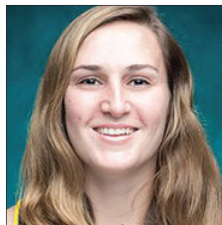

Obusek averaged 23.0 points, 15.0 rebounds and 3.5 blocks as UNCW split a pair of games with Towson last week. Playing her final home games at UNCW, the senior forward set career-highs with 23 points, 18 rebounds and five blocks in Thursday's 77-66 setback. In Friday's 75-65 victory, she matched her career-high with 23 points on 9-of-10 FG shooting and added 12 rebounds for her 11th double-double of the season. For the week, Obusek shot 66.7% from the floor for the week.

Webster averaged 9.0 points and 10.5 rebounds as UNCW went 1-1 against Towson last week. The freshman guard contributed nine points and eight boards in a loss to the Tigers on Thursday. In a win over Towson on Friday, she tallied nine points and a team-best 13 rebounds. It was the fourth double-digit rebounding effort for Webster, who ranks 8th in the CAA with 7.7 rpg for the year.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

VARIETY OF CHAMPIONS: Five different schools have won the CAA Women's Basketball Championship since 2009 (James Madison - 5, Delaware - 2, Elon - 2, Drexel - 1, Towson - 1).

WHERE CHAMPIONS COME FROM: The #1 seed in the CAA Women's Basketball Championship won the title for seven straight years from 2011-17, but the last two tournament champions have been #3 Elon in 2018 and #4 Towson in 2019.

BACK AT ELON: The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returns to Elon's Schar Center after last year's event was cancelled early due to the CoVID-19 pandemic. UNCW and Elon won first-round games in 2020, but the tournament was halted just prior to the tip-off of the quarterfinals on March 12.

DICKEY HEADLINES POSTSEASON AWARD WINNERS: Delaware junior **Jasmine Dickey** was chosen as the CAA Player of the Year in voting by the league's head coaches. Dickey led the CAA and ranked 8th nationally in scoring with 23.6 ppg and was also fourth in rebounding (8.8 rpg) and third in steals (2.4 spg). The Blue Hens' **Natasha Adair** earned CAA Coach of the Year honors, JMU guard **Peyton McDaniel** was Rookie of the Year, Drexel guard **Hannah Nihill** was Defensive Player of the Year and the Dean Ehlers Leadership Award winner, UNCW guard **Za'Nautica Downs** was Sixth Player of the Year and Elon guard **Saadia Munford** was the Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

DELAWARE CAPTURES REGULAR-SEASON TITLE: Delaware captured its first CAA regular-season title since 2012-13 with a 16-2 mark. The Blue Hens swept seven of their nine conference series. The 16 conference victories were the most since 2012-13.

HARD TO SWEEP A SERIES: It was difficult to record a sweep during the CAA's new conference schedule that featured back-to-back games. Of the 30 back-to-back conference series played, there have been 15 sweeps and 15 1-1 splits.

COVID-19 CAUSES SCHEDULE CHANGES: The CoVID-19 pandemic caused the postponement of 40 conference games this season.

DELAWARE TOPS CAA TEAMS IN NCAA NET RANKINGS: Four CAA teams are among the top 150 in the latest NCAA NET Rankings released on March 9. Delaware leads the way at #73, followed by #118 Drexel, #138 James Madison and #149 Towson.

W&M OPTS OUT FOR REMAINDER OF SEASON: William & Mary announced on Feb. 12 that it had opted out for the remainder of the regular season and would not participate in the CAA Women's Basketball Championship. The conference will now conduct a nine-team championship from March 10-13 at Elon.

JETER RANKS 3RS ON TOWSON SCORING LIST: Towson senior guard **Kionna Jeter** ranks 3rd on the Tigers' all-time scoring list (1,563 points). Next up in second place is Tanisha McTiller with 1,605 points. Jeter has topped the 20-point mark 13 times and has scored 30 or more points six times in 2020-21.

AMONG THE BEST ON OFFENSE AND DEFENSE: Towson ranks 12th nationally in scoring offense at 80.0 ppg, while Delaware is 30th with 75.6 ppg. Drexel ranks 26th in Division I in scoring defense at 56.5 ppg as of March 9.

JMU ON FIRE AT THE FREE THROW LINE: James Madison ranks 16th in the nation in free throw percentage at 77.6% as of March 9. The Dukes are shooting 77.9% in CAA play.

THREE CAA PLAYERS AMONG NATIONAL SCORING LEADERS: Three CAA players were among the nation's top 20 in scoring as of March 9. Delaware's **Jasmine Dickey** was 8th at

23.6 ppg, Towson's **Kionna Jeter** was 11th at 23.2 ppg, and William & Mary's **Sydney Wagner** was 18th at 21.3 ppg. Wagner was also 2nd nationally with 3.92 threes made per game.

