Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - C of I has won four-straight road matches and picked up their first win in six tries over a Top-25 team this season with the win at Concordia

Concordia - The Cavaliers have one of the NAIA's top-15 setters and liberos on their team as senior Lindsay Mangan is ranked No. 9 in the nation at 10.88 assists per set and sophomore Shantel Gritsch ranked No. 13 in the land with 5.430 digs per set. Mangan enters the week 115 assists shy of second place on CU's all-time leaderboard.

Corban - After being away from the C.E. Jeffers Sports Center for the past four matches, Corban returns home to take on Warner Pacific and Concordia at the start of the second half of the CCC schedule. The Warriors are only three games behind Oregon Tech for the sixth and final playoff spot with nine league matches remaining in the season.

Eastern Oregon - For the third time this season, Casey Loper was named CCC Red Lion Offensive Volleyball Player of the Week. EOU came in No. 10 in the fifth edition of the Tachikara-NAIA Volleyball Coaches' Top 25 Poll. This is the best ranking in school history. EOU ranks 6th in the NAIA in assists per game with 12.7 and 12th in kills per game with 13.6. Loper ranks 13th in the nation in hitting percentage (.376)

Evergreen - The Geoducks finished the first half of CCC play having played one less match than eight other teams in the conference. Evergreen's match on Sep. 20 at Northwest was not played due to lack of officials and will be made up on Nov. 7 in Olympia with the Geoducks also hosting Northwest on Nov. 8.

Northwest - The Eagles have their hands full this weekend as they host the College of Idaho and No. 11 Eastern Oregon. NU has dropped 7 of their last 8 matches and have been swept in all seven.

Northwest Christian - None Provided.

Oregon Tech - None Provided.

Southern Oregon - Southern Oregon's momentum continued to build with its best-hitting weekend of the season in sweeps of Northwest and Evergreen as the Raiders attacked at averages of .371 and .282. Junior middle Nikki Keller put together an especially impressive performance with 14 kills on 16 swings against the Eagles, Paulla Pinheiro had 23 kills and 19 digs in six sets and Lauren McGowne posted 88 assists. The Raiders will kick off the second half of CCC play Friday against Oregon Tech, which they swept the first time around.

Warner Pacific - After two losses over the weekend, the Knights are 1-8 in CCC play. The team hopes to turn around their season with matches at Corban and Northwest Christian. Marchelle Bostic has moved to #2 on the WP career assists list (1182), and will likely surpass Tara Andrews for #2 before the season ends.
