College of Idaho - Lady Yotes have won 9-of-10 games heading into showdown with #9 EOU...Yotes have not lost at home to EOU since 1996.

Eastern Oregon - The Mountaineers moved up one spot, from No. 10 to No. 9, in the sixth edition of the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll. The No. 9 ranking is the highest EOU has been ranked. Eastern Oregon has won 15 straight matches.
