Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

LA GRANDE, Ore. – The 2012 Cascade Collegiate Conference Volleyball Championships gets underway this week and it will be a wild week for all six teams involved.

After the tournament expanded to six schools this year, College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon secured the two first-round byes after playing first and second respectively. The Yotes also earned hosting rights and will welcome Tuesday's winners along with the Mountaineers to Caldwell, Idaho on Friday.

One first-round match will feature sixth-seed Warner Pacific traveling to third-seed Southern Oregon. The Knights earned a spot in the postseason after being picked ninth in the preseason coaches poll. The Raiders are coming off a pair of losses on the road but are 11-4 at home this season.

The other first-round match will feature fifth-seed Northwest Christian traveling up to Portland, Ore. to take on fourth-seed Concordia. The Beacons are in the postseason for the first time in school history while the Cavs have been playing well at home and on the road, making them dangerous this week.
