After a spirited preseason Concordia, ranked No. 1 in the NAIA holds a 6-0-2 record and will take on travel partner Warner Pacific on Saturday. Southern Oregon, picked second in the CCC will host Evergreen and Northwest. TESC and NU will also play at Oregon Tech.

The Corban Warriors, the only other team in the league with a winning record thus far, will host The College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon. COI and EOU will also travel to Eugene to battle Northwest Christian. Eastern is looking to break into the win column for the first time this season.

Four spots are up for grabs in the post season tournament and teams will need to get off to a fast start in hopes of positioning themselves well for the Championships.
