## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - Lady Yotes open the season this weekend with road games at Montana Western and Carroll.

**Concordia** - With the Concordia women's basketball team tipping off their 2013-14 season in an exhibition game at University of Portland on Oct. 29. The Cavs will play a second exhibition game at the University of Washington on Oct. 31 before opening its regular season at home against Simpson University on Nov. 10.

**Corban** - Sixth-year head coach Dave Bale will begin his second stint as the leader of the Warriors this week when Corban takes part in the Spokane Challenge hosted by Eastern Oregon University. The Warriors will open against Frontier Conference member Great Falls on Friday before going toe-to-toe with Montana State-Northern less than twenty-four hours later. Junior preseason all-conference selection Tara Vanweerdhuizen heads into her third season as a Warrior a mere nine blocked shots away from breaking the program's career record held by former Warrior and associate head coach Rosey Ball.

**Eastern Oregon** - Started the season with three straight victories. Opened the season as the No. 18 team in the NAIA Division II Women's Basketball Coaches Poll

**Evergreen** - The Geoducks continue to prepare for the 2013-14 season. They take on local rival Saint Martin's in an exhibition on Nov. 5 before hosting Northwest in a non-conference game on Nov. 6.

**Northwest** - The Eagles women will be idle this week and will be back in action on November 6 when they travel to Olympia and take on the Geoducks in a non-conference contest in the CRC.

**Northwest Christian** - The Beacons begin the season on Friday at the Southern Oregon University tournament against Pacific Union. NCU is 1-0 all-time against the Pioneers, winning 111-45 back in 2005. NCU is also 1-0 against their next tourney opponent, Cal Maritime. The Beacons defeated the Keelhaulers last season, 62-43 at the same SOU tournament.

**Oregon Tech** - Fresh off a double overtime 100-89 thrilling win at Humboldt on Saturday the Lady Owls will continue a six game road trip to open the season with games at Holy Names on Friday, at UC Merced on Saturday and at NCAA D1 University of Oregon Monday night at Mathew Night Arena in an exhibition game against the Ducks.

**Southern Oregon** - The Raiders, picked to finish fourth in the conference, will begin their season Friday and Saturday with the Red Lion/SOU Season Opening Classic. They play Friday against California Maritime and Saturday against Pacific Union.

**Warner Pacific** - WPC ventured north of the border for two games, defeating Trinity Western 73-67 but falling to Victoria 84-74. In the two games, Jordan Wilcox made a combined 7 of 12 attempts from the three point line.
