Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande, Ore. – The College of Idaho continued their hot play earning a league best ninth straight win in the CCC. The Yotes defeated I-84 rival Eastern Oregon to remain in first place and maintained No. 15 in the latest NAIA poll. Southern Oregon, with two victories, moved to 8-1 and is one game behind COI.

With the second half of conference action getting underway this week, teams continue to jockey for the 6 playoff spots available. EOU and Concordia remain in striking distance of SOU and COI but will need to string together a run of wins to solidify home court for the quarterfinals. Northwest, the only other team above .500, face winless travel partner Evergreen this week.

Warner Pacific, Concordia Northwest Christian and Corban will face three of the four top conference teams this week.