DISTRIBUTING THE BALL: Drexel's **Maura Hendrixson** is 3rd in the nation in assist/TO ratio (3.80), having handed out 76 assists with only 20 turnovers. Towson's **Aleah Nelson** ranks 8th nationally in assists (6.3 apg) and 25th in assist/TO ratio.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES FOR DELAWARE'S BATTLE: Delaware's **Ty Battle** ranks 3rd in the nation with 16 double-doubles, which includes a current streak of seven straight games. Battle leads the CAA and is 20th nationally in rebounding (11.2 rpg) while also scoring 12.2 points per game.

DELAWARE CLEANING THE GLASS: Delaware leads the nation with 20.0 offensive rebounds per game and is 12th nationally in rebound margin (+10.8 rpg).

JETER NAMED SEMIFINALIST FOR MID-MAJOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Towson's **Kionna Jeter**, the CAA Preseason Player of the Year, is one of 10 semifinalists for the 2020-21 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award by Her Hoop Stats. Jeter is averaging 23.3 points, 4.9 rebounds and 2.4 steals per game.

STRONG PERFORMANCE IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY: CAA women's basketball teams have performed well against non-conference competition with a combined 32-23 record. Eight teams had a non-conference winning percentage of .500 or better, and seven of the 23 setbacks were to squads from Power 5 conferences. 14 of the wins have come on the road.

CAA RANKED 6TH AMONG DIVISION I CONFERENCES: The CAA was ranked 6th among the nation's 31 Division I conferences according to the latest RPI calculations from Warren-Nolan.com as of March 8. The CAA only trails the SEC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12 and Pac 12.

DELAWARE RANKED #19 IN COLLEGE INSIDER MID-MAJOR POLL: Delaware is ranked #19 in the March 2 Mid-Major Top 25 poll produced by CollegeInsider.com. James Madison, Towson and Drexel were among others receiving votes. A new poll is released each Tuesday night.

DELAWARE, JMU POST ROAD WINS OVER ACC TEAMS: Delaware and James Madison posted road victories over ACC opponents as the Blue Hens defeated Pittsburgh, 85-79, and the Dukes downed Virginia, 71-67. It was JMU's third win the past four meetings with the Cavaliers, while it was Delaware's first victory over an ACC foe since 2013.

CAA ADJUSTS SCHEDULING FORMAT FOR 2020-21 SEASON: The CAA women's basketball conference schedule once again includes 18 games in 2020-21, but the format has been adjusted to limit travel and help ensure the health and safety of student-athletes, coaches and staff. In lieu of a traditional home-and-home round-robin schedule, teams will play against the same opponent at the same site on consecutive days, primarily Saturdays and Sundays. The only exception will come when teams face their designated travel partner. On those weekends, each team will play once at home and once on the road, with flexibility given to create a day off in between contests.

- In their first games since Feb. 7, fell twice to UNCW (68-66 and 61-54).
- Tyler Collins scored a team-high 18 points vs. UNCW on Feb. 26. She has scored at least 17 points in 8 of the past 12 games and leads the Cougars with 13.5 ppg for the season. She's 8th in career assists (262) at CofC.
- Chelsea Wooten tallied 14 points vs. UNCW on Feb. 26 and 11 points on Feb. 28. She leads the Cougars with 25 treys.
- Aryn Eady netted 10 points at UNCW on Feb. 28. She ranks 3rd in the CAA in rebounding with 8.9 rpg and leads the league in blocks (2.0 bpg).
- Madison Taylor averaged 14.0 ppg vs. UNCW, including a season-high 18 points on Feb. 28.
- Amira Williams chipped in 10 points, seven rebounds and four steals at UNCW on Feb. 28.
- Tyler Gray averaged 10.5 points, 6.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals in the two games at Towson. She's averaging 9.5 ppg for the season.
- Defeated Towson 80-54 and 86-55 to claim their first CAA regular-season title since 2012-13. Finished 11-0 at home.
- Jasmine Dickey averaged 29.5 points and 14.5 rebounds vs. Towson. She leads the CAA in scoring (23.6 ppg) and is 4th in rebounds (8.8 rpg). Dickey has scored at least 20 points 16 times and 30 points five times.
- Ty Battle averaged 12.5 points and 12.5 rebounds vs. Towson. She has posted a double-double in seven straight games and has 16 for the season, which is 3rd in Div. I.
- Lizzie Oleary matched her career-high with 14 points on 6-of-9 FG shooting vs. Towson on Feb. 27. She also had six rebounds.
- Jewel Smalls hit 8-of-9 threes and scored a season-high 24 points at JMU on Feb. 20. The 8 treys set a school record and included a three that sent the game into overtime.
- Delaware out-rebounded Towson 63-38 on Saturday and 55-38 on Sunday. UD tops the CAA in rebound margin (+10.8 rpg) and leads the nation in offensive rebounds (20.0 rpg).
- Rallied from a 17-point deficit to beat JMU 51-48 on Feb. 27, but lost 61-51 on Feb. 28.
- Keishana Washington netted 18 points, including Drexel's final two buckets, in the JMU victory. She had a team-high 16 points on Feb. 28 and has scored double digits in 13 of her last 18 games.
- Hannah Nihill had a team-high 20 points, 6 assists and 5 steals in the win over JMU. She's averaging a team-best 15.7 ppg and has had double-digit points 16 times. Nihill leads the CAA in steals and is 5th in assists.
- Mariah Leonard tallied 15 points and a team-high 7 boards vs. JMU on Feb. 28. She leads the CAA in FG% (52.1%) and tops the team in rebounding (6.8 rpg).
- Kate Connolly averaged 13.5 points in the Towson games. She was 11-of-15 from the floor and 5-of-7 from 3-point range.
- Maura Hendrixson ranks 3rd in the nation in assist/TO ratio with a team-high 76 assists and only 20 turnovers for the season.
- Drexel leads the CAA in scoring defense (56.5 ppg) and FG% defense (38.2%).

