Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

LA GRANDE, Ore. – The Cascade Conference is just one match away from awarding an automatic spot in the 2012 NAIA National Championship and it will all be decided on Saturday in Kirkland, Wash. as Northwest plays host to Concordia.

Northwest earned a spot in the conference championship after earning a pair of first half goals from Jessica Oliver that allowed the Eagles to hold off Oregon Tech, 2-1.

Concordia advanced to the final after holding off Southern Oregon in a hard-fought 1-0 win. The Cavs scored the lone goal in the third minute as Alex Blalock put CU on top and Concordia used strong defense to keep the Raiders scoreless.

The National Championship Qualifiers will be announced on Nov. 11, with play beginning on Nov. 17 on campus sites.
