Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande Ore. – Northwest Christian provided the upset of the year thus far defeating the NAIA's No. 1 team Concordia 1-0 last week. It was the Cavaliers first loss of the season and kept them at 18 points going into the final week of CCC play. CU dropped from No. 1. To No. 3 in the weekly NAIA poll.

Friday has the potential to bring some clarity, as well as tighten the playoff race as CU takes on second place Northwest. A win by the Eagles will certainly put pressure on CU's championship hopes and the No. 1 seed in the post season.

Mathematically, College of Idaho, Corban and Oregon Tech are still in the hunt for one of the four playoff spots. Evergreen, Eastern Oregon and Warner Pacific have the opportunity to play spoiler and build momentum for next year if they can get some quality wins as their seasons will come to an end this weekend.
