Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - After starting the season 1-8, the Yotes have battled back into postseason position by winning 3-of-4 - including their first road game in over a year.

Concordia - The Concordia men's soccer team has lost three conference matches for the first time since 2009 when they went 11-3-0. Septi Danciu and Michael Chamberlain share the CCC lead with 11 goals scored this season.

Corban - The NAIA's No. 20-ranked Warriors will put their unbeaten streak on the line today against defending conference champions Concordia. In 12 games so far this season, Corban is 10-0-2 and is the lone unbeaten team in the NAIA. The Warriors have allowed a mere three goals all season, including two in Cascade Collegiate Conference play, en route to leading the nation in Goals Against Average at 0.27. This season marks the second time in three years that Corban has registered 10-or-more victories, as this is the fastest in program history that the Warriors have reached the 10-win mark.

Evergreen - The Geoducks play their final two home matches of the season on Friday and Saturday as they play host to College of Idaho on Friday night and Oregon Tech on Saturday.

Northwest - The Eagles are at home this weekend facing Oregon Tech on Friday and the College of Idaho on Saturday. NU lost to OIT 1-0 in Klamath Falls on Oct. 4 and defeated the Yotes in Caldwell, 2-1, in September.

Northwest Christian - NCU might be winless on the season, but they have been making strides. Over the past two weeks the Beacons scored twice on #20 Corban University. They are the only two goals allowed by the Warriors in CCC play this season.

Oregon Tech - Loren Jessen Ranks Number 15th in Division I in Saves per Game 6.1

Warner Pacific - Warner Pacific will try to snap a three game losing streak Wednesday night in Eugene vs. Northwest Christian.
