Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - Yotes close out homestand with Saturday match vs. OIT and Tuesday match with CU...Yan Gioseffi leads CI with five goals – all off free kicks or PKs

Concordia - Concordia has lost two conference games already this year, something the team has avoided the last three seasons. Concordia has the top two goal scorers with seniors Septi Danciu and Michael Chamberlain sharing the league lead with nine goals.

Corban - For the first time since 1997, Corban is ranked inside the NAIA's Top 25 after the Warriors earned the No. 24 ranking this week. Corban is riding a school-record tying nine-game unbeaten streak, as the Warriors are the lone team in the Top 25 to have not suffered a loss so far this season. Over the past seven games, Corban has not allowed a goal with the Warriors' scoreless streak sitting at 721 minutes and 21 seconds. The last team to score against Corban was Bethesda University of California with a goal at the 8:38 mark on August 27th.

Evergreen - The Geoducks open up a stretch of four home games in five matches when they host Northwest on Saturday. Evergreen is 3-1-1 at home, with their lone loss coming last weekend against then-No. 12 Concordia in a match played at South Sound Stadium in Lacey.

Northwest - The Eagles are in Olympia on Saturday to take on in-state rival Evergreen. Games between the Eagles and the Geoducks always prove to be competitive contests. NU needs a win to stay tied with Concordia for second place in the CCC.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Warner Pacific - Ruben Amezcua provided a late game winning goal against Northwest Christian last week, sending WP to 2-1 win. The Knights hope to climb further up the CCC standings this weekend, but face a tough opponent in rival Concordia on Saturday. WPC upset the Cavs 2-1 in their last meeting.
