Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande, Ore. – The Cascade Conference title chase begins in earnest this week with eight of ten conference teams in action. **Southern Oregon** and **Oregon Tech** will open conference play next week as the rivals square off September 4th in Ashland. Prior to their matchup they each will host William Jessup (Calif.) in non-conference action.

Eastern Oregon, picked No. 3 in the pre-season coaches' poll has gotten off to a fast start with a record of 6-2. The Mountaineers earned key wins over No. 8 in the NAIA pre-season poll Lewis Clark State and played well in the Red Lion Cascade/Frontier Challenge going 4-1. The **College of Idaho**, pre-season favorite to win the CCC title, sports a 3-4 record as they head into conference play. The Yotes hosted their own tournament and participated in the Biola Invitational. Another perennial power **Southern Oregon** is 3-2 overall to start the young season and was picked at No. 2 by the CCC coaches. **Oregon Tech** is the surprise so far winning 6 matches. The Owls were slated at No. 7 in the conference. **Northwest**, **Northwest Christian**, **Warner Pacific**, **Corban** and **Evergreen** participated in the Red Lion Challenge with mixed results. Tracy Smith earned her first win with the **Corban** Warriors since returning to the bench. A young **Evergreen** squad improved each match and pushed Montana Tech to five games before falling 15-7 in the final.
