Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Yotes were competitive against the preseason top-two teams in the Frontier Conference...Antonio Garrett averaged 20 points and 14 rebounds in the two games, while Jordan O'Byrne recorded back-to-back 20-plus point nights. C of I heads to the Quinn Classic in La Grande, Ore. to meet Walla Walla and Carroll, before Tuesday's rivalry game vs. Northwest Nazarene.

Concordia - Through their first three games this season, the Concordia men's basketball team is averaging 92.0 points per game. Adam Herman paces the team from the field as he's shooting .700 (28-of-40).

Corban - After playing its first-ever exhibition game against a Pac-12 Conference opponent in Oregon State last night, Corban now turns its attention toward the regular season opener next week against Portland Bible. The Warriors, who are under the leadership of second-year head coach Steve Masten, welcome back junior preseason all-conference selection Jordan Carter after he missed most of last season with a knee injury suffered against Oregon Tech.

Eastern Oregon - Opened up the season with two straight victories over New Hope Christian College. Return to the court on Friday night against Carroll in the Quinn Classic

Evergreen - After announcing the the U.S. Customs and Border Patrol that the Geoducks were bringing a win back into the United States after going 1-1 in Canada, Evergreen takes on Thurston County rival Saint Martin's in the annual exhibition doubleheader on Tuesday night at Marcus Pavilion in Lacey, Wash.

Northwest - The NU men continue to play teams from across the border as they host Quest University from Squamish, B.C. (south of Whistler), this Saturday night. NU will then reciprocate and travel to Quest in December for a non-conference game.

Northwest Christian - NCU dropped their exhibition opener on Sunday to the University of Oregon, 99-59. Former Duck Coleton Baker scored a game-high 25 points in his return to Matthew Knight Arena. It was also the first game for NCU head coach Luke Jackson, who ranks second on Oregon's all-time scoring list. The Beacons will play their second exhibition game on Friday night, traveling to face NCAA D.I Portland State University. The Vikings were 8-20 last season and took tenth in the Big Sky Conference.

Oregon Tech - The Hustlin' Owls will host Pacific Union on November 3rd at 5:00 pm as Head Coach Danny Miles looks to win game #988

Southern Oregon - The Raiders will open the season Saturday night against Pacific Union with their highest ranking since 2006 as they debuted at No. 4 Tuesday in the NAIA preseason poll.

Warner Pacific - The Knight men travelled to Canada last week, coming home with two wins and one loss. WPC also hosted NAIA Div. I #6 ranked Concordia-Irvine on Monday, falling 79-73. Ryan Parks has made 12 of 29 attempts from three point range so far this year.
