Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande, Ore. – The second week of Conference play provided for plenty of action. The College of Idaho and Southern Oregon remained the only unbeaten teams. A resurgent Warner Pacific pushed SOU to 5 games before the Raiders escaped with the win. SOU earned the Adidas Team of the Week award winning all three CCC matches along the way. Northwest Christian handed Eastern Oregon a stunning loss in La Grande. The Mountaineers, who were ranked a program high No. 19, fell from the top 25 this week.

Key games include EOU at SOU and Warner Pacific at Concordia. EOU, CU and WPC each sport a 3-1 CCC record and whomever can add to the win column will certainly position themselves well headed into the meat of the CCC schedule.

College of Idaho dropped two spots to No. 15 in the weekly poll despite two victories and SOU climbed up in the receiving vote's category earning 47 points. Corban hosts Evergreen on Thursday and one team will emerge with their first CCC win of the season.
