Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande, Ore. – The College of Idaho ran their winning streak to thirteen matches with wins at home over Evergreen and Northwest. and moved two spots to No. 12 in the polls. The Yotes remain two games up on Southern Oregon and four games ahead of Eastern Oregon and Concordia in the race for a CCC title.

With seeds No. 1 and No. 2 earning a bye to the semifinals, much is at stake the last few weeks of conference action for teams looking to make the playoffs and to hopefully host a quarterfinal round as the No. 3 and No. 4 seed. With a two game lead over the current No. 5, Warner Pacific and No. 6, Northwest, EOU and CU control their own destiny. Northwest Christian is lurking in the No. 7 spot and could make a push into the top six.

Oregon Tech, Corban and Evergreen have showed improvement and pushed many conference teams. Watch for the No. 8, 9 and 10 teams to possibly upset the playoff apple cart seeding's before it is all over.
