Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Lady Yotes look to snap a season-long nine-match losing streak on Saturday in their finale against Eastern Oregon...C of I is 3-0 this season when scoring 2 or more goals in a match, 0-12 when scoring one or fewer goals.

Concordia- The Concordia women's soccer has yet to allow more than one goal in a match this year while forming the NAIA's No. 1 defense with a 0.40 goals against average. The CU offense, meanwhile, is ranked No. 14 in the NAIA with 3.60 goals scored per game.

Corban - Having locked up a spot in the Cascade Collegiate Conference Tournament for the first time in two years, Corban closes out the regular season with a pair of home games this week against Warner Pacific and No. 1-ranked Concordia. Senior forward Audrey Sullivan currently leads the Warriors in all six offensive categories that includes a conference-leading 12 goals and 33 points.

Eastern Oregon - Mauriana Gonzalez has scored a goal in three of the last four games for the Mountaineers EOU has won eight games this season, seven more wins than they had last season.

Evergreen - Evergreen plays host to Southern Oregon on Thursday and Oregon Tech on Saturday as a pair of wins could propel the Geoducks into the postseason.

Northwest - The Eagle women hope to snap a two game losing streak when they play host to Oregon Tech on the NU pitch this Thursday afternoon and then face a tough Southern Oregon team at home on Saturday. It will be senior day for three NU seniors.

Northwest Christian - Heading into the final weekend of the regular season, NCU is two points behind Oregon Tech for the sixth-and-final playoff spot. The Beacons hold the tie-breaker over the Owls by virtue of a 1-0 win at home earlier this season.

Oregon Tech - Rebekah Nisbet leads the CCC in Shots 87 and shot on goal 46. Goal Keeper Rebekah Matteri leads the CCC in total saves 105 and saves per game 7.

Southern Oregon - Despite dropping their senior game Saturday against Oregon Tech, 1-0, the Raiders can still claim the No. 2 seed in the conference tournament with a little help and a sweep this week of Evergreen and Northwest. However, they'll be seeking their first win against the Eagles since 2009.

Warner Pacific - Warner Pacific won their first two CCC games of the season last weekend, the first back-to-back wins for the Knights since 2011. Trisha Durham scored three goals and assisted on two others and was named CCC Player of the Week for the second time this year.
