PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Ron Curry • James Madison

Jr., G, 6-4, 190 - Pennsauken, N.J./Paul VI
Curry averaged 21.5 points and 6.0 assists in James Madison's two games last week. The junior guard posted his first career double-double with a team-high 20 points and a career-high 11 assists in the Dukes' 82-73 win over Hofstra and poured in a game-high 23 points in a loss at UNCW. For the week, he shot 52% from the floor, including 10-of-13 (76.9%) from 3-point range. He has eight 20-point efforts in the past 12 games.

Elijah Bryant • Elon

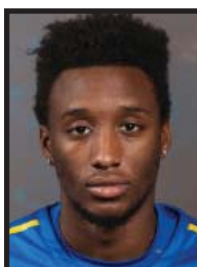
Fr., G, 6-4, 225 - Gwinnett, Ga./New Hampton School
Bryant averaged 14.5 points and 8.0 rebounds as Elon knocked off a pair of first-place teams last week. The freshman guard had a team-high 16 points, eight boards, four assists and three steals in a 72-65 win over Northeastern and followed with 13 points and eight caroms in a 74-55 victory against UNCW. He has tallied double figures in 25 of 31 games.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Kory Holden • Delaware

Fr., G, 6-2, 180 - Salisbury, Md./J.M. Bennett
Holden averaged 13.0 points and 6.0 assists as Delaware closed the regular season with back-to-back road wins. The freshman guard scored a game-high 17 points, including four crucial free throws in the final 23 seconds, in a 65-60 triumph at Towson and had nine points, eight assists and no turnovers in a 58-44 win at Drexel. For the week, he shot 52.9% from the floor, including 4-of-8 from 3-point range.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

FOUR-WAY TIE FOR REGULAR-SEASON TITLE: For the first time in CAA history, there was a four-way tie for the CAA regular-season title as **James Madison, UNCW, Northeastern** and **William & Mary** all finished 12-6. W&M captured its first regular-season crown since 1997-98, JMU won its first title since 1999-2000, UNCW posted its first regular-season title since 2005-06 and NU claimed its second regular-season championship in the past three years. **It was the first tie for the CAA regular-season championship since 2005-06 and the first time the conference has had more than two teams finish in a first-place tie.**

HISTORIC BALANCE: The six conference losses for the CAA regular-season champion were tied for the most in league history. The last time the first-place team in the CAA had more than four setbacks was 1996-97 when Old Dominion and UNCW shared the league title with a 10-6 mark. There were seven teams that finished .500 or better in CAA play.

CLOSE CONFERENCE GAMES: Of the 65 CAA games played since January 17, 29 were decided by six points or less or in OT. Eleven of **Delaware's** past 16 games have been decided by six points or less or OT. Eight of **College of Charleston's** last 15 games have been decided by six points or less. Seven of **UNCW's** last 14 games have been decided by five points or less. Twelve of **Towson's** 18 CAA games had margins of 5 points or less.

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP RETURNS TO BALTIMORE: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship starts Friday at Baltimore's Royal Farms Arena. It's the second year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to Baltimore. Nearly 20,000 fans attended last year's tournament. More than 400,000 alumni from CAA schools live within 250 miles of Baltimore. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

ROAD TEAMS FARE WELL IN CAA PLAY: Road teams posted a 21-19 mark over the final four weeks and home teams finished just 47-43 (52.2%) in CAA play this season. Seven squads posted winning records in league road games, led by **Hofstra (6-3)** and **James Madison (6-3)**. All 10 teams won at least one conference road contest and eight won three or more. Last season, home teams went 44-28 (61.1%) in CAA play.

THORNTON BECOMES W&M'S ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** became the school's all-time leading scorer last Wednesday and now has 2,081 points. He broke the oldest Division I scoring record in the country, which was set by Chet Giermak (2,052 pts) back in 1950. Thornton ranks third among all active NCAA Division I players in career 3-pointers made (308) and he's sixth in career scoring. He's also fifth on the CAA's career treys chart and 11th on the CAA career scoring list.

DREXEL'S LEE OUT FOR THE SEASON: Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who leads the CAA and ranks fifth nationally in scoring with 21.4 ppg, is out for the season after suffering a fracture in his right hand on Feb. 21 at Northeastern. Lee finished with 578 points, which is the 8th-highest season total in school history. He also ranks 10th on the Dragons' career scoring list with 1,538 points.

