point performances last week and was 11-for-18 from 3-point range in the two games.

CLOSE CONFERENCE GAMES: There have been 30 CAA games played since January 17, and 15 have been decided by six points or less. Seven of **College of Charleston's** last nine games have been decided by six points or less. **Delaware** has had seven of its past nine contests with a margin of six points or less. Four of **UNCW's** last seven games have been decided by five points or less.

ROAD TEAMS DOING WELL IN CAA PLAY: Road teams are 3-2 so far this week and home teams are only 30-25 (54.5%) in CAA play this season. Six squads are at least .500 in league road games and all 10 teams have won at least one conference road contest. Last season, home teams went 44-28 (61.1%) in CAA play.

TWO CAA PLAYERS AMONG TOP 30 IN SCORING: Two CAA players are among the nation's top 30 in scoring through games of Feb. 5. Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee** is ranked 4th with 21.5 ppg, and W&M's **Marcus Thornton** is 28th with 19.0 ppg. Thornton has scored double figures in 28 consecutive games and Lee has a 19-game streak.

3-POINT THREATS: The CAA features several of the nation's top three-point threats this season. W&M senior **Marcus Thornton** is 23rd in 3's per game (2.95) and 22nd in 3-pt percentage (43.6%), while teammate **Daniel Dixon** is 9th in 3-pt percentage (46.3%). Hofstra junior **Ameen Tanksley** ranks 4th in 3-point percentage (48.1%), while Pride sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 20th in 3's per game (3.04) and 20th in 3-pt percentage (44.0%). Elon junior **Tanner Samson** is 11th in 3's per game (3.21).

MCGLYNN RANKED #3 NATIONALLY IN FT PERCENTAGE: Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** is an incredible 96-of-103 (93.2%) at the charity stripe, which currently ranks third in the nation. Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%. Drexel junior **Damion Lee** is 30th at 87.1%.

GREEN, THORNTON ON HENSON AWARD WATCH LIST: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** and William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** are two of 40 players named to the mid-season watch list for the Lou Henson Award, which is presented to the Division I Mid-Major Player of the Year by CollegeInsider.com. The award will be presented on April 3.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: There are only five seniors among the CAA's top 30 in scoring, six seniors among the league's top 20 in rebounding and three seniors among the top 15 in assists. Through games of Feb. 5, there were 12 juniors, 10 sophomores and three freshmen on the list of top 30 scorers, while there were nine juniors and five sophomores on the list of top 20 rebounders.

CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS: Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** became the Tribe's career 3-point leader (288) on Jan. 21, passing David Schneider (278). That total also ranks 8th in CAA history. Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** is the Blue Hens' all-time three-point leader (254), passing Mike Ames (228) on Jan. 5. Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** ranks fourth on Elon's career three-pointers list with 216.

W&M'S THORNTON ON NATIONAL TOP 10 LISTS: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** ranks fifth among active Division I players in career 3-pointers made (288) and he's fifth in career scoring (1,937 points). The CAA preseason Player of the Year ranks second in the CAA in scoring (19.0 ppg) this season and has hit 65 treys. He also ranks third on W&M's all-time scoring list.

HOFSTRA'S GREEN SECOND IN NATION IN MADE FREE THROWS: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** has made 158 free throws this season, which is the second-most of any player in Division I. BYU's Tyler Haws leads the nation with 161. Green also ranks third in free throws attempted (190). He's shooting an impressive 83.2% from the charity stripe.

CAA TEAMS AMONG NATIONAL STATS LEADERS: Several CAA teams are ranked in the top 20 nationally in various statistical categories through games of Feb. 5. **William & Mary** ranks 5th nationally in FG percentage (49.7%). **Hofstra** is 9th (9.3 pg) and W&M is 20th (8.8 pg) in 3-pointers per game, while the Tribe is 7th (41%) in 3-point FG percentage. Hofstra is also 18th in scoring offense (78.4 ppg). **Towson** ranks 9th in rebound margin (+8.2 rpg).

