Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande, Ore. – The College of Idaho ran their winning streak to eleven matches with wins at Corban and Northwest Christian and moved one spot to No. 14 in the polls. Unless the Yotes suffer a complete collapse it appears as if the route to the NAIA championships will again go through Caldwell.

Southern Oregon, two games behind C of I, were soundly defeated by Warner Pacific in three straight sets. The Knights play this season, under first year head coach Nels Norquist, has been inspired and earned them the Adidas Team of the Week award. Eastern Oregon and Concordia, both at 7-4 need to stay on track to secure home quarterfinal playoff berths. Northwest, Northwest Christian and Warner Pacific are all within a game of each other in the 5, 6 and 7 spots in the CCC with only the top six headed to playoffs.

Oregon Tech, Corban and Evergreen would need to dramatically turn their seasons around and get some help from the middle of the pack. They may be relegated to the spoiler role
