## Around The Cascade Conference

**College of Idaho** - After played their first 9 games on the road this year, the Lady Yotes open their home schedule on Thursday vs. Oregon Tech.

**Concordia** - The two teams Concordia has not defeated this season, No. 1-ranked Embry-Riddle (Fla.) and No. 4-ranked Westmont College (Calif.) have a combined record of 17-1-2. A dozen different Cavaliers have scored at least one goal this season with Ashley Ames and Hannah Kimsey leading the way at six goals each. Freshman Olivia Brock holds the NAIA lead with a 0.19 goals against average

**Corban** - After a four-game road trip, Corban returns home this weekend for its Cascade Collegiate Conference home openers against Evergreen and Northwest. With a win in either game this weekend, head coach Marty Ziese-mer will become the ninth active head coach in the NAIA to register 200-or-more victories in a career.

**Eastern Oregon** - The shutout of Warner Pacific was the fourth shutout of the season. The four shutouts are the second most in school history. EOU's five wins is the most wins in the program since it won five games in 2008.

**Evergreen** - Evergreen will play their fifth and sixth straight match on the road this weekend at Corban and Northwest Christian. While just 1-5 on the year, the Geoducks are 1-0 in the state of Oregon, having earned a 1-0 win at George Fox on Sep. 12.

**Northwest** - Northwest has won five out of their last six contests and hope to continue their winning ways when they face two tough opponents in Northwest Christian and Corban this week. All five of the Eagles' victories have been shut outs.

**Northwest Christian** - None Provided

**Oregon Tech** - None Provided

**Southern Oregon** - Five different Raiders got on the board in Saturday's 5-3 comeback win against Corban, helping SOU extend its unbeaten streak to five matches going into contests this week at College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon. The Warriors ended SOU's four-match shutout streak -- which was extended in Thursday's scoreless draw against Northwest Christian -- but the Raiders scored three times in five minutes at the end of the match to make that moot. Twelve Raiders have contributed to SOU's goal total of 21 this season.

**Warner Pacific** - The Knights remained winless in CCC play following losses to College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon last week. Hannah Millhollen was a bright spot for the Knights, contributing a goal and an assists versus C of I.