TWO CAA PLAYERS AMONG TOP 25 IN SCORING: Two CAA players are among the nation's top 30 in scoring through games of March 1. Drexel's **Damion Lee** is ranked 5th with 21.4 ppg, and W&M's **Marcus Thornton** is 21st with 19.4 ppg. Thornton has scored double figures in 35 consecutive games and Lee, who is out for the season, has a 24-game streak.

3-POINT THREATS: The CAA features several of the nation's top three-point threats this season. W&M sophomore **Daniel Dixon** ranks 3rd in Div. I in 3-pt percentage (46.2%). Elon junior **Tanner Samson** ranks 13th in 3's per game (3.16). W&M senior **Marcus Thornton** is 21st in 3's per game (2.93) and 35th in 3-pt percentage (40.9%). Hofstra sophomore **Brian Bernardi** is 30th in 3's per game (2.81) and 31st in 3-pt percentage (41.6%).

MCGLYNN RANKED #4 NATIONALLY IN FT PERCENTAGE: Towson junior guard **Four McGlynn** is 117-of-128 (91.4%) at the charity stripe, which currently ranks fourth in the nation. Last season, McGlynn led the CAA and ranked sixth nationally in free throw percentage at 91.3%. Drexel junior **Damion Lee** ranks 13th at 88.7%.

COFC'S BARRY EARNS ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA HONORS: College of Charleston sophomore **Canyon Barry** was named to the Capital One Academic All-America second team.

He holds a 4.0 grade point average while majoring in physics and minoring in computer science and mathematics. Barry is only the second CofC men's basketball player to receive Academic All-America accolades.

GREEN, THORNTON ON AWARDS LISTS: Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** and William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** are two of 40 players named to the mid-season watch list for the Lou Henson Award, which is presented to the Division I Mid-Major Player of the Year by CollegeInsider.com. The award will be presented on April 3. Thornton is also one of 16 finalists for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year award, which is presented to the nation's top shooting guard by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: There are only six seniors among the CAA's top 30 in scoring, five seniors among the league's top 20 in rebounding and four seniors among the top 15 in assists. Through games of March 1, there were 12 juniors, 10 sophomores and two freshmen on the list of top 30 scorers, while there were nine juniors, five sophomores and one freshman on the list of top 20 rebounders.

CLIMBING THE 3-POINT LISTS: Three CAA players are climbing the career three-point lists at their respective schools. William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** became the Tribe's career 3-point leader (308) on Jan. 21, passing David Schneider (278). That total also ranks 5th in CAA history. Delaware senior guard **Kyle Anderson** is the Blue Hens' all-time three-point leader (269), passing Mike Ames (228) on Jan. 5. Elon junior guard **Tanner Samson** ranks fourth on Elon's career three-pointers list with 237 and set the school record for 3-pointers in a season with 98, which ranks 7th in CAA history.

HOFSTRA'S GREEN LEADS NATION IN MADE FREE THROWS: Hofstra guard **Juan'ya Green** has made 192 free throws this season, which is the most of any player in Division I. Green ranks fourth in free throws attempted (230). He's shooting an impressive 83.5% from the charity stripe. Green also ranks 9th nationally in assists (6.5 apg).

CAA TEAMS AMONG NATIONAL STATS LEADERS: Several CAA teams are ranked in the top 25 nationally in various statistical categories through games of March 1. **William & Mary** ranks 6th nationally in FG percentage (49.2%) and **Northeastern** is 19th (48.1%). **Hofstra** is 14th (8.9 pg) in 3's per game, while the Tribe is 21st in 3's per game (8.6) and 11th in 3-point FG% (40.0%). Hofstra is also 16th in scoring offense (78.1 ppg). **Towson** ranks 8th in rebound margin (+8.4 rpg).

HOFSTRA AMONG NATION'S BEST ON ROAD: **Hofstra** is one of 15 Division I teams with double-digit road wins (10-6) through games of March 1. Other teams include: Albany (12-5), Gonzaga (11-1), Murray State (11-1), Rider (11-4), Maryland-Eastern Shore (11-8), Virginia (10-0), Wichita State (10-2), Stephen F. Austin (10-3), UC Davis (10-5), Wofford (10-5), Yale (10-5), Iona (10-6), Buffalo (10-7) and Iona (10-7).

