Around The Cascade Conference

College of Idaho - C of I off to their best start since the 2006-07 season (10-1) and have won four in a row for the first time since 2010-11...Yotes lead the NAIA in assists per game and are averaging 97 points a night.

Concordia - Concordia leads NAIA DII with 13.4 steals per game and is ranked No. 2 in the nation with 101.4 points per game. Saint Xavier (Ill.) holds the NAIA lead at 104.0 points per game.

Corban - Coming off a second place finish at last weekend's Menlo Tip-Off Classic, Corban continues its road trip at the Carroll Classic this weekend in Helena, Montana. Junior Jordan Carter currently leads the Warriors in scoring with an average of 21.5 points per game and is shooting 67.6% (23-for-34) from the field this season, while handing out a team-leading 4.0 assists per game.

Eastern Oregon - Tony Eackles Jr. was named CCC Player of the Week. The Mountaineers are 6-0 to start the season.

Evergreen - After a pair of DI exhibitions on the road last week, the Geoducks will enjoy sleeping in their own beds as they play at Puget Sound on Friday night before heading up to KeyArena on Saturday to take on DI Seattle University in an exhibition.

Northwest - The Eagle men head to California this Friday and Saturday for two games with William Jessup. Cal Pac teams have already knocked off CCC teams this season, so the two games should be very competitive in the Rocklin's school home gym.

Northwest Christian - After a 2-1 start during a California road trip, NCU will return to the court on Saturday, traveling to Portland to take on Multnomah University (3-4). The Lions are averaging 112 points per game while allowing 114. The game is scheduled to tip-off at 4:00 pm.

Oregon Tech - None Provided

Southern Oregon - Eric Thompson matched a career-high with 34 points, Jeff Bush had 11 points and nine assists and the Raiders salvaged a weekend split Saturday at The Master's a night after going down at Westmont. They're off until Nov. 22-23 at OIT's Midland Empire Classic.
