Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Yotes to play their next four matches at home - looking to end three-match losing streak...eight goals allowed at CU was the most in the 30-year history of the program...loss Friday at WP was the first in OT in eight OT games dating back to 2011.

Concordia - With nine goals already this year, senior Septi Danciu is one goal away from reaching double digits for the third straight season. After scoring twice against Evergreen, Danciu now has 11 career multi-goal games and 47 total goals in his career. Also with nine goals in 2013, Chamberlain, meanwhile, has already set a career high, one more than his eight goals scored a year ago.

Corban - The Warriors posted the best start in school history following a scoreless tie with Evergreen last week, as Corban is 6-0-1 through its opening seven games surpassing the old mark set in 1990 by then-Western Baptist. Freshman goalkeeper Jordan Farr was named Cascade Collegiate Conference Defensive Player of the Week Monday before becoming the first Warrior since 2009 to earn NAIA Defensive Player of the Week one day later. The Warriors are in the midst of a shutout streak that is over 621 minutes long, as Corban's last goal allowed came in the first half of a 2-1 victory over Bethesda University of California. On Saturday, the Warriors will put their unbeaten streak on the line against nationally-ranked Concordia with Corban looking to snap a 12-game losing streak against the Cavaliers that dates back to the 2006 season.

Evergreen - The Geoducks are the lone team this season to post a shutout against CCC-leading Corban, playing to a scoreless tie last Saturday in a downpour in Salem, Ore.

Northwest - The Eagle men won a key CCC game with Warner Pacific on Tuesday and head to Klamath Falls for a match up with OIT on Friday. Both games are important for NU to maintain their second place standing and tie with Concordia behind league leading Corban.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons will head to face Warner Pacific on Saturday. NCU is officially 0-11 all-time against the Knights. A scoreless tie from last season was later negated by forfeit.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Warner Pacific - Francisco Duenas scored his first career goal in dramatic fashion, heading in the game winner with 14 seconds left in the second overtime and sending WPC to a 4-3 win over College of Idaho.
