Cascade Collegiate Conference Notes

La Grande, Ore. – With the first weekend of Conference play in the books four teams emerged with perfect 2-0 records. Preseason favorite College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon swept Evergreen and Northwest on the road. Warner Pacific and Concordia were able to travel down 1-5 and sweep Corban and Northwest Christian. The win at Corban for WPC marked the return of former Warrior Head Coach Nels Norquist and spoiled the home opener for Tracy Smith who returned to the Corban sidelines in 2012.

Tuesday CCC action matches travel partners Oregon Tech @ Southern Oregon and Evergreen @ Northwest. Later in the week both Evergreen and Northwest will finish up non-conference action at the Evergreen hosted Red Lion Tournament.

Friday and Saturday night(s) the four top teams will all have "home court advantage" as the Mountaineers of EOU and the COI Yotes host Corban and Northwest Christian. WPC and CU welcome the Raiders of SOU and the Lady Owls of Oregon Tech to town. In the first poll of the season COI comes in at No. 13 while EOU hits a program high ranking at No. 19.