DOUBLE TRIPLE-DOUBLES: Only eight players have recorded triple-doubles in Division I basketball this season, and two of them are in the CAA. William & Mary junior **Terry Tarpey** had the first triple-double in the 110-year history of Tribe basketball on Jan. 10 when he had 18 points, 11 rebounds and a career-high 10 assists in a win over James Madison. Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green** turned in the first triple-double in Pride program history on Dec. 28 when he had 15 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in a victory over LIU Brooklyn.

CAA IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA teams are 58-64 (.475) in non-conference play. Of the 64 losses, 20 have come against teams from the Power 5 conferences, as well as seven teams who are currently ranked in the top 25 (#2 Virginia, #4 Duke, #6 Villanova, #15 North Carolina, #17 Louisville and #20 West Virginia.)

MORE ON THE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS: CAA teams have played only 49 of their 122 non-conference games (40.2%) at home and the league is a combined 31-18 in those contests. CAA teams have also picked up 18 road victories and are a combined 9-7 in neutral site games.

CAA RANKED 18TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA is ranked 18th out of the nation's 32 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI report produced by Collegiate Basketball News (rpiratings.com) through March 1. **Northeastern** is ranked #99 in the RPI while **William & Mary** is ranked #101, **James Madison** is #139 and **UNCW** is #140.

CAA COACHES TELECONFERENCES EACH TUESDAY: The final CAA weekly coaches teleconference takes place at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, March 3. More information can be found on page 5 of this release.

THREE CAA PLAYERS NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM: Three CAA men's basketball players - College of Charleston sophomore guard **Canyon Barry**, Hofstra graduate student guard **Dion Nesmith** and UNCW senior forward **Cedrick Williams** - have been nominated for the 2015 Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The prestigious award recognizes student-athletes who have made significant contributions to their communities through volunteerism and civic service.

W&M'S THORNTON HEADLINES PRESEASON ALL-CAA TEAM: William & Mary senior guard **Marcus Thornton** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Thornton received first-team All-CAA accolades last season after averaging a team-best 18.7 points per game and knocking down a league-high 93 three-pointers. Joining Thornton on the preseason All-CAA first team were Northeastern senior forward **Scott Eatherton**, who was the 2014 CAA Defensive Player of the Year and a 2nd-team All-CAA pick, Hofstra junior guard **Juan'ya Green**, a transfer from Niagara who was 1st-team All-MAAC in 2012-13, Drexel junior guard **Damion Lee**, who made the All-CAA second team in 2012-13, and James Madison junior guard **Andre Nation**.

NORTHEASTERN PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: Northeastern, which returned four starters and welcomed back All-CAA forward Quincy Ford from an injury, was picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2014-15 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Huskies were followed in the voting by William & Mary, Hofstra, Drexel, James Madison, College of Charleston, Towson, defending champion Delaware, UNCW and CAA newcomer Elon.

ELON JOINS THE CAA: The CAA welcomed Elon University to the conference this season. The Phoenix had a solid 18-14 campaign in 2013-14, which included an 11-5 mark in the Southern Conference. Elon has averaged 18 victories over the past three seasons under coach **Matt Matheny**, and the Phoenix earned a postseason berth in the CIT in 2013. They are 33-11 at home over the past three years. **College of Charleston** is in its second year as a CAA member and the conference will have 10 members for the first time since 2004-05.

TWO NEW COACHES IN THE CAA: There are two new coaches in the CAA this season as **Earl Grant** takes over at College of Charleston and **Kevin Keatts** begins his first year at UNCW. Grant, who is a native of Charleston, spent the past four seasons as an assistant under former CAA Coach of the Year Brad Brownell at Clemson. He also was an assistant for six seasons under Gregg Marshall, with the last three coming at Wichita State. Keatts coached the past three seasons under Rick Pitino at Louisville, where the Cardinals went to two NCAA Final Fours and won the national championship in 2013. Prior to Louisville, he compiled a 263-17 record over 10 seasons at Hargrave Military Academy in Virginia.

PILING UP POSTSEASON WINS: CAA teams have combined to win 43 games in postseason play since 2006, including 14 victories in the NCAA Tournament. During that nine-year period, the CAA has had two teams reach the NCAA Final Four, one reach the semifinals of the NIT, and has had squads capture championships of the CBI and CIT.

NCAA TOURNAMENT SUCCESS: CAA teams have won opening round NCAA Tournament games in six of the last nine years, including four of the past five. Since 2006, CAA teams have compiled a 14-13 record in the NCAA Tournament with two squads reaching the NCAA Final Four.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA will feature an outstanding broadcast package for the upcoming season. The conference will have at least 90 televised games, including 10 nationally televised contests on the NBC Sports Network and 22 regionally televised games on the Comcast SportsNets. The CAA will also have 17 men's games aired by the league's newest television partner, the American Sports Network. In addition, CAA fans will be able to watch hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's new digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference game.

