Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Coyotes facing must-win matches at Corban and Northwest Christian to keep their postseason hopes alive.

Concordia - The Concordia men's soccer team handed No. 20-ranked Corban University their only loss of the season by a score of 5-0 on Oct. 23. This was the only match this season that Corban conceded multiple goals in a game. Concordia soccer players hold the top four positions in total points in the CCC: Septi Danciu (35); Michael Chamberlain (29); Timur Zhividze (18) and Radcliffe McDougald (18).

Corban - Corban will close out its home regular season schedule this week with its first back-to-back games of the year against The College of Idaho and Oregon Tech. Freshman goalkeeper Jordan Farr registered his eighth shut-out of the season last week in Corban's 1-0 victory over Warner Pacific, as the first-year Warrior set a new single-season school-record surpassing former Warrior Mike Patron's record of seven set during the 1994 season and then matched in 1997.

Evergreen - The Geoducks make the trip north to Kirkland this weekend with a secure, but not definite, grasp on fourth place. Evergreen will try to move one step closer to the postseason when they take on first-place Northwest.

Northwest - With a three-point lead over second-place Concordia, the NU men host Evergreen in Kirkland on Saturday. Having clinched a playoff spot, the Eagles need to continue their winning ways to host their first game.

Northwest Christian - NCU picked up their first win of the season last week, defeating Warner Pacific, 4-1. The win broke a 13-game losing streak to start the year.

Oregon Tech - Loren Jessen is Ranked 9th in the NAIA Total Saves (98) and 13th in the NAIA in saves per game at 6.5

Warner Pacific - The Knights broke a five game losing streak with a 3-2 win over Oregon Tech, but fell to Northwest 2-1 on senior night. Jameson Jones scored his 22nd career goal in the game versus OIT.
