



Overflow Parking Information

The Hampton Virginia Aquaplex uses the closest section of the Hampton Coliseum parking lot to the Aquaplex whenever overflow parking is needed. This lot is a short 5 to 7 minute walk.

The Hampton Virginia Aquaplex is located at the corner of Coliseum Drive and Pine Chapel Road. The overflow parking lot, which contains 350-400 parking spaces, is diagonally across the street from the Aquaplex. For evening events/competitions, this lot will have lights on until 10:00 pm. Below are the directions for the three most used ways to get to the overflow parking lot. Signs are posted along the road to help you.:

- After turning onto Coliseum Drive from Mercury Blvd., the first stop light is Pine Chapel Road. Continue straight through the light and make your first right turn into the parking lot. You have arrived.

If you dropped off your swimmer/swimmers at the front of the Aquaplex and could not find a parking spot in the main lot, please do the following:

- Depart the Aquaplex using the driveway next to the Aquaplex building which takes you back to Coliseum Drive. Make a left turn onto Coliseum Drive. The first stoplight will be Pine Chapel Road. Continue straight through the light and make your first right turn into the parking lot. You have arrived.
- Depart the Aquaplex using the driveway next to the Aquaplex Splash Park. Make a right turn onto Pine Chapel Road. The first stoplight will be Coliseum Drive. Make a left turn. The first driveway on the right will be the entrance to the overflow parking lot. You have arrived.

Bus Parking: NO BUS PARKING IS ALLOWED IN THE MAIN LOT OF THE AQUAPLEX.
Buses must park in the overflow parking lot.

Please note: because parking in areas with “No Parking Signs” prevents an ambulance and fire trucks from having access to the Aquaplex, the Hampton Police Department has the support of the Aquaplex to ticket illegally parked vehicles.
