NEWS & NOTES

CROWNED IN THE CAPITAL

The 2026 Air Force Reserve CAA Men's Basketball Championship begins with one Friday afternoon game in D.C., as 12th-seeded North Carolina A&T takes on 13th-seeded Northeastern. The 13-team tournament marks its sixth season at CareFirst Arena, formerly known as Entertainment & Sports Arena (2020, 2022-26).

This year's tournament will be the 44th installment of the CAA Championship and the 41st to be played in either D.C., Virginia, or Maryland. The CFA is the second venue in league history to host at least six Championships, including five straight alongside the Richmond Coliseum (1990-2013).

BACK-TO-BACK?

UNCW will look to be the second program in the last four seasons to win back-to-back CAA tournament championships when its quest for an eighth league crown begins on Sunday. Charleston had won the 2023 and 2024 titles before UNCW's championship run in 2025.

The Seahawks secured their conference-leading 10th regular season title following their win over Elon on Tuesday. UNCW enters the postseason with a 26-5 record overall, marking the fifth straight season with at least 20 victories.

STREAKY BUSINESS

Five CAA programs enter the postseason slate riding winning streaks of three games or more. Charleston leads the charge with wins in five straight contests. Hofstra has notched four consecutive wins, while Monmouth, Towson and William & Mary all picked up their third triumph in as many games on Tuesday.

THE PATH OF LEAST RESISTANCE

Since the league's official start in the 1982-83 season, only three teams have ever won the CAA Championship seeded outside the top four: East Carolina (1993), Drexel (2021) and Delaware (2022). Furthermore, only 10 teams have ever made it to the championship game as a fifth seed or lower, five of which have come in the last five tournaments.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

Campbell Head Coach John Andrzejek will make his CAA Men's Basketball Championship debut on Saturday when his team takes on Stony Brook. Andrzejek will look to join elite company to win the CAA Tournament in his first year with a program; Ernie Nestor, George Mason (1989), Oliver Purnell, Old Dominion (1992), Jeff Capel Jr., Old Dominion (1995), Jeff Beilein, Richmond (1998), Brad Brownell, UNCW (2003), Anthony Grant, VCU (2007).

CRUZ-ING

Hofstra's Cruz Davis was named the second-ever USBWA National Mid-Major Player of the Month for December. In five games against Division I opponents last month, Davis averaged 26.2 points on 54.7% shooting from the floor (47-86 FG) to go with 5.8 assists. He helped the Pride to a pair of road wins over ACC foes Pittsburgh and Syracuse. The Plano, Texas native garnered his lone national recognition by unloading a career-high 36 points in an 80-73 road win over the Panthers, the starting point of the team's eight-game winning streak.

DOUBLE OVERTIME THRILLER

After 14 ties, 17 lead changes and an extra 10 minutes of action, Stony Brook prevailed in its 112-106 double-overtime victory over Charleston on Jan. 17. The 218 combined points tied the CAA record for most combined points in a conference game, matching the total in William & Mary's 114-104 win over the Cougars on Feb. 24, 2018. The Seawolves' Erik Pratt went off for a game-high 39 points, 13 assists and seven rebounds in a complete 50 minutes of action. Richard Goods and Rob Brown III chipped in 18 and 17 points apiece, respectively. The Cougars' Jlynn Counter notched a team-high 28 points, seven rebounds and six assists.

40-PLUS

Michael Eley's 43-point performance against Campbell was the highest scoring output in a conference contest since Hofstra's Desure Buie posted 44 points against Elon on Jan. 4, 2020. His showing also tied the program's benchmark since elevating to Division I and is tied for the eighth-highest total in CAA history.

COASTAL TIDES

The CAA caused a ruckus in the KenPom Rankings, jumping as high as No. 12 this season after watching the league secure 53 NCAA Division I wins from Nov. 21-Dec. 21.

As of Thursday, two teams find themselves inside the NCAA NET Ranking Top 120: UNCW at No. 90, Hofstra at No. 93.

WINNING COMPANY

Northeastern's Bill Coen is the all-time leader in CAA wins (conference games and tournament) with 199, passing Jim Larranaga in January 2024. Bill Coen secured his 300th win with the Huskies on Nov. 7 after watching his squad fight back and down Colgate, 68-65. Towson's Pat Skerry became just the fourth men's basketball coach in league history to reach 150 CAA wins with a 58-56 win over Elon.

A WEEKEND TO REMEMBER - FEB. 13-16

All six games during the weekend of Feb. 13 went down to the wire, all being decided by five points or less. All five of the CAA's national TV games went down to the wire over the weekend, all being decided by five points or less. Three of those contests saw a game-winning bucket come in the final minute of action.

For the fifth time in eight CAA conference showdowns, the battle between North Carolina A&T and Hampton was decided by one point as a late three-point play by Trent Middleton Jr. erased a nine-point deficit and propelled the Aggies to a 71-70 victory with an and-one in the fifth installment of the NBA HBCU Classic during at NBA All-Star 2026 on Feb. 13.

Christian May's late 3-pointer pushed UNCW to a 70-66 victory over Hofstra inside Trask Coliseum on Feb. 14. The graduate guard logged 13 points, seven boards and a trio of assists.

Bryson Cokley sank seven 3-pointers, including the game-winner with two seconds remaining, to help Elon knock off William & Mary with an 81-78 victory as the league's lone non-TV game on Feb. 14. The Phoenix handed the Tribe just their second loss inside Kaplan Arena. The sophomore guard posted a career-high 29 points on 8-of-13 shooting from the floor and a 6-for-6 showing at the charity stripe.

Justin Ray's late 3-pointer with under 30 seconds to play lifted Monmouth to a 72-71 victory over Towson on Feb. 15. The sharpshooter saw three of his four makes go down from distance en route to 15 points.

Centers Chol Machot and Christian Reeves combined for 35 points, 21 rebounds and nine blocks as Charleston secured a 62-57 victory at Campbell on Feb. 15.

A furious scoring effort over the final 75 seconds saw Stony Brook come out on top with a 72-69 victory over Drexel on Feb. 16, thanks to a putback finish from Erik Pratt and a late steal by Andrej Shoshkikj. Pratt led all scorers with 21 points, eight boards and five assists. Shoshkikj notched 14 points and three total steals in the winning effort.

USBWA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Dec. 9: Cruz Davis - Hofstra

Davis put forth an incredible week for Hofstra, notably pushing the Pride to an 80-73 road win over ACC foe Pittsburgh. He averaged 30.0 ppg on 56.1% shooting from the floor with 4.0 made 3-pointers per game and 5.0 apg. The Preseason All-CAA selection unleashed a career-high 36 points on 14-of-25 shooting from the field overall and 5-for-11 from distance as Hofstra took down the Panthers for its first win over an ACC opponent since 2015. Davis contributed to 63.8% of the team's scoring as he added seven assists to his final line.

USBWA MID-MAJOR PLAYER OF THE MONTH

December: Cruz Davis - Hofstra

Davis capped off the final month of 2025 with consistent dominance against high-caliber adversaries. USBWA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jan. 21: Erik Pratt - Stony Brook

Pratt orchestrated a pair of wins over two of the league's top teams, Hofstra and Charleston, playing all 90 minutes for the Seawolves. The Lake Worth, Fla., native racked up 28.5 points per game on 52.5% shooting from the floor (21-40 FG), adding 8.5 assists and 5.0 rebounds per contest.
