## Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande Ore. – Concordia remains a highlight on the national scene and for the Sixth-straight week, takes the top position in the seventh regular-season edition of the 2012 NAIA Women's Soccer Coaches' Top 25 Poll. The Cavaliers, who are (11-0-2, 5-0 CCC) on the season, received 20-of-21 first-place votes and 591 total points.

Eastern Oregon, under first year head coach Jennifer Simonetti, picked up their first win of the season over Warner Pacific.

With two weeks of CCC action left before playoffs Concordia and Oregon Tech have created some breathing room with 15 and 13 points in the standings. Points are awarded for a win and a tie with 3 and 1 point respectively. Corban, Southern Oregon and Northwest are close behind 10 points each and C of I and Northwest Christian remain in the hunt for one of the four playoff spots with 9 points apiece.