- Joe Chealey averaged 15.5 ppg and 4.5 rpg last week, including a team-high 20 points vs. NU. He's reached double digits in 10 straight games and is averaging 14.8 ppg over that stretch.

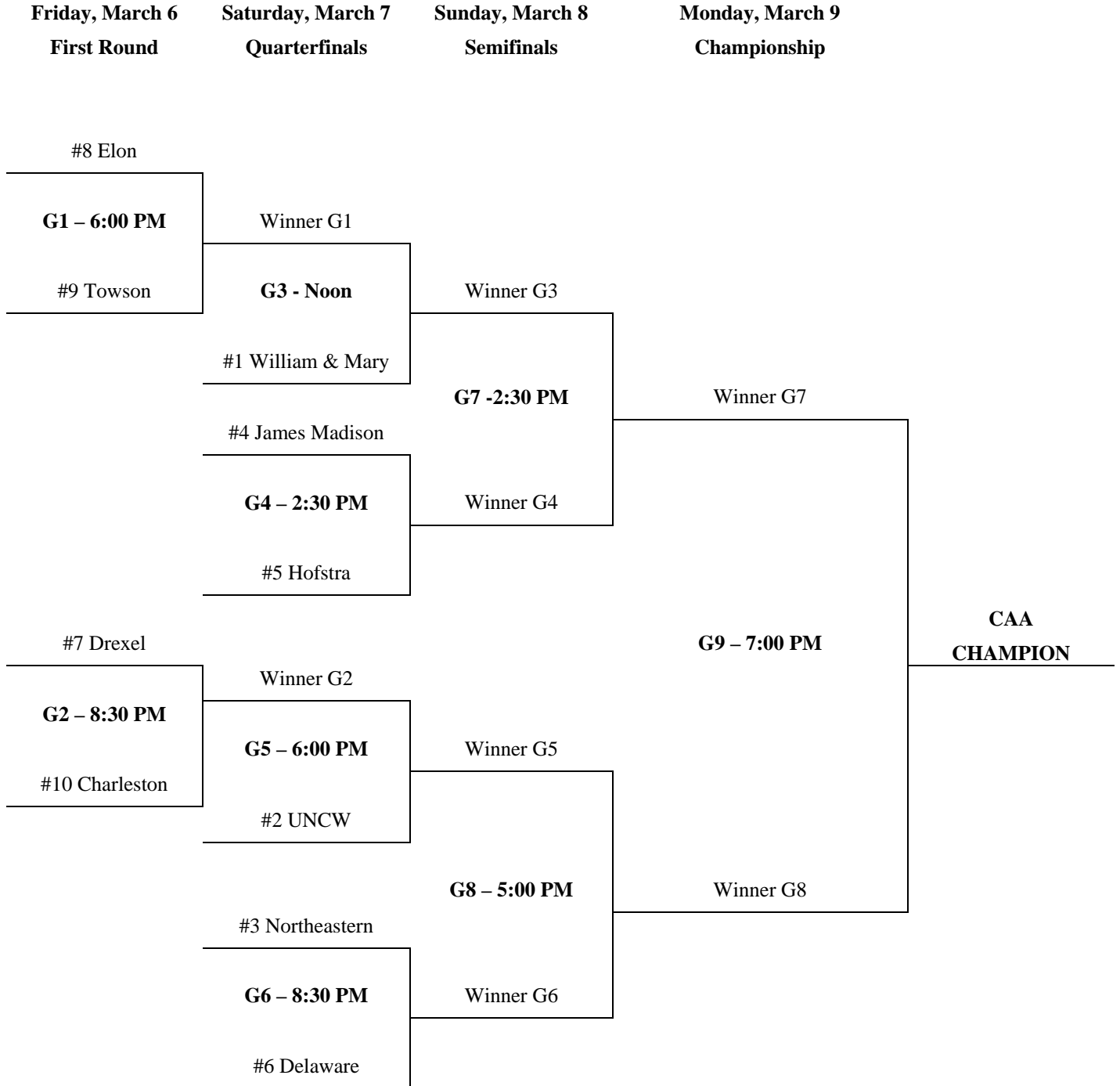