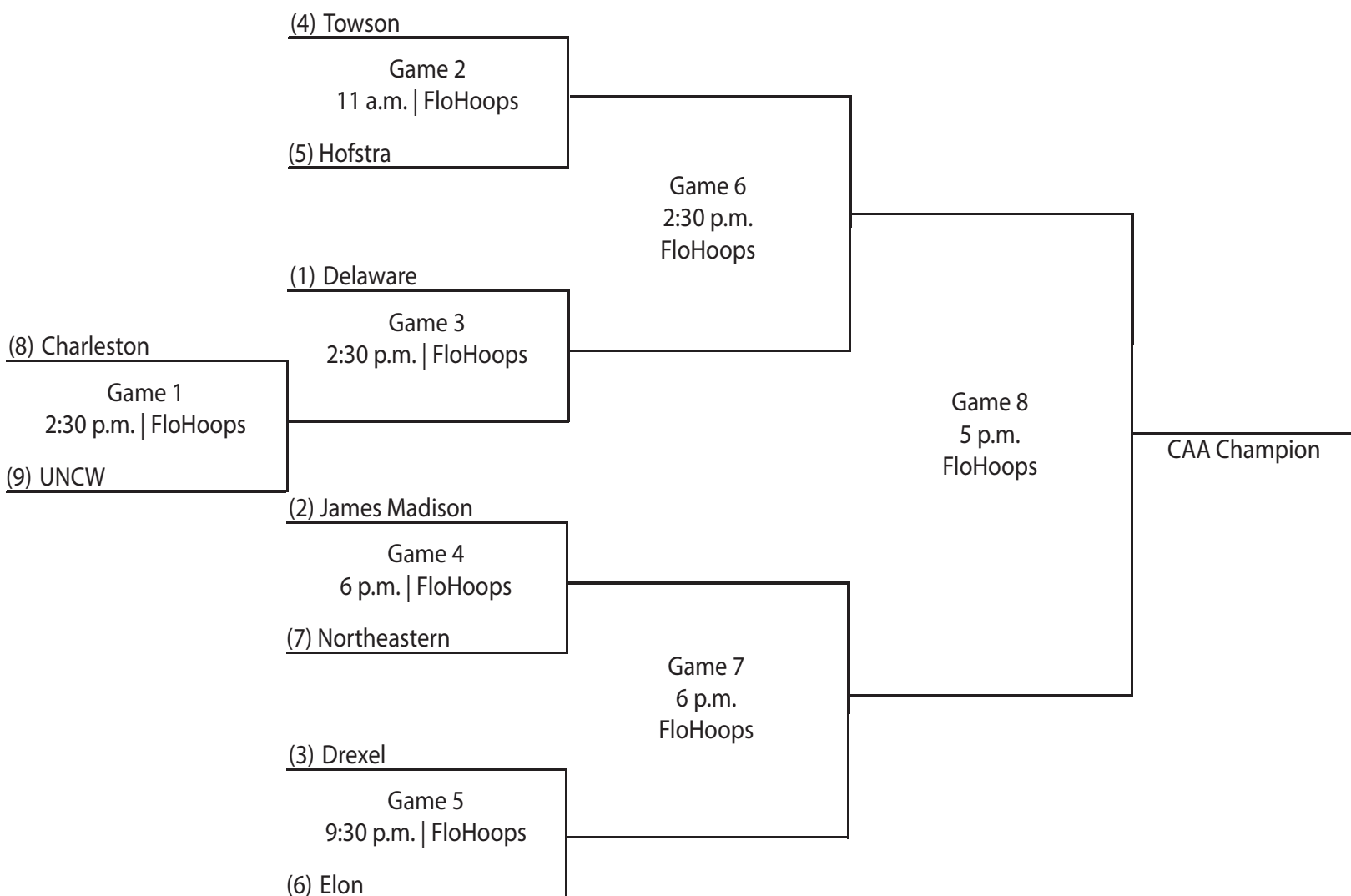
