## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Lady Yotes look to keep their playoff hopes alive the weekend with road matches at Evergreen and Northwest...C of I has never been swept on this trip since NU joined the CCC.

**Eastern Oregon** - EOU soccer has won six games this season. This is the most wins for the Mountaineers in one season since they won 11 games in 2006.
