Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes have lost five in a row and 8-of-9, looking to end skid this weekend with final home matches against Corban and Northwest Christian...Saturday vs. NCU is the final home match for five seniors

Concordia - Head Coach Grant Landy earned his 300th win of the season when Concordia beat Oregon Tech 9-0 on Oct. 19. This season, 13 different players have recorded at least one of the Cavs' 48 goals.

Corban - Riding a three-game unbeaten streak, Corban hits the road for the final time during the regular season this week at The College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon. With four games left in the regular season, Corban holds a one-point lead on Eastern Oregon and a four-point advantage over Evergreen for the fifth & sixth spots in the play-offs. The third and fourth seeds will host a quarterfinal game on November 6th, while the top two teams will earn an automatic bye into the semifinals.

Eastern Oregon - EOU picked up its seventh win of the season against Evergreen last Thursday. The Mountaineers won, 4-0. The shutout against Evergreen was the sixth shutout of the season for EOU, tying most shutouts in one season in program history. Mauriana Gonzalez scored two goals against Evergreen. She is the first EOU player to score multiple goals in one game this season for EOU.

Evergreen - The Geoducks look for their third conference win of the season this week as they travel to top-ranked Concordia on Thursday and last-place Warner Pacific on Saturday.

Northwest - The Eagles are 7-0-1 in their past 8 games and their undefeated streak will be put to the test in Portland this week when they face Warner Pacific on Thursday and then No. 1 ranked Concordia on Saturday. The Cavs will be NU's fifth Top 25 team they've faced this year.

Northwest Christian - The Beacons are currently eighth in the CCC but just two points out of sixth-place. With the top-six qualifying for the CCC playoffs for the first time, NCU is looking for their first-ever post-season appearance.

Oregon Tech - In 9-0 loss to Concordia last week, marks the most goals OIT has ever given up in a single game since a 10-0 loss to Concordia in 2006

Southern Oregon - The Raiders bounced back from their first conference loss Thursday against Concordia with a 4-0 win Saturday over Warner Pacific. Julie Zamzow scored her fourth goal in as many matches -- she also had SOU's second goal in its last 10 matches against Concordia -- to start the scoring, and Sydney Paulsen assisted two goals for her team-leading 14th and 15th points of the season. The Raiders play their final regular season home game Saturday against Oregon Tech.

Warner Pacific - The Knights will try to earn their first CCC win of the season this week with Northwest and Evergreen visiting Portland.
