Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - C of I's loss Friday vs. Southern Oregon was the first home CCC loss since 2005, a stretch of 73 matches dating back 2,931 days.

Concordia - Concordia's only two losses this year have come against ranked opponents. The Cavaliers took Westmont, currently ranked No. 10 in the NAIA, to five sets and lost to No. 3-ranked Biola in straight sets. The Biola match is the only contest where the Cavs did not record at least one win. At 21-0, Concordia is the only team in the CCC to not lose a single set in conference play.

Corban - Following a five-set victory over Evergreen for their first conference win of the year, Corban concludes its four-match road trip this week against non-conference opponent New Hope Christian before returning to CCC play against rival Northwest Christian. The Warriors will play New Hope Christian in Eugene, but will step on the court at Churchill High School due to a scheduling conflict that does not allow the match to take place at NHCC. This will be the second meeting all-time between Corban and New Hope Christian, as the Warriors swept the Deacons in their first-ever home volleyball match last season.

Eastern Oregon - EOU remained No. 11 in the nation in the fourth edition of the Tachikara-NAIA Coaches' Top 25 Poll. EOU dropped its first set since Aug. 31 when Southern Oregon took two sets off the Mountaineers. The Mountaineers are on an 11 game winning streak, the longest of the season.

Evergreen - Junior Victoria Love set a collegiate-best this season with 37 kills in a five-set loss to Corban on Friday night. Her 81 attacks were also an NAIA-high this season.

Northwest - The Eagles snapped a five match losing streak last weekend and face a tough road trip to Oregon Tech and Southern Oregon this weekend.

Northwest Christian - This weekend the Beacons host Corban to close out the first half of CCC play. A win will give NCU their best-ever first half record in conference action. Northwest Christian is just 3-10 all-time against the Warriors, but have won three-of-four including a sweep of the home-and-home series last season.

Oregon Tech - None provided.

Southern Oregon - The Raiders ended College of Idaho's 73-match home winning streak in CCC play with a five-set upset Friday, and pushed 11th-ranked Eastern Oregon to a fifth set Saturday before falling. Senior hitter Mona Goudarzian had the biggest weekend of her career with 42 kills and 25 digs. SOU will take that momentum into this weekend, when they'll have Evergreen and Northwest over for the first of five straight home matches.

Warner Pacific - WP picked up a non-league win over New Hope Christian, but dropped to 1-6 in CCC play after falling at home to #20 Concordia. Rachel Warick has been on a hot streak for the Knights, swinging for 33 kills in her last three matches.