DOUBLE TRIPLE-DOUBLES: Only eight players have recorded triple-doubles in Division I basketball this season, and two of them are in the CAA. William & Mary junior **Terry Tarpey** had the first triple-double in the 110-year history of Tribe basketball on Jan. 10 when he had 18 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists in a win over James Madison. Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** turned in the first triple-double in Pride program history on Dec. 28 when he had 15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a victory over LIU Brooklyn.

HOFSTRA AMONG NATION'S BEST ON ROAD: **Hofstra** is tied for the second-most road wins (8-5) in Division I through games of Feb. 5. Albany (9-5) leads the nation. The Pride is tied with Virginia (8-0), Gonzaga (8-1), Murray State (8-1), Rider (8-4), Yale (8-5) and Maryland-Eastern Shore (8-7).

CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA teams are 58-64 (.475) in non-conference play. Of the 64 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, as well as eight teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#3 Virginia, #4 Duke, #7 Villanova, #9 Louisville, #12 North Carolina, #15 West Virginia and #24 Georgetown.)

MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: CAA teams have played only 49 of their 122 non-conference games (40.2%) at home and the league is a combined 31-18 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

CAA RANKED 18TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA is ranked 18th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through Feb. 5. **William & Mary** is ranked #89 in the RPI while **Northeastern** is ranked #104 and **UNCW** is #142.

The prestigious award recognizes student-athletes who have made significant contributions to their communities through volunteerism and civic service.

W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93 three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team were Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton**, who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who made the All-CAA second team in 2012-13, but missed most of last season with a knee injury, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**, who earned 3rd-team All-CAA accolades.

NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: Northeastern, which returned four starters and welcomed back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, was picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

ELON JOINS THE CAA: The CAA welcomed Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix had a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** is in its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA: There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS: CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS: CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship returns to Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena on March 6-9. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.

- Snapped a 5-game losing streak with an 80-72 victory over W&M on Thursday. Seven of nine CAA losses have been by 6 pts. or less.
- Canyon Barry tallied team-highs of 19 points and 6 rebounds vs. W&M. He has reached double figures in a career-best 9 straight games, leads the team in scoring (13.0 ppg) and steals, and is 2nd in rebounds (5.5 rpg).
- Anthony Stitt returned vs. W&M after missing 7 games with a knee injury and had 10 points, 5 assists and 3 steals off the bench.
- Adjehi Baru tallied 12 points on 5-5 FG shooting vs. W&M. Baru is averaging 11.5 ppg and is 10-of-11 from the floor over his past two games.
- Joe Chealey contributed 16 points and 5 rebounds vs. W&M. He has six double-digit efforts in the past eight games and is averaging 15.3 ppg over his last 3 contests.
- CofC shot a season-best 54.5% from the floor and had five players score double figures for the first time vs. W&M.

8-14 Overall/6-5 CAA



- Picked up a 67-63 victory at Elon on Thursday. Have won four in a row and five of their last six games to move into a tie for 4th.
- Damion Lee scored a team-high 16 points with 8 rebounds at Elon. Lee tops the CAA in scoring (21.5 ppg) and is 5th in rebounding (6.5 rpg). He's scored double digits in 19 straight games and has 11 games with 20+ points. Lee has made 54 of his last 58 FT's.
- Tavon Allen added 14 points and 5 rebounds at Elon. He's scored double figures in five of his last six games.
- Freshman Sammy Mojica scored 14 points off the bench at Elon. He's tallied double figures in 4 straight games and is averaging 12.8 ppg over that stretch.
- Mohamed Bah tied his season-highs with 10 points and 9 rebounds in the Elon victory.
- Drexel is 53-of-67 (79.1%) at the FT line over the past three games and is shooting a league-best 73.2% for the season.
- The Dragons made a season-high eight steals at Elon.

- Dropped a 79-69 decision to Hofstra on Wednesday night.
