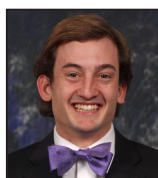

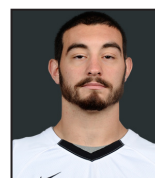

CAA MEN'S LACROSSE WEEK IN REVIEW

- **Fairfield 12, Delaware 11 (2OT):** Senior **Tristan Sperry** scored the game-winning goal one minute into the second overtime period as the Fairfield outlasted visiting Delaware, 12-11, on Saturday. Sperry and **Drew Federico** each tallied two goals and two assists while **TJ Neubauer** had two goals and six ground balls. The Stags were dominant at the faceoff 'X', led by a 16-for-24 showing from **Will Fox**. For Delaware, **Beau Jones** had a career-best six points with five assists and a goal, which sent the game to overtime. Rookie **Mike Handlan** had a pair of goals in just his third game.
- **UMass 12, Drexel 9:** Balance on attack and 14 saves by goalie **Zach Oliveri** keyed UMass to a 12-9 win over Drexel. The Minutemen received three goals each from both **Brendan Hegarty** and **Dan Muller**. Drexel out-shot UMass, 36-33 and won the ground ball war, 29-21. For Drexel, **Ryan Belka** tallied five points on four goals and an assists while **Jimmy Joe Granito** had 10 saves.
- **Hofstra 9, #12 Towson 2:** Junior **Sam Llinares** tallied four goals and senior **Chris Selva** came off the bench to record 12 saves and lead Hofstra to a 9-2 victory over the 12th-ranked Towson. Towson received two goals by sophomore **Ryan Drenner** while goalie Tyler White made six saves in the Tiger cage.

#CAACHAMPS PRIMER

- The top four teams in the final league standings qualify for the 2015 CAA Men's Lacrosse Championship. The field will be determined at the conclusion of regular season play on April 25.
- The highest seed of the tournament plays host both the semifinals and final.
- The CAA Championship semifinals will be held on Thursday, April 30 and will be streamed live on CAA.tv. Times are to be determined.
- The CAA Championship final will be held on Saturday, May 2 at 1:00 p.m. and will be broadcast live on the American Sports Network (ASN).

QUICK SHOTS

- UMass Head Coach **Greg Cannella** took to the sideline for his 300th career game on April 18. Cannella has 182 wins at the helm of the Minutemen.
- The sophomore class for UMass is providing 52.5 percent of the Minutemen's goals (63), 59.3 percent of the assists (51), and 55.3 percent of the points (114).
- Hofstra's **Sam Llinares** has 10 multi-goal efforts, including five hat-tricks in 13 games this season.
- In 10 of Hofstra's 13 games, the opposing goalie has recorded 13 or more saves against the Pride.
- Fairfield's five losses this season have each come by one goal. The Stags have played seven one-goal games this season.
- Towson has won at least eight games in the last four seasons under Head Coach **Shawn Nadelen**.
- Drexel's **Nick Saputo** has scooped up a CAA-best 102 ground balls in 13 games for the Dragons. He is sixth in the nation in ground balls per game (7.85).
- Hofstra's **Mike Malave** is second in the nation in man-up goals this season with 10. He is two behind the national leader, Dylan Donahue of Syracuse.
- Delaware's **Brian Kormondy** has scored in 36 of his last 40 games since 2013.
- Delaware senior **Brandon Worrall** is second all-time at Delaware in caused turnovers (49).
- After a seven-game home stand, Delaware traveled to Fairfield on April 18 for the Blue Hens' first road game since February 28.
- UMass sophomore **Nick Mariano** has scored at least one point in each of his 25 career contests.
- Senior **Andrew Hodgson** has four of Towson's nine game-winning goals this season.
- Delaware's **Tyler Barbarich** won his 400th career faceoff and picked up his 200th career groundball on March 21.
- Hofstra posted an 18-0 shutout against Manhattan, the Pride's first blank sheet since 1970.

CLAMP DOWN DEFENSE

- Towson has held 12 of its 13 opponents to single digit goals this season and ranks third nationally in scoring defense (7.08/g). Goalie **Tyler White's** 6.81 goals against average is the second-best in the nation and his .596 save percentage is third-best.
- Towson held UMass to three goals on March 28, the fewest CAA goals allowed by the Tigers since beating Drexel 7-4 on March 28, 2009.
- Fairfield is sixth in the nation in scoring defense, allowing just 7.62 goals per game.
- Drexel goalie **Jimmy Joe Granito** has a 7.87 GAA this season, good for seventh-best in the nation.

NATIONAL NOTICE

- Towson goalie **Tyler White** was named the USILA Division I Defensive Player of the Week on March 31 after holding UMass to three goals and tying a career-best with 14 saves.
- In addition to his CAA Player of the Week honor on March 23, **Tyler Behring** was named the *Inside Lacrosse* Sector Player of the Week as well as the NCAA.com Division I Defensive Player of the Week.
- Fairfield was named the *NCAA.com* Team of the Week on April 6 after winning its fifth-straight game and appearing in the national polls.

INSIDE LACROSSE MID-SEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Drexel's **Ryan Belka** and Towson's **JoJo Ostrander** were named to the *Inside Lacrosse* Mid-Season All-American Second Team. For the last six years, *Inside Lacrosse* has been rating the nation's top players at the midway point of the season.

SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE

Hofstra senior **Mike Malave** has been named one of the 20 candidates for the 2015 Senior CLASS Award. Malave is a finance major and a three-time CAA Commissioner's Academic Award recipient, a two-time Hofstra Dean's List student, and is a recipient of the Hofstra Presidential Scholarship. Malave has also served as one of the team leaders in community service and charitable team activities. The 20 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists later in the season.

TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST

Four CAA men's lacrosse players were named to the initial Tewaaraton Award Watch List. Receiving the honor were: **Sam Llinares** (Hofstra); **Andrew Hodgson** (Towson); **Nick Saputo** (Drexel); **Ryan Izzo** (UMass).

FIRST THINGS FIRST

- Fairfield made its CAA debut on March 28 by topping defending league champion Drexel, 7-4.
- Delaware kicked off the entire 2015 NCAA Division I season by playing the first game of the year at High Point on February 1. The Blue Hens were clipped, 15-10.

WELCOME FAIRFIELD

The Fairfield University Stags join the CAA as an associate member this season after the departure of Penn State. The Stags, who were a member of the ECAC Lacrosse League, had their best season in program history in 2014, finishing at 12-4, winning the ECAC Lacrosse League Regular Season Championship, and advancing to the finals of their championship tournament for the third time. Fairfield also was ranked as high as 11th in the nation last season. The Stags are under the guidance of seventh-year Head Coach **Andy Copelan**. The Stags also begin their inaugural season in Rafferty Stadium, a newly constructed 3,500-seat venue on their Connecticut campus.

2015 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- Hofstra was picked to win a league title according to a poll of the CAA head coaches. Defending champion Drexel was next followed by CAA men's lacrosse newcomer Fairfield and Towson.
- The Pride's **Sam Llinares** was chosen as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year.
- Senior midfielder **Ryan Belka** (Drexel), senior faceoff specialist **Nick Saputo** (Drexel), senior defender **JoJo Ostrander** (Towson), senior faceoff man **Tyler Barbarich** (Delaware), senior midfielder **Colin McLinden** (Fairfield), and junior midfielder **TJ Neubauer** (Fairfield) earned Preseason All-American honorable mentions from *Inside Lacrosse*.
