Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande, Ore. – The College of Idaho ran their record to 8-0 in the CCC after two home victories. The Yotes swept Warner Pacific but needed five games to get past the Concordia Cavaliers. Southern Oregon and Eastern Oregon created some separation from the # 4 and # 5 slots as they each secured two victories moving their records to 6-1 and 6-2 respectively.

Contests to watch this week that have huge implications are in the middle of the pack. Northwest, who had their seven game win streak snapped, sits at 4-3 and will travel to take on CU at 4-3 and Warner Pacific at 3-4. These three teams appear to be very evenly matched in personnel and the CCC could see each go to five games to decide the outcome.

Eastern Oregon will travel down Interstate- 84 to take on league leaders College of Idaho. The Yotes have been dominating at home under Head Coach Liz Mendiola. The Mountaineers have many weapons in their arsenal that could threaten the Yotes on their home court.
