Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande, Ore. – With two weeks remaining in regular season play much is at stake for teams still in the hunt for a playoff spot. Last week Eastern Oregon University ended a 36 match skid against the College of Idaho with a five set thriller in La Grande, Ore. The Mountaineers had not defeated the Yotes since 1996. C of I remains atop the standings however, with a 13-1 mark. Southern Oregon is just a game behind at 12-2.

The Concordia Cavaliers reside in the third spot at 11-4, while EOU has a mark of 10-4. Warner Pacific, Northwest Christian and Northwest are in a tight race and currently hold the fifth, sixth and seventh spot with only two games separating them.

Key match-ups this weekend include the CU, WPC series against EOU and C of I. The outcome could not only affect who has the leg up for hosting in the quarterfinal round, but could also put C of I's reign of CCC regular season championships in jeopardy if the Yotes stumble at all on the road.
