Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Head coach Liz Mendiola is one win away from her 300th career victory with the Lady Yotes - would become the first women's coach in C of I history to reach the 300-win plateau...Yotes look to complete the sweep at OIT/SOU for the second-straight year.

Concordia - Concordia's Lindsay Mangan continues to rank in the NAIA top 25 assists leader as she checks in at No. 14 averaging 10.6 assists per match. With 17 wins and three matches remaining, the Cavaliers are looking for their first 20-win season since 2002.

Corban - Corban will wrap up its home schedule this weekend against Northwest and Evergreen, as the Warriors are still in the playoff picture with four matches left. The Warriors will be honoring their four seniors - Jenny Harman, Alex Mateluwicz, Olivia Shropshire, and Brittany Sweet - prior to Saturday's match against the Geoducks, as the quartet will be suiting up for one final time in front of the home fans.

Eastern Oregon - Improved two spots, from No. 12 to No. 10, in the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll. Have won 17 straight matches at Quinn Coliseum. The Mountaineers have matched its 2012 of 23. EOU looks to improve on the win total from last year as they face Southern Oregon and Oregon Tech this weekend. With the win on Friday night against Concordia, Head Coach Kaki Morehead became the all-time wins leader in EOU Volleyball History.

Evergreen - The Geoducks picked up another win last weekend against Oregon Tech and still have an outside chance at going to the playoffs after being selected to finish 10th in the preseason coaches' poll.

Northwest - Northwest U. finishes their final four matches of the season on the road beginning with a trip to Salem and Eugene this weekend when they face off with Corban and Northwest Christian. The Eagles have struggled in the latter part of the season having lost their starting setter and starting senior OH, Molly Boyle (knee injury).

Northwest Christian - The Beacons have clinched a post-season berth and head into the final two weeks of the regular season with an eye on the school wins record. NCU currently has 16 wins, just two away from the school record of 18, set last season.

Oregon Tech - Lady Owls magic number is one to clinch the final CCC playoff spot.

Southern Oregon - The Raiders survived a weekend without the most efficient hitter in the league, freshman middle Emma Gasman, thanks to another strong effort by junior hitter Paulla Pinheiro, who had 33 kills in seven sets to secure two SOU wins. A seven-match winning streak has set up a huge weekend at home for third-place SOU against first-place Eastern Oregon and second-place College of Idaho.

Warner Pacific - Julia Toscano is having a standout year for the Knights. The junior is #4 in the CCC in kills per set (3.30)
