Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande Ore. – Oregon Tech, Northwest Christian and Concordia emerged from week two of CCC action with three wins each and 9 points in the standings. Points are awarded for a win and a tie with 3 and 1 point respectively. A tight race at the top seems to be shaping up with Southern Oregon and Northwest close behind with 2-1-1 records.

Corban and College of Idaho are lurking in 6th and 7th place with six points each. Warner Pacific, Evergreen and Eastern Oregon continue to seek their first conference win.

Concordia remains a highlight on the national scene and for the fifth-straight week, takes the top position in the sixth regular-season edition of the 2012 NAIA Women's Soccer Coaches' Top 25 Poll. The Cavaliers, who are 9-0-2 on the season, received 20-of-21 first-place votes and 591 total points. SOU continues to receive votes in the poll.
